- 1/2/30 - Old barn burned down 12/31/29, cor. Lexington & Denman (Old Stephenson property). Dwelling was saved.
- 8/6/31 - According to Herodotus, Jos. Stephenson one of \$500 contributors to Catholic Church (See Cath. Church card.)

8/1/40 - Mrs. - Adelaide Bigelow Drysdale Stephenson, widow of Winfield Stephenson, died 7/30 at her home, 24 Eastman St. Came to Cfd in 1865., born in NY. Old family home (Bigelow) was on present Cleveland school property. Two sisters survive, Emily and Beatrice Bigelow, both of Ufd., & a granddaughter, Mrs. Charick Rosencrantz, also of Cfd.
