- 2/8/45 - Wm. Willsey won Bd. of Ed seat. (1 of 3) " "

- 2/7/46 - Willsey named Health Officer for Roselle Park. He is also Health Officer for Cranford, Garwood, Mountainside and Clark
- 1/1/48 - William Willsey retires as Health Officer. He was appointed 9/15/31. He will continue in Kenilworth, Winfield and Roselle Park. He came to Cranford in 1925.

11/20/13 - Henry Willsie, 73, of 7 Berkeley Pl., died 11/17. Leaves his wife, a son Henry, and a daughter Etta.

9/20/17 - Mrs. E.B. Mc Cue (formerly of Mc Cue farm on Spgfld.Ave., now known as the Willsie farm), died 9/18/17. Leaves her husband, 2 daughters, Mrs. Honore Willsie (editor of the Delineator) & Mrs. M.E. Chester & 1 son Philip.

11/29/17 - Willsie house at Spgfld.Ave. & the turn to Wstfld., burned down 11/26. Caretakers, Mr. & Mrs. Martin got some books out, and with aid of firemen, most of the furniture. No water supply as nearest hydrant is at Dreyer's, a quarter mile away.

4/26/23 - Mrs. Honore Willsie, divorced from Henry Willsie in Dec., married to Wm. Morrow 4/25/23.
