Community Service Day

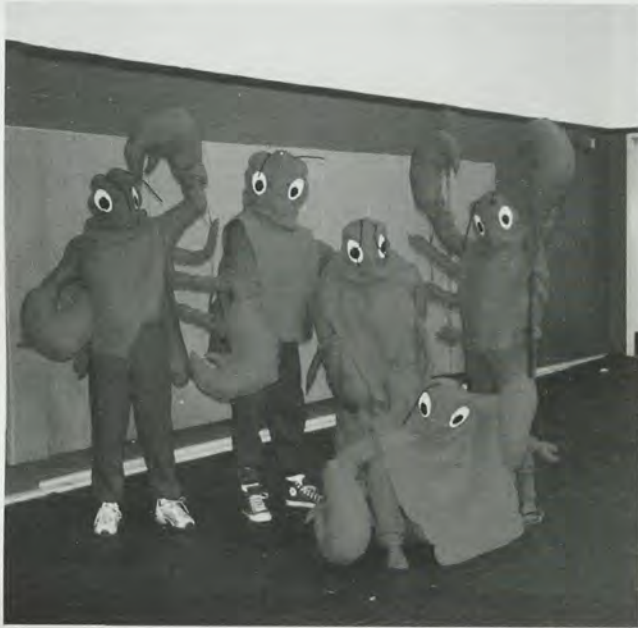

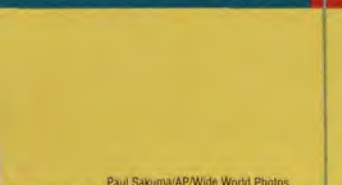

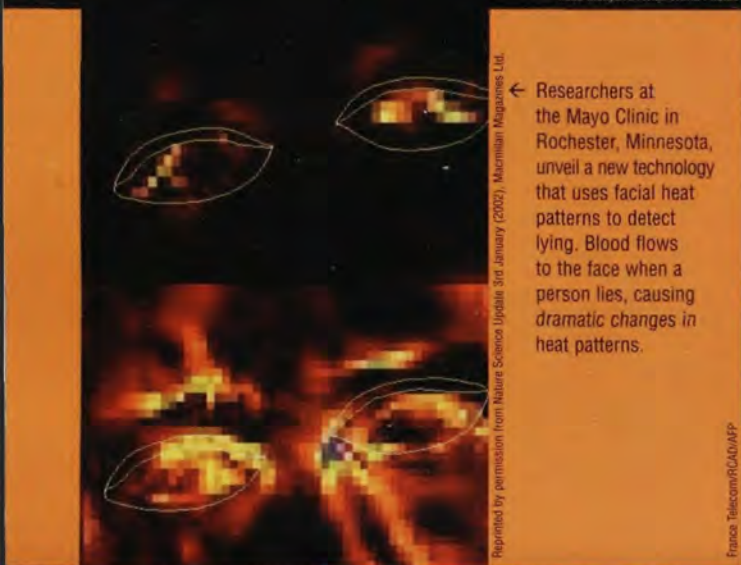

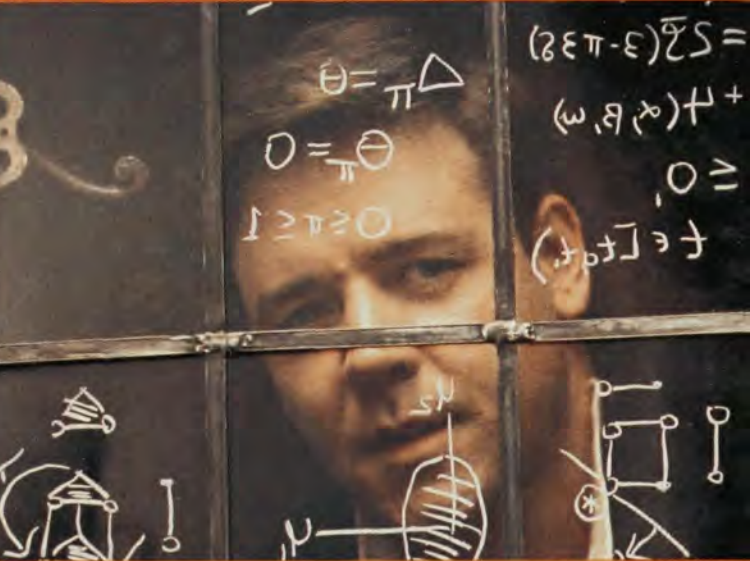
