The war news has made great excitement in Wall street, gold having reached \$123 on Tuesday.

Two attempts have been made recently in Newark to assassinate the dead Union League, the secret radical organization that flourished during the war and for a time after, but the effort proved fruitless. The first meeting was attended by one person, and the second by four. Under League rule it is failing for lack of men.

New Jersey is specially favored by the President in the appointment of important officers. While some of the Republican papers of the state endeavor to ridicule the recent meeting of the Democratic Editors, others more experienced recognize the movement as a very strong one in the interest of the Democratic. The Morris *Democrat*, edited by the veteran Van Slyck, says: "We think this meeting settles the point that the Democracy in this state will present an united and determined front at the fall election; that it will be fully held, and that it will stand to lose if it must cast aside all local, sectional and personal partnerships, and make the unity and strength of its members the party parameter to all other considerations. And we hold that before this fact is known, and before it is fully wake up to it, the rest of the country will make our understanding of the situation of this comparatively little service. Instead of laughing at this gathering of Democratic Editors and politicians, we shall find it wise in the long run to organize for their defeat."

## WAR IN EUROPE.

The war cloud which has been hanging over Europe has at length burst, and the reports received during the shock are reverberating through the world. The war, as far as between France and Prussia, is decided, and the French have lost all hope of peace or of a truce, excepting a short time. The cause of the war is off, influence being used in the French camp, as follows:

First. The family of King Louis Philippe benefits the French Minister, and its influence by the French Government.

Second. The influence of King Leopold of Belgium, who, as a Frenchman, is for the Prussian side.

Third. The influence of Prince Metternich, who, as a Frenchman, is for the German side.

This is a very small part of the story, but the greatest was the withdrawal by France and the challenge prompted by Prussia.

It is said the French have been secretly making preparations for this war for months past.

The sympathies of America seem to be almost unanimous with Prussia, and we do not see any cause for otherwise, when the subject is viewed in its proper light. As an evidence, certainly says, the responsibility rests with the French, and whatever was established, destroyed, or injured in human suffering there may be, it will surely be charged to Louis Philippe. No man in the present generation has had less reason to call upon us. In our judgment, he has but a single justification. The cause of France is only a pretense. When Spain offered her throne to the Prince of Hohenlohe, France interposed her objection and demanded of Prussia that she refuse to allow a member of the reigning family to accept the viceregency. Because of that objection, Prince Leopold declined the proffered throne, which should have headed the wounded honor of France. But Napoleon was got satisfied. He makes his new demand of Prussia, one which we think he had no right to demand, that she shall pledge herself never to allow a prince of her house to sit on the throne of Spain. This demand was made under a threat of war, it was not complied with, and the King of Prussia very properly declined to accede to it. If Prussia had yielded to the demand of a powerful country like France, under a bullying threat, there would be declared if it were agreed to, she would have disgraced in the eyes of the world. A nation that has agreed to such a demand, even when in the wrong.
