



Biographical Sketches

Mr. Morton Graham, retiring chairman of the language department, taught in private schools for fourteen years before he came to Metuchen High School in 1936. Born in Meriden, Connecticut, where he attended the city's public schools, he earned a Bachelor of Art's degree from Trinity College in Connecticut; later he received a Master's degree in French at Teacher's College, Columbia University.

Born and raised in Tremont, Pennsylvania, Mr. Ray C. Herb received a Bachelor of Art's degree from Lebanon Valley College, did graduate work at Penn State and Rutgers Universities, receiving a Master's degree from the latter. Mr. Herb has taught in our high school since 1924. He has served as social studies chairman for 25 years; also as acting principal from 1946 to 1959; and as coach of major sports at various times. Prominent in the borough, Mr. Herb has been president of the Metuchen Board of Health for the last four years.

The four familiar faces on these pages represent one hundred and twenty-nine years of service to Metuchen High School. These gentlemen have helped the youth of Metuchen to grow into responsible adults. We, the Senior Class of 1964, are proud to dedicate this yearbook to these retiring educators.

The 1963 Bulldog harriers compiled an impressive record of nine victories, four losses, and one tie. Team captain Jerry Konopka highlighted the local season with five record-breaking runs. (Some of Jerry's feats appear on the other page.)

Coach John Cassell, who rarely has unsuccessful seasons, is particularly pleased with the increased interest and support of the student body. Coach Cassell's last three squads have produced a state championship, MHS's first undefeated team, and a record of twenty-one consecutive wins.

Konopka's astounding performances during the 1963 season include: Running the Lawrenceville course in 13:03, which is the second best time registered at that course; and achieving second place in the Middlesex County Championship.

Seven adequate runners are required to round out a competent cross-country team. Senior lettermen, besides Konopka, were Ron McHale, Craig Conover, and Jim Crownover. Junior help came from Dan Lupfer, next year's cross-country captain, John Lydic, Ray Oesterle, Jim Wells and Carl Dietz. Tom Grillo sustained an injury during the 1963 season but is expected to be an important factor next year. The JV's compiled a 3-1 record; the freshman's was 1-3.



(Editor's Note: Just so that Susie doesn't feel bad, the Eighth Grade Yearbook noted that she was "sweet and lovely.")

























