When the doctor said, "You can't play." he might as well have said don't breathe; that's the way I felt about it.


I had a lot of time to think while I was in the hospital. I cried

Metuchen's grapplers ended a 10-2 season this year with losses to Roselle Park and Middlesex.


Coach Bailey and his squad also faired well in the county by placing fourth and in the Districts by placing third.
