10/29/31 - According to Herodotus, 5/18/94, property on Riverside Dr., Union Ave., Willow & Orange, recently bought by Cahill, called Roosevelt Manor.

12/3/31 - According to Herodotus, 8/30/95, stone has arrived for the two bridges at Roosevelt Manor, one at Casino Ave., to be 80 ft. long, & one at Claremont Pl., 50 ft. long.

8/11/32 - According to Herodotus, Roosevelt Manor named for Roosevelt Thompson, brother of J. Walter Thompson. Bounded by Riverside Ave., Union Ave., Orange Ave. & Willow (now Manor Ave.)

1/22/96 - E.C. Winckler to erect another house on Roosevelt Manor on site 2 lots away from one he is now building.

1/29/96 - Sewer Const. on Roosevelt Manor making headway.

2/5/96 - When Jas. Rodgers 1st talked of bldg. Opera House Block, people laughed. Now they know he was right. Then he talked of houses in Roosevelt Manor. Now that is being done. Lot 121 bot by Mr. Pierce who is bldg. handsome house. Lot 15 has house under way.
