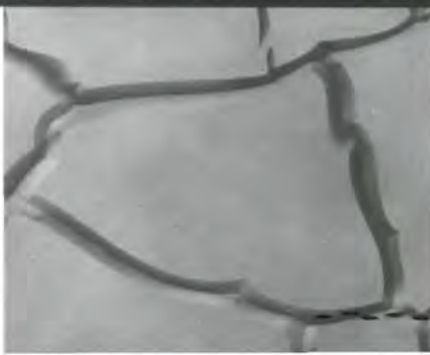

On the eve of your graduation, thank you for all that you have contributed to PDS. I wish you continued success, happiness, and fulfillment in your future pursuits.

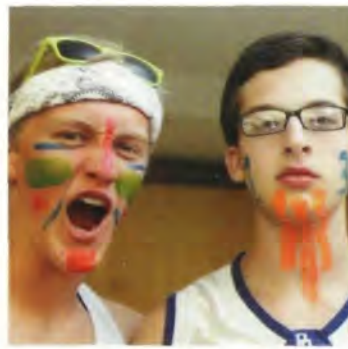

There was a crime. But there were also the lovers. Lovers and their happy ends have been on my mind all night long. As into the sunset we sail. An unhappy inversion. It occurs to me that I have not traveled so very far after all, since I wrote my little play. Or rather, I've made a huge digression and doubled back to my starting place. It is only in this last version that my lovers end well, standing side by side on a South London pavement as I walk away. All the preceding drafts were pitiless. But now I can no longer think what purpose would be served if, say, I tried to persuade my reader, by direct or indirect means, that Robbie Turner died of septicemia at Bray Dunes on 1 June 1940, or that Cecilia was killed in September of the same year by the bomb that destroyed Balham Underground station. That I never saw them in that year. That my walk across London ended at the church on Clapham Common, and that a cowardly Briony limped back to the hospital, unable to confront her recently bereaved sister. That the letters the lovers wrote are in the archives of the War Museum. How could that constitute an ending? What sense or hope or satisfaction could a reader draw from such an account? Who would want to believe that they never met again, never fulfilled their love? Who would want to believe that, except in the service of the bleakest realism? I couldn't do it to them. I'm too old, too frightened, too much in love with the shred of life I have remaining. I face an incoming tide of forgetting, and then oblivion. I no longer possess the courage of my pessimism. When I am dead, and the Marshalls are dead, and the novel is finally published, we will only exist as my inventions. Briony will be as much of a fantasy as the lovers who shared a bed in Balham and enraged their landlady. No one will care what events and which individuals were misrepresented to make a novel. I know there's always a certain kind of reader who will be compelled to ask, But what really happened? The answer is simple: the lovers survive and flourish. As long as there is a single copy, a solitary typescript of my final draft, then my spontaneous, fortuitous sister and her medical prince survive to love.

The problem these fifty-nine years has been this: how can a novelist achieve atonement when, with her absolute power of deciding outcomes, she is also God? There is no one, no entity or higher form that she can appeal to, or be reconciled with, or that can forgive her. There is nothing outside her. In her imagination she has set the limits and the terms. No atonement for God, or novelists, even if they are atheists. It was always an impossible task, and that was precisely the point. The attempt was all.

I've been standing at the window, feeling waves of tiredness beat the remaining strength from my body. The floor seems to be undulating beneath my feet. I've been watching the first gray light bring into view the park and the bridges over the vanished lake. And the long narrow driveway down which they drove Robbie away, into the whiteness. I like to think that it isn't weakness or evasion, but a final act of defiance, a stand against oblivion and despair, to let my lovers live and to unite them at the end. I gave them happiness, but I was not so self-serving as to let them forgive me. Not quite, not yet. If I had the power to conjure them at my birthday celebration . . . Robbie and Cecilia, still alive, still in love, sitting side by side in the library, smiling at *The Trials of Arabella*? It's not impossible.

But now I must sleep.

MOST DECORATED OLYMPIAN EVER

The medal count as Michael Phelps ended his swimming career in London was staggering: 22 in all, including 18 Golds. From London alone, Phelps earned four Golds and a pair of Silvers. The 27-year-old champion officially retired from competitive swimming after the Olympic Games and was vague about his plans for the future. Also in the pool, Colorado's 17-year-old Missy Franklin captivated fans, winning four Golds and a Bronze while setting two new world records. And Ryan Lochte's five new Olympic medals, including two Golds, along with his big personality and good looks, set off a new career on screen — though he already committed to competing in Rio. Ongoing controversy surrounded record-breaking performances by Chinese swimmer Ye Shiwen, 16, who won a pair of IM Golds and smashed world records by delivering times better than either Phelps or Lochte. Proving doubters wrong, Shiwen tested clean for doping.



GOLD THRICE Called "the greatest beach volleyball team of all time," Misty May-Treanor and Kerri Walsh Jennings repeated as women's beach volleyball champions in London. In addition to their three Olympic Golds, the duo won three World Championships before May-Treanor retired. **RECORD-BREAKING** When Carmelita Jeter anchored a world-record effort in the 4x100-meter relay, Team USA won the Gold medal with a scorching time of 40.82 seconds. That mark, the first in history under 41 seconds, broke a record set in 1985.

"FIERCE 5" The U.S. women won the team gymnastics competition, their first team Gold since 1996, by a whopping five points over second place Russia. Because only two from each team can compete, Jordan Wieber was edged out of the individual all-around finals. There, Gabby Douglas earned the individual all-around Gold, Aly Raisman medalled twice and McKayla Maroney's "not impressed" look after winning the Silver medal in the vault finals became an Internet sensation.

BLADE RUNNER While South African double amputee Oscar Pistorius left London an inspiration to many, his reputation lost its shine (and sponsors pulled their endorsements) just months later when he was charged with the murder of his girlfriend, Reeva Steinkamp.



VICTORY Winning the first U.S. women's Gold in judo was just part of Kayla Harrison's story. Molested by her childhood coach, she returned to the mat after opening up to her mother. Kayla committed herself to training harder than ever while her coach sat in prison.



BADMINTON EXPULSION Eight players from three different Asian teams were controversially excluded from the Games for not trying hard enough to win matches. Officials said their attempts to throw early matches violated the Olympic spirit.



DENIED South Korea's Shin A-lam waited more than an hour for her appeal to be heard before leaving the fencing strip. Britta Heidemann of Germany, who advanced to the Gold medal match but lost, was awarded the winning touch.



MORE GOLD Without dropping a set during the Games, sisters Venus and Serena Williams earned Gold in doubles with victories over the Czech Republic and Russia. In addition, Serena took top singles honors, so she — like her sister — owned five Olympic Gold medals.

VOLCAN DE FUEGO A long-simmering volcano in Guatemala produced its most powerful eruption in nearly 40 years in September, hurling thick clouds of ash miles high, spewing glowing rivers of lava and prompting massive evacuation orders.

POWERFUL TEMBLOR Costa Rica's worst quake in over two decades — a tremor measuring 7.6 that was felt as far away as Nicaragua and Panama — sparked landslides, knocked down buildings, disrupted power and briefly triggered a tsunami warning, but caused just two deaths and relatively few injuries.

RECORD SPACE JUMP Austria-born extreme athlete Felix Baumgartner made history on several counts with his feat on Oct. 14. He set the altitude record for a manned balloon flight and the world record for skydiving an estimated 24 miles. Plus, he reached an estimated speed of 843.6 mph — or Mach 1.25 — to record the greatest free-fall velocity, becoming the first person to break the sound barrier without vehicular power on his descent before landing in eastern New Mexico.

TRIUMPH IN SPACE After years of planning and months of interplanetary travel, the NASA rover/robotic laboratory Curiosity landed safely on Mars to study the Gale Crater's terrain. **A BLUE MOON** A second full moon in August presented the rare celestial phenomenon, which will next occur in 2015.





DISNEY BUYS LUCASFILM

Filmmaker George Lucas accepted millions of shares of Disney stock in a deal worth more than \$4 billion. Immediately after the acquisition was announced, Disney released plans for the next addition to the Star Wars saga in 2015. **GROWING ANTARCTIC ICE SHEET** While Arctic sea ice has been diminishing for decades, the Antarctic sea shelf has grown for seven consecutive years. A new NASA study showed that the sea ice surrounding Antarctica grew by roughly 6,600 square miles in 2012.

SUPERSTORM SANDY The largest Atlantic hurricane on record — with winds spanning 1,100 miles — Sandy devastated parts of the Caribbean, the Mid-Atlantic and the northeastern U.S. in late October. In addition to at least 285 people killed in seven countries, damage estimates topped \$75 billion. The severe damage, as well as the storm's unusual merge with a frontal system, resulted in the nickname.

FOUR MORE YEARS After nearly 20 months doing double duty as president and candidate, Barack Obama was re-elected for a second term. Beginning in April, 2011, Obama travelled the nation seeking support. From those who backed his Affordable Healthcare Act and the record numbers who saw early voting as increased opportunity to those who rallied for Obama, Americans had many chances to gather with others seeking to see/hear the president as he campaigned from coast to coast.



HOFSTRA SHOWDOWN After an unexpected less-than-stellar performance by President Obama in the first debate in Denver, the Romney campaign had the advantage of momentum going into the second debate — the only use of the town hall format — on campus in NY. **YOUR TURN** The vice presidential debate allowed candidates Paul Ryan and Joe Biden to share their views on both foreign and domestic topics. While there seemed to be agreement that the debate didn't affect voter decisions, both sides claimed that their candidate out-performed the opponent.

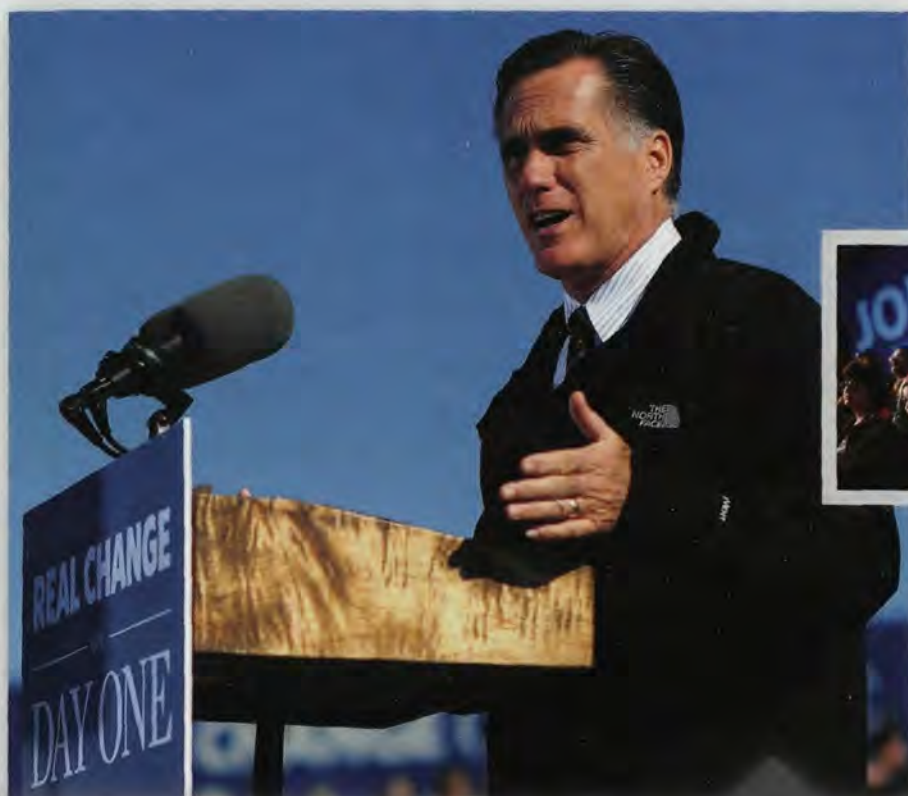

GOP CANDIDATE Mitt Romney, the former governor of Massachusetts, formally announced his second candidacy for the presidency of the United States on June 2, 2011, in Stratham, NH, after working years to build a strategy for the campaign and a nationwide network of supporters eager for him to run again.



INAUGURATION DAY Since Jan. 20, 2013, was Sunday, the inauguration took place the next day. Nearly 1 million people attended festivities in D.C. **@FLOTUS** First Lady Michelle Obama celebrated her 49th birthday — and the inauguration — by cutting her bangs and introducing her new Twitter account.



SYRIAN WAR

The U.N. estimated a death toll of more than 70,000 after nearly two years of ongoing armed conflict in Syria. **WAR'S IMPACT** The uprising also displaced 1.2 million Syrians within the country and led hundreds of thousands to escape to safety.

DISCOVERY IN SPACE

NASA's Voyager 1 spacecraft uncovered a new layer of the solar system that scientists hadn't known was there. **ROYAL**

BABY Prince William and Kate Middleton announced a July due date for their first child.

RADIATION ROBOT

Toshiba unveiled a robot designed to assist in nuclear disasters.

UNUSUAL VENUE After a single college basketball game aboard a decommissioned aircraft carrier in 2011, several pre-season match ups were scheduled for Veteran's Day weekend 2012. SPRINT CUP CHAMP In his third season, Brad Keselowski won five races on his way to the NASCAR Sprint Cup title. **A NEW PRESIDENT** Enrique Peña Nieto was sworn in as Mexico's 19th president since the Mexican Revolution, bringing the democratic PRI back to power after a 12-year hiatus.





FIFA CLUB WORLD CUP

Corinthians (Brazil) won the 2012 FIFA Club World Cup title for the second time, defeating Chelsea (Britain) 1-0 in the final. The tournament included the champion clubs from six continental confederations and Japan, the host nation. **FISCAL CLIFF** After much debate, the House approved a Senate bill designed to block hefty tax increases and delay severe budget cuts scheduled to take effect in the new year. According to President Barack Obama, the increases "could have sent the economy back into recession."

MTV noted Psy's rise from little-known to "global superstar," and, declaring him first in the YouTube-era to secure a place in pop culture history, hailed the singer as the "Viral Star of 2012."



GUN CONTROL The debate over gun control took center stage after several high profile shootings focused attention on the ease of acquiring weapons. While public opinion polls showed support for stricter gun laws, gun sales grew — due to concerns about potential changes in gun laws.

CONFESSION In an exclusive interview with Oprah, famed cyclist Lance Armstrong admitted to taking performance-enhancing drugs in all seven of his Tour de France wins. Armstrong was banned from competition for life and stripped of all his medals. **NHL LOCKOUT ENDS** After a four-month delay caused by labor negotiations, the National Hockey League's 48-game regular season began on Jan. 19. Once a possible resolution was proposed, the league's 700 union members voted electronically to approve the deal. In all, 510 games were lost to the lockout.

NASCAR CRASH More than 30 fans were injured when a car rammed into the fence, hurling debris into the stands at the Nationwide race preceding the season-opening Daytona 500. News of the crash nearly upstaged Danica Patrick's earning the pole.



FEBRUARY NOR'EASTER

When two weather systems merged over the northeast, New England and Atlantic Canada received as much as 40 inches of snow accompanied by gusty winds. **JUST PLAIN FUN** In addition to winning Best Song for "We Are Young," New York City's hip-hop-inspired group, Fun., was crowned Best New Artist at the Grammys, and received two other nominations.



TURKISH EMBASSY EXPLOSION

A suicide bomber from a far-left terrorist group killed a security guard at the U.S. Embassy in Ankara, blowing the door off an entrance and sending smoke and debris flying into the street.

The Ravens were ahead 21-6 when Beyoncé took the stage for a halftime extravaganza that included a Destiny's Child reunion. After a prolonged power outage in the stadium, the momentum changed and the 49ers outscored Baltimore 25-13 in the second half. Ravens QB Joe Flacco, MVP, and his team held on to win 34-31.

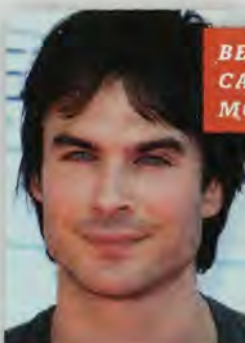
