- 11/4/09 - Headquarters of Chr. & Miss. All. Church is to move from the Opera House Block to the Kleinfelder Bldg., South & Walnut, (1st floor)
- 5/5/10 - C&MA will begin services in old C&M Hall at North & Eastman.
- 8/11/10 - Tent meetings to be held on Alden St. by Alliance Church.
- 12/1/10 - Change in ownership of bldg. at North & Eastman (Cranford Hall), so Chr. & Missy. Alliance Church will have to move.

(She spoke on the 2nd coming of Christ.)
- 4/16/31 - Alliance Ch 1 of 4 & VIA opposed to Theater open on Sundays (See Theater).
- 6/30/32 - Rev. Haviland (Alliance Church) leaves Cfd to go to Eliz.
- 7/26/34 - Cfd. Gospel Tabernacle to put up an addition on easterly side of church. Entrance to face Cherry St. instead of Retford.
- 10/6/38 - Rev. C.J. Mason of Buffalo named to Gospel Tabernacle & Christian Missionary Alliance Church, succeeding Rev. E.W. Richards who is going to Orlando, Fla.
- 1/9/41 - Gospel Tabernacle 1 of 7 churches to conduct community wide survey in co-operation with the Amer. Bible Society. (See Misc. card.)
- 5/15/41 - 70th birthday of Cfd. issue of Chronicle had picture of Christian and Missionary Alliance Church.
- 10/2/41 - Alliance Church had 10 7th graders in religious school classes. (See Cfd. School Board & Schools card.)

- 6/18/42 - Alliance Church participating in Vesper services to be held 5 PM each Sun. evening at Mac Connell Park.
- 6/17/43 - 1st Presby. Church & Alliance Church to unite in summer Bible School 6/21 to 7/9 at the Presby. Church.
- 6/24/43 - C&C 50th Anniversary Issue, events: Tabernacle 1898, organized Ladies Christian League by Miss Miriam Cromwell. In 1905 Alliance branch was established at home of Mrs. C.C. Drake, 7 Orange Ave.
- 4/27/44 - Christian & Missionary Alliance Church to open a center for fellowship & recreation in vacant stores at 101 & 103 Walnut Ave.
- 7/13/44 - Tent meetings to be held by Gospel Tabernacle at Retford & Cherry. Speakers include Jack Wyrtezh, noted youth speaker.
- 1/11/45 - Rev. Mason, Cfd. Gospel Tabernacle, pastor since Oct. 1938, has resigned; to leave in March.

4/5/45 - Rev. Gordon Keeney called to serve as pastor of the

7/30/01 - Christian Science Church opened in Cranford Hall

10/17/02 - Trustees of Chr. Science Church to have nominations for leaders.

11/27.03 - B.F. Bailey bought the Osbourn prop. on Spgfld. & Miln. Some people think it is for Christian Science Church.

1/1/04 - Christian Science Meeting in Opera Bldg.

4/5/04 - Christian Science Church Meetings, North & Eastman (Cfd. Hall?)

- 1/27/10 - Reineman property (formerly occupied by Christian Science Church - Walnut near Chestnut?) leased to Mrs. Mary Ireland for a restaurant there.
- 11/27/13 - Christian Science Reading Room to be in Chronicle Bldg.
- 10/22/14 - Chr. Science Church elects officers: Roderick W. Smith is among trustees.
- 10/17/18 - Chrst. Science Church protests closing of church during the Flu epidemic.
- 6/2/32 - Mrs. Etta Smith who died 5/30, former reader in Christian Science Church. (See Smith card).

6/24/43 - C&C 50th Anniversary Issue, events: Christian Science group met in 1897 in homes. 1st meeting room established in Royal Arcanum Hall in 1898 until 1901, when the Town Hall Bldg. was used. - Mr.&Mrs. Jos. B. See.
