Dear Class of 1996,



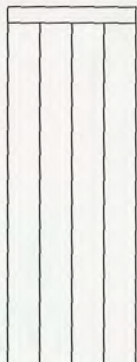
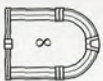
Travel far and wide. Explore. Challenge. Embrace. Persist. Commit. Think often of those at PDS who have taught and loved you. We will be thinking of you.
