- 9/26/12 - Progressive Bull Moose Party organized (Teddy Roosevelt)
- 10/31/12 - Robt. M. Hermes, Republican candidate for Township Committee. (See Hermes card.)
- 11/7/12 - Progressive Republicans won the Twnshp. Comm. seats. Majority vote cast for Roosevelt, Marshall, Moon. (Wilson was actually elected.)
- 5/29/13 - Permanent Republican Headquarters at old hall, North and Eastman St.
- 8/31/16 - Democratic picnic at Gaffney's Grove, end of Spgfld. Ave. Bull Moose & Republicans also attend.

- 7/3/30 - Syrian-American Club organized as part of Republican Club.
- 7/31/30 - Geo. Osterheldt, pres. of Cfd. Republican Club.
- 5/28/31 - According to HERODOTUS, Cfd. ~~Party~~ Club formed in 1871, and organized a company of tanners for the Grant & Wilson campaign. (So-called tanners because Grant was a tanner in early life.)
- 3/17/32 - Name of Ancient & Honorable Order of Yellow Dogs (Est. 1 yr. ago) changed to GOP Social Club. New officers: Pres. Robt. Niedrach; V.E., Milton Doty; Treas. A.A. Smith; Secy. E. Fred Sulzer.
- 3/24/32 - According to Herodotus, 4/20/1875, Republican ticket elected by about 75 majority. Freeholder, Alden Bigelow; Town Clerk, Wm. Christman; Tax Clctr, Moses Crane; Tax Assessor, Gideon Ludlow; Pound Kpr, Charlotte Mendell; Twnshp. Commtn-at-large Alex. Purvis; 1st Dist. John Close; 2nd Dist., E.K. Adams; 3rd Dist., Edw. S. Crane; 4th Dist., Jacob Ludlow.

- 3/24/32 - According to Herodotus, 10/5/1875, Club met at Crane's Hall on Fri. night & adopted resolution recommending for presidential nomination in 1876, Chas. Adams, grandson of 2nd Pres.
- 3/31/32 - According to Herodotus, 5/2/1876, Wm. Bigelow & E.K. Adams, delegates to Republican State Convention.
- 4/21/32 - According to Herodotus, 4/28/1880, a mtg. of Republicans on 10/27, passed a resolution for nomination of John Sherman for pres.
- 6/2/32 - Mrs. Etta Smith who died 5/30, member of Women's Republican Club. (See Smith card.)
- 11/17/32 - According to Herodotus, Stephen Cox was pres. of First Rep. Club in 1871. (See Cox card.)
- 10/21/33 from 10/21/48 (15 yrs. ago) Philip S. Swain of 11 Grove St. has achieved a record of having voted for every Republican pres. from Lincoln to Hoover, & all local Repub. candidates. He is 96 yrs. old.
- 11/4/33 from 11/4/48 (10 yrs. ago) Edw. Sullivan, Rep. C. for Twnshp Comm. won by only 51 votes over John Rath, Demo. and. All others won by small counts.
- Cfd. Rep. Club voted to request Bd. of Ed. to name Roosevelt School, the Theodore Roosevelt School.

- 8/2/35 from 8/2/45 (10 yrs. ago) Cfd. Democratic Club indorsed Fred Sykes for re-election to Twnshp. Comm. He is a Republican.
- 3/10/38 - J.W. Doran elected pres. of the Republican Club.
- 2/9/39 - Doran re-elected pres. of Republican Club.
- 6/1/39 - Twnshp. Comm. asks Republican Municipal Committee to recommend candidates for Police Dept.

6/8/39 - Democratic Club criticized the Twnshp. Comm. for asking the Republican Club to recommend police.

9/25/41 - Chas. Ehmling, head of Republican Municipal Committee.

10/9/41 - H.B. Peniston, Republican candidate for Twnshp. Clerk.

3/12/42 - Clarence Victor re-elected pres. of Repub. Club. Pictures of Robinson & Victor.

2/3/44 - Twnshp. wants to tear down old Republican Club structure (See Cooper card for 8/5/43.)

3/30/44 - Old Republican Club, No. Union & Spgfld., razed. It was formerly Geo. Teller propty. Twnshp. Honor Roll is now on the propty.

4/13/44 - Geo. D. Rankin appointed to Cty. Bd. of Taxation. Has been Republican County Chairman for several years. (See Rankin card.)
