- 10/25/35 from 10/25/45 (10 yrs. ago) Wm. Bragdon, 208 Manor Ave. to head Red Cross Drive for 1935.
- 3/26/36 - Big floods, Pittsburg area, Emergency drive by Red Cross.
- 10/29/36 - **Bragdon heads the Red Cross Drive.**
- 5/23/40 - Welfare Assoc., Red Cross, Boy Scouts, & Finnish Relief all to have drives at same time.
- 7/11/40 - Red Cross donations total \$2460. They wanted to ge \$4000.
- 10/16/41 - Red Cross drive - goal \$3000.
- 10/30/41 - Red Cross Drive for \$3000.
- 12/11/41 - Red Cross drive gets \$3084.30. Quota was \$3000. Notice just received says \$10,000 wanted for 1942 war relief - British War Relief Society to establish Red Cross Auxillary Work Room at its N.Union Ave. Hdqtrrs, it was announced by Mrs. Chas. F. Hansel.
- 2/12/42 - Red Cross has organized a blood donor & home nursing service.
- 2/19/42 - Red Cross now at \$5584 of \$10,000 goal.
- 5/7/42 - Red Cross Hdqtrrs. moved from vacant store on W.North Av. to Cleveland School.

- 6/18/42 - New ambulance in service. Chas. Kurtz bought old one for about \$500 and loaned it to Red Cross for duration ~~after~~ after which he will give it to Children's Country Home.
- 8/20/42 - Cfd. Red Cross to donate \$100 to Camp Kilmer Army Hospital to be set up.
- 9/17/42 - Red Cross quota for 1943 is \$20,000
- 12/31/42 - Amer. Red Cross Fund for a mobile kitchen at \$1946.
- 1/7/43 - Red Cross Mobile Kitchen Fund over the top at \$2326.
- 1/14/43 - Red Cross War Fund Quota at \$18,300.
- 2/25/43 - Red Cross quota for 1943 is \$18,300. Drive begins 3/1/43.
