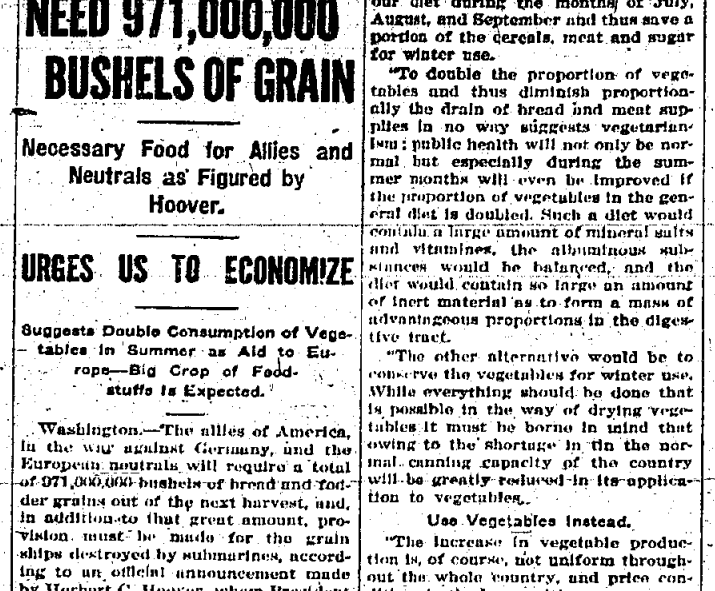

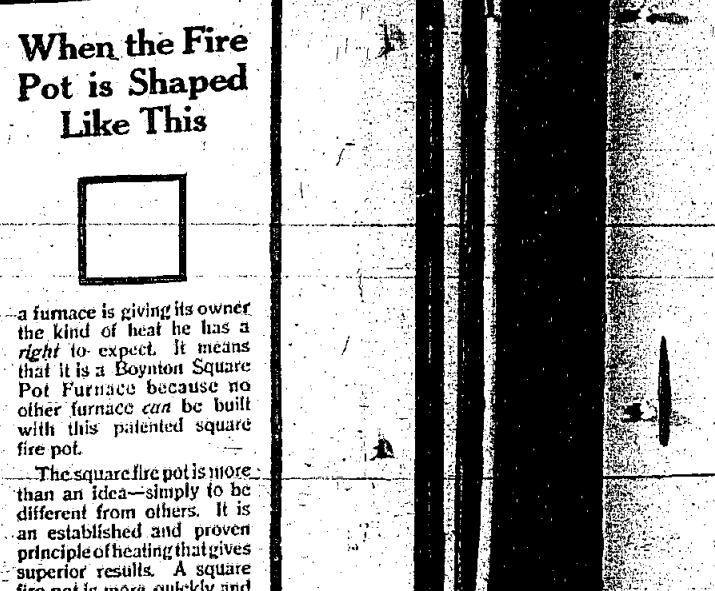

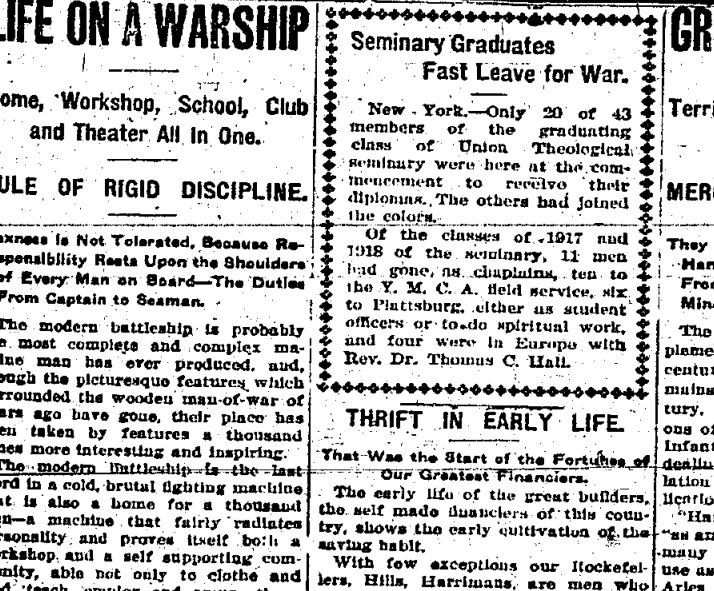

Then add the rest of the flour, sugar, lard and salt.

Knead to minutes after dough is on the board and let rise until double in bulk. In kneading keep the dough as soft as possible. Greasing the hands will help greatly. Mould into loaves, half fill the pans and let rise until double in bulk. Brush melted butter over the tops and bake for 45 minutes.
