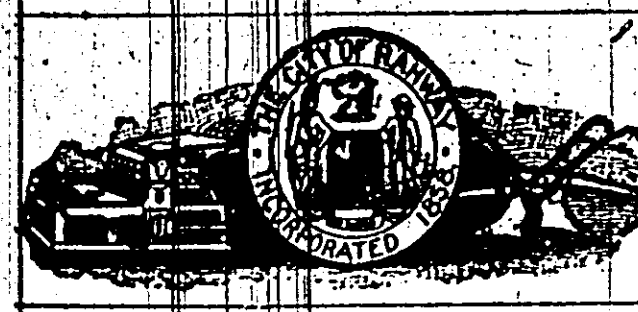

Proceedings of the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Hudson.

ELIZABETH, N. J., April 17, 1890.

Regular meeting of the board of chosen freeholders of Hudson county, held on Thursday, April 17, 1890, at 2:00 o'clock P. M.

Present: Director Hubbard, and Freeholders Brian, Day, Donahue, Howard, Houghton, Jones, Kline, Kleinman, Piersen, Roll, Thompson, Vanderhook, Van Sledright, West, Winkey—17.

Absent: None.

The minutes of last meeting (omitting list of bills ordered paid) were read and on motion approved.

A committee from Elizabeth city council who desired to be heard in relation to extension of adoption of county road from city line to North Broad street, through Westfield avenue to North Broad street in the city of Elizabeth, were upon motion of Freeholder West given unanimous consent to be heard.

After remarks by Mayor John C. B. Canine, ex-City Attorney, City Attorney J. A. Fay and County Attorney J. A. Campbell and the reading of petitions from taxpayers and citizens, Freeholder West moved the petition be referred to committee of the whole.

Which was adopted unanimously.

From committee of the whole:

To the board of chosen freeholders of Hudson county:

GENTLEMEN:

The committee of the whole would report and recommend that the city of Elizabeth, be adopted as a county road from North Broad street, through Westfield avenue, inside the city line of Elizabeth, by means of a direct line if necessary.

Freeholder West moved the adoption of report in section.

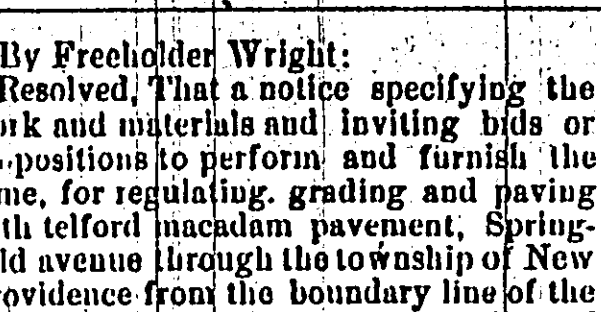
