Breadan T. Byrne to shift responsibility for balancing the new state budget to the Legislature was "welcomed" by Assemblyman Robert Franks, who represents Rahway and Clark.

"The decision guarantees full debate on cost-cutting initiatives," Assemblyman Franks said.

"Had the governor presented a hudget balanced with a specific new tax program, it would have been easier for the legislature to rubber-stamp the whole package. Now, those of us inseressed in flading ways to trim the fat will have a forum for debate," he added.

Gov. Byrne has forecast a gap in the fiscal 1981 budget exceeding \$200 million. Earlier administration estimates were as high as \$280 million.
