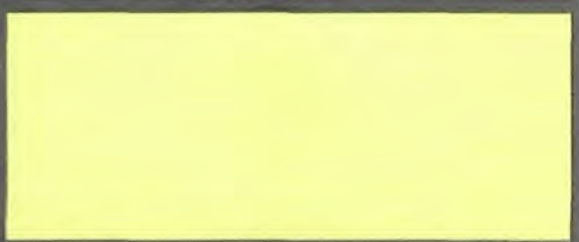
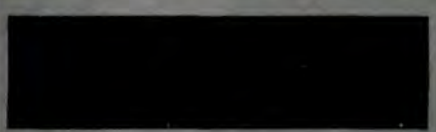
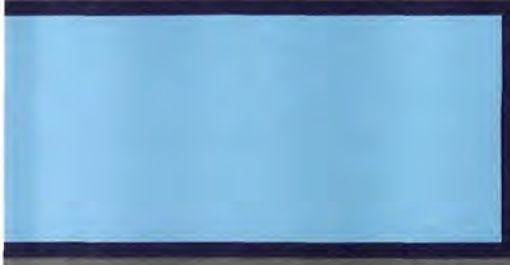
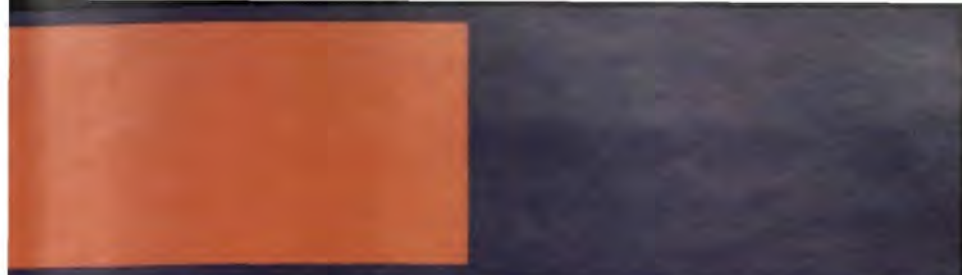


# 2004

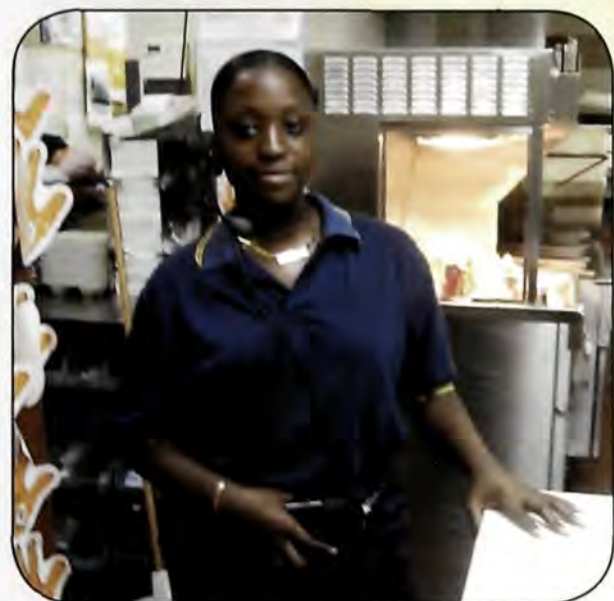

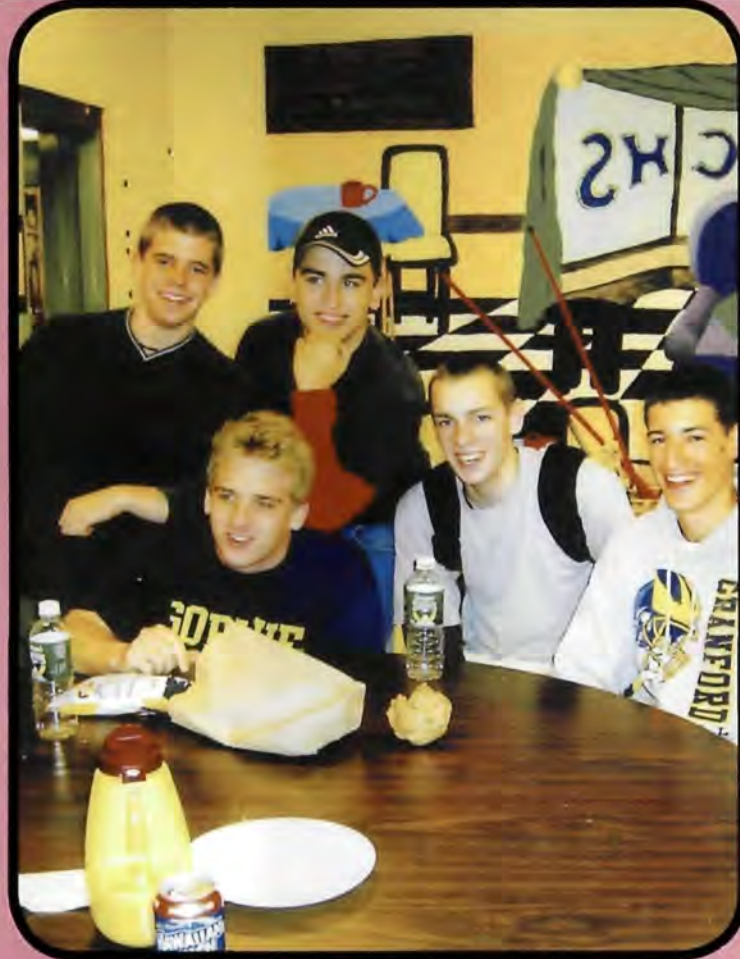

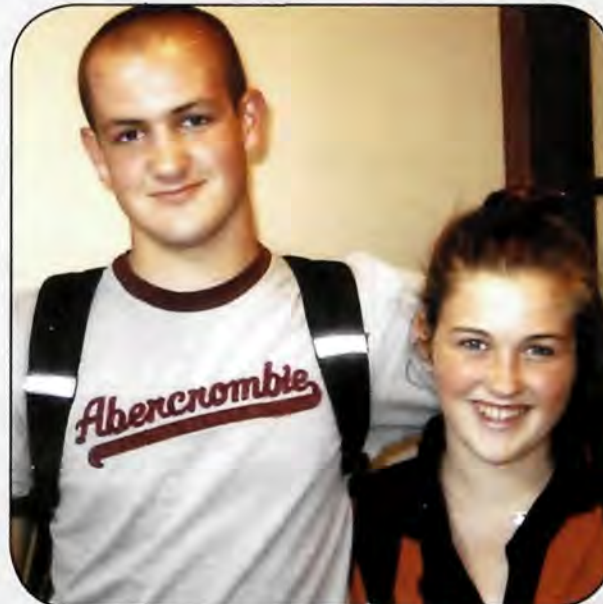

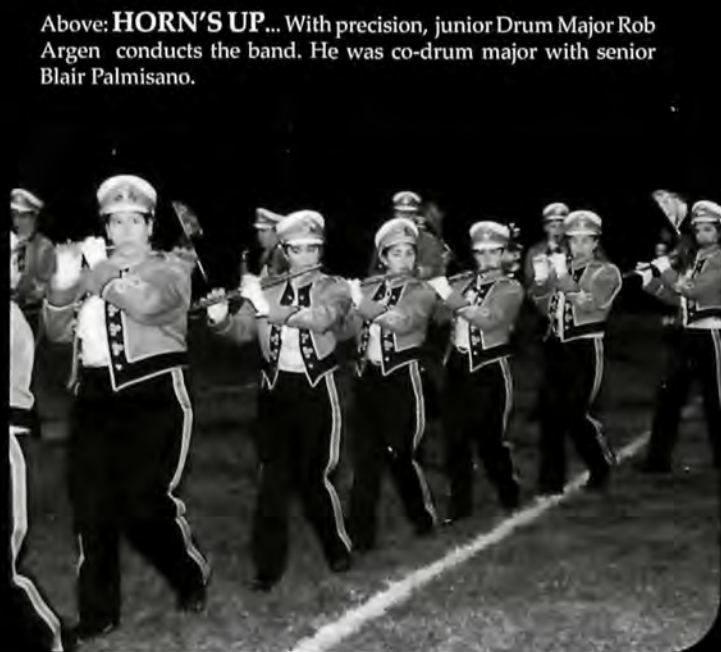

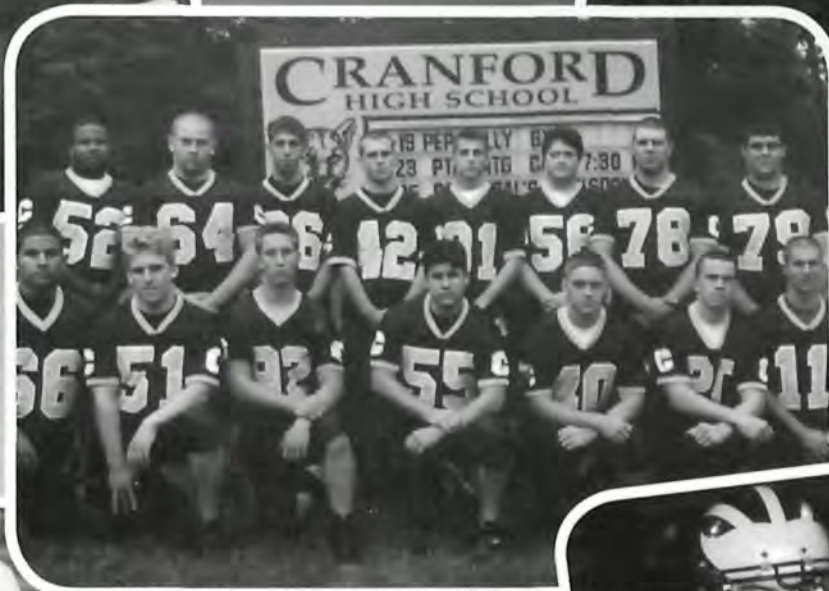

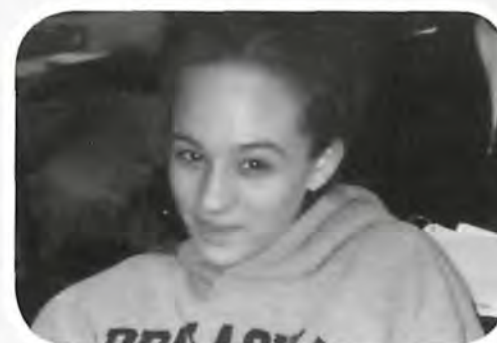

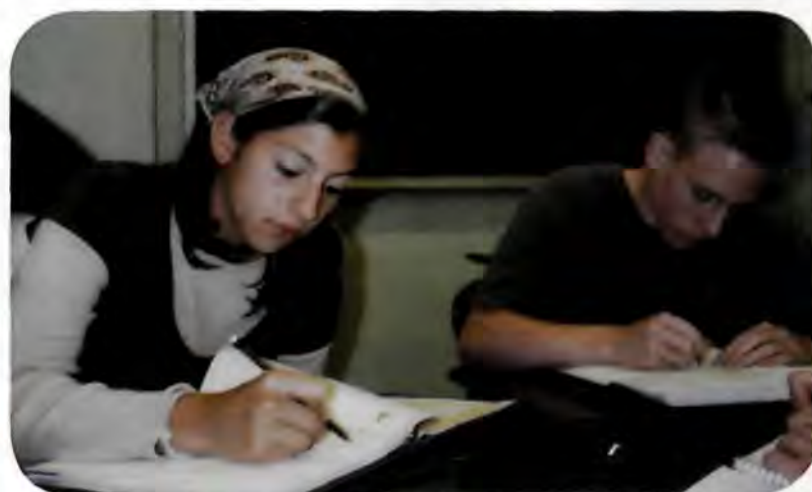

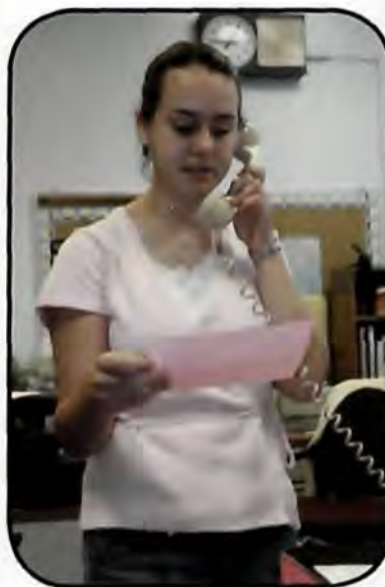

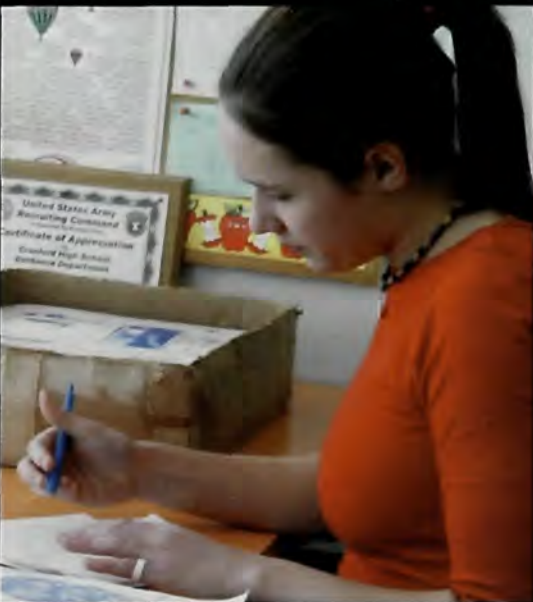


# ENCORE

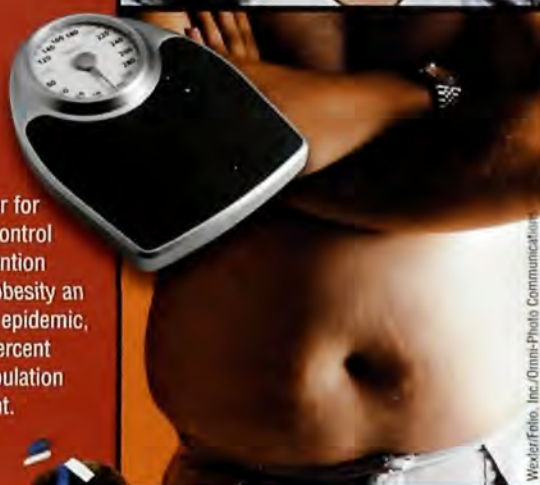

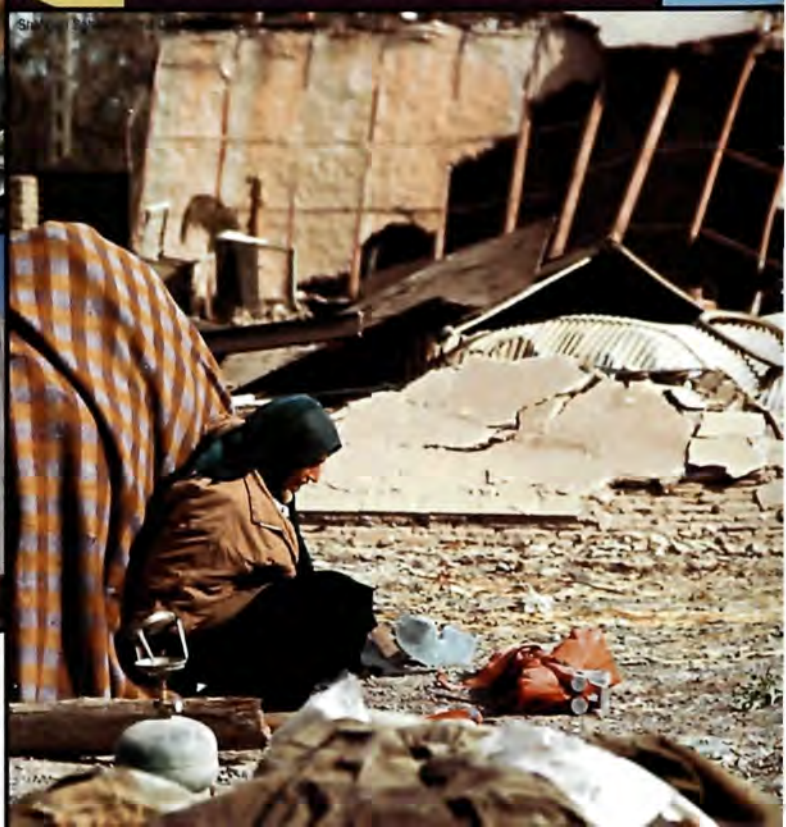

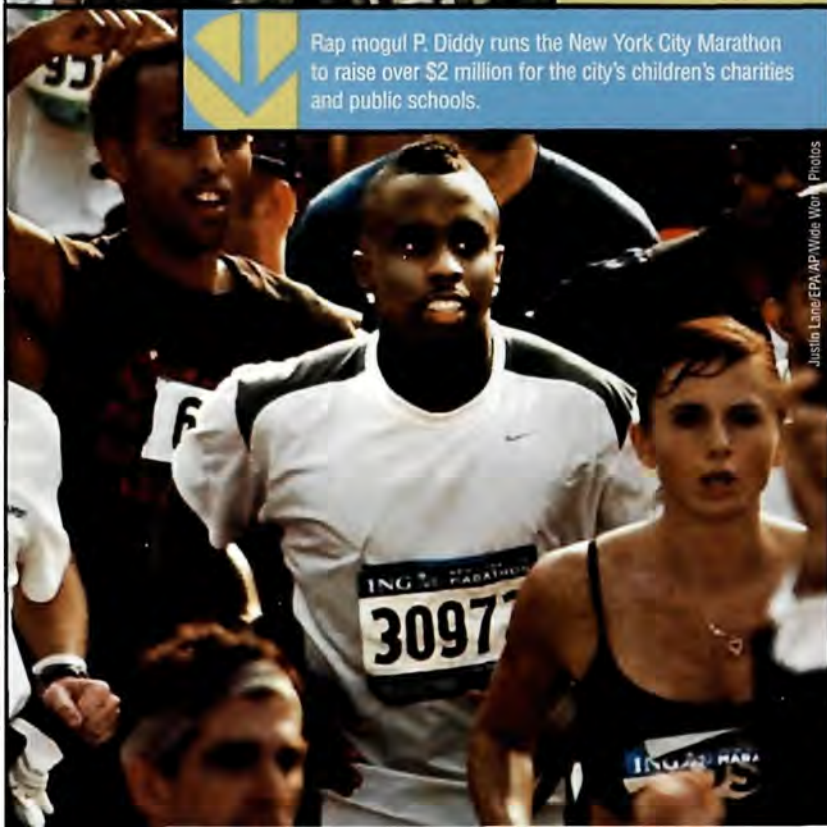

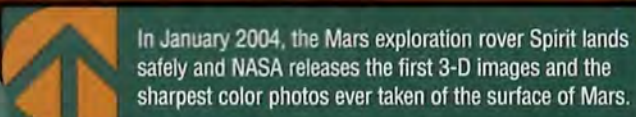

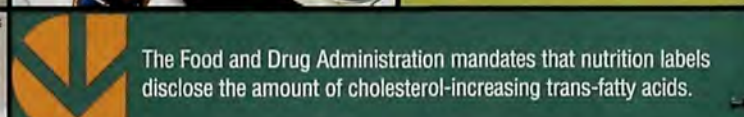

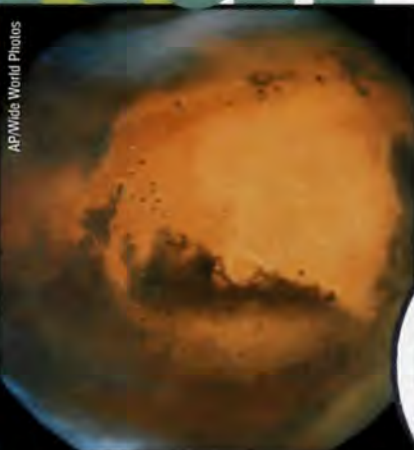

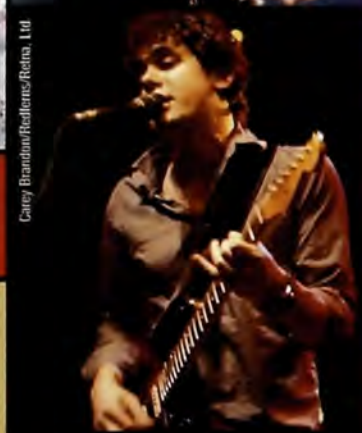

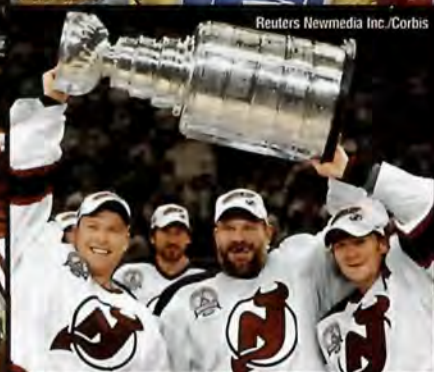
