








South Plainfield — The Bulldogs could score only once against the stiff Tiger defense and were soundly beaten by Cirafesi and Company.







Clifford Scott — The Bulldogs were plagued with injuries throughout the game and were unable to mount a successful offense, resulting in a 35-0 loss.





It's old stuff, this running, I'm a senior now and should be used to it, but I was just as nervous this morning as our sophomores. My last time. Boy, how many miles have I run over the last couple of years to get into shape, to run faster and longer! It hasn't been easy. A lot of guys have more natural talent than I, but I've been improving a little each season. That's important, too. Everybody can't finish first, A guy learns from this sport. He learns what it means to run with everything that's in him and still not beat the other guy. That's the way life is, they tell you. You can't always win. It's how you play the game. Okay, okay, I'm playing the game, as well as I know how.

I can hear Coach Cassell yelling at us to move up. Okay, so I'll put on some speed. I know this course, 'specially the first part. We've practiced it enough, that's for sure. I'm passing up a few of our boys and some of those Highland Parkers. Boy, we've got to whip those Owls. Even if we come in thirtieth, it won't be so bad as long as we whip the Park runners.

I should have run the way Cassell instructed us. Now I've got to run around a lot of guys, waste a lot of energy. But I feel fine, as fine as I've ever felt running. It feels great to pass so many of these lads, most of whom I may never see again. Man, two hundred runners are a bunch! A guy can run well, end up fiftieth, and still not be disgraced. Crane and Crownover are still ahead of me. Hey, the coach at St. Joe's is yelling for us. He wants to see us run well, too. How about that!

I must give this thing my all. Boy, that cold wind can cut! I wonder how the other



guys are feeling. They're human. It must be bothering them, too. I know I'm running as well as I know how. I may be going too fast to last. I'd better slow down. Anyway, I think I'm leading our gang.

Wow, only about a mile left to go! It's getting rugged. Every once in a while I think I can hear Cassell yell at me. Man, how does he cover the entire area! His voice somehow helps me run faster. I know I must hang in there. With all the running around Roosevelt Park we've done, I should be in condition.


Coming around the lake, a runner passes me on my left, cuts in too sharply, and trips over my leg. Down he goes, the darn fool! He should have been careful. Better him than me. He almost knocked me over, too. I never would have gotten up.

Finally. The stadium and its quarter mile track are in view. That's where we finish. I can see the barn. I feel new strength; some of the tightness around the chest lightens. A quarter mile to go. I feel good, strong. I pass some runners—I don't know how many. I'm pretty sure I'll be first to finish for Metuchen. That makes me feel good. I know now I can make that finish line. Soon it'll be over. All over. My last cross country run. It's been rough, but it's been worth it. It builds character. You can laugh, but it does. I'm finally going to cross that blessed finish line. Boy, I am TIRED! But it's good. I ran as well as I know how.

I finished thirty-first. That doesn't sound like much. But I'm satisfied. There are a hundred and seventy guys behind me—that's if they all finish. When you think of it that way, thirty-first isn't so bad.

When we all finished, Mr. Cassell came to tell us that we had placed eighth in our division of 17 schools. Highland Park finished thirteenth. We all felt better.

The good feeling stayed with us on the bus ride home. We had done as well as we could. That was what counted, wasn't it?



Outstanding performances were registered as follows: Dennis Kerr, an 168-pounder, had ten wins for twelve encounters and placed third in the County tournament; Dick Crane, a nine and three record plus a fourth place finish in the County; Jeff Rule, a sophomore, won the district 98-pound title and was nine wins for eleven matches; Ronnie Weingart was five wins with no defeats; Jon Rule was five and one; and John McDuffie was eight and four, registering the runner-up spot in the 148-pound class in the district tournament.

The Middlesex County Novice Tournament saw Jim Ward win the 98-pound class with Joe Ouslander in second place in the 178-pound class.

Kerr was selected as most valuable; Jeff Rule as most improved. Selected as captains at the end of the year were Kerr and Crane.







A Capsule Interview

With Dick Crane

QUESTION: You are completing your fourth season as a wrestler, Dick. Do you find yourself less nervous as you become more experienced?

ANSWER: No, I still get nervous for every match.

Q: Do you lose sleep? Or lose your appetite?

A: I sleep okay. I don't have to worry about losing my appetite because I never eat the day of a match, anyway.

Q: Why is that?

A: A little problem of making weight.

Q: Would you explain that?

A: Well, I wrestle at 115 pounds. A half hour before the match, all the wrestlers have to weigh in. If we're one ounce overweight, we aren't allowed to compete.

Q: That sounds interesting. What happens if you're a pound or two overweight a few hours

before the match?

A: We try our best to lose 'em.

Q: That sounds rugged.

A: It is. We do everything from taking steam baths to exercising, to cutting our finger nails, to doing things that are better left unsaid. We've got to make weight. One ounce too much could hurt the team.

Q: Dick, on these pages there are some pictures of you in a match.

Do you remember it?

Sure. It was with a fellow named Rizzo, or something. He was from Watchung Hills. That was a big win for us, the first time we beat them since Metuchen introduced wrestling four years

Q: Who won the match, Dick? A: I did, but it was a squeaker. I

think I won, eight to seven. Q: Did you feel that you were going to win all the way?

A: After the first couple minutes, I thought I'd win.



Q: When you're sitting on the bench before your particular match comes up, Dick, do you look at your opponent?

A: Of course.

Q: Do you learn anything impor-tant?

A: Yes. I can see his build, of course, but more important, I can tell a lot when our eyes meet. If he looks down or away, I know I have the match.

Q: Really? That's hard to believe. Could that be just your imagina-

tion?

A: Not in my case. I've never known it to fail. If his eyes don't waver as we look at each other, I know I'm in for a tough match.

Q: Could you stare down the Watchung Hills fellow?

A: No, so I knew I was in for a match. It was a tough one.

O: How important is conditioning? A: Very, very important. Coaches Rees and Bailey make sure we're in top shape.

Q: Even if you are in condition, can you get tired out there?

A: I'll say. Sometimes it seems as though the three minutes will never end.

Q: Some guys seem to really get mad when they lose a match.

A: Nobody likes to lose, but we only get mad at ourselves.

Q: Did you ever get mad at your opponent?

A: Never. I fact, I don't remember ever seeing two opponents really get mad at each other. It's a contest, not a brawl.

Q: The closer the match, the rougher the loss, I suppose?

A: Right, If we know we've lost to a better man, it's not hard to take. It's when you feel you should have won that you really suffer.

Q: How about getting pinned? A: That's terrible. Awful. A guy

feels like dying.


Q: Do you make up a wrestling plan before each bout?

A: Well, I have some idea what I'm going to try, but I have to be ready to switch strategy all the time. You play it by ear.

Q: Do you always go for a pin? A: No. Often, you try to get ahead by points. If you're ahead on points and the opportunity comes up, you may go for a pin. But this varies, too. Sometimes you go for a pin right from the gun.

Q: If you win, you feel great. How does it feel to be congratulated by the boys and the coach?

A: Fine, of course, but it's more important what the coach thinks.



Q: Do you talk about the match afterwards? At home, for instance?

A: Not much. I just answer my family's questions, but that's about it. Of course, after the match, the fellows go over the matches with each other; and the next day the coach gives us a critique.


