REMOVAL

The House of Representatives today passed a bill to remove the name of the late President John F. Kennedy from the title of the National Defense University. The bill, which was introduced by Rep. James W. Thompson (R-Mich.), passed by a vote of 317 to 100.

The bill, H.R. 10000, would amend the National Defense University Act of 1956 to change the name of the university from the "John F. Kennedy School of Government" to the "National Defense University."

The bill was passed in a 10-hour session that began at 10:30 a.m. and ended at 8:30 p.m. The vote was taken after a lengthy debate on the floor of the House.

Rep. Thompson said the bill was necessary to honor the memory of the late President and to recognize the university's role in national defense. He said the university had been a source of controversy since its inception, and the removal of the President's name was a necessary step to resolve the controversy.
