The 1966 Cranford Varsity Football Team, in posting a brilliant 7-1-1 record, established themselves as one of the best ever to don the gold jerseys. From the second quarter of the opening game, when Gene Demsey showed a sign of things to come with his 1yard plunge into the Linden end zone, to the last quarter of the Thanksgiving Day Game, where with 36 seconds showing on the clock Roy Knauer capped a great comeback on a one-yard run through the Jefferson line, the Cougars played some 435 minutes of the kind of football coaches dream about. With a poise rarely found in a high school quarterback, junior Knauer drove the offensive unit up and down the field to the tune of 163 points, centering the bulk of his running attack on Gene Demsey and, when forced
to throw, having for targets as fine a trio of ends as ever were on a Cougar team in Bill Albans, Chuck Archdeacon and Ken Dinsmore. The defensive unit, anchored by linebacker Demsey, yielded a scant 77 points, thanks largely to five shutout games.

The team finished second only to Westfield in the Watchung Conference. Incidentally, our only loss came at the hands of the champions early in the year on a rain-soaked field. Although both sides were subject to the same poor conditions, it was evident from the outset that the superior Cranford passing attack was hindered. It was a season riddled by injuries, bad breaks, and tough Watchung Conference opponents. But it was only twelve baskets and a freethrow that kept the battling Cougars from a 14-6 record and their perennial spot atop the Conference heap.
