and would be much more attractive. He said that many of the properties in the section of the Third Ward and the district would now sell for \$1500 to \$2000, but two-family houses placed beside them would tend to detract from their value. He stated that if a man held an undeveloped lot in the section for which he would build a two-family structure it would be better for him to sell the lot and obtain one where there are no restrictions desired on comparable houses.

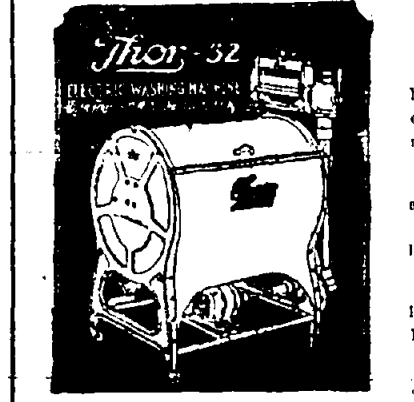

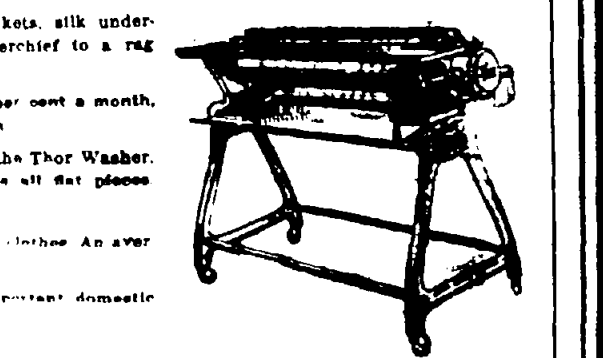
