CONVENTION REPORT

(Continued from Page One)

Robert J. Hendon, president of the Jersey City Club, was elected to the second George R. Geller, of Newark, as governor of the New Jersey district. Hendon, however, named more than 100,000 of Newark, president of the North Hudson club, and Dr. William J. Carleton, president of the Atlantic City club, William H. MacIntyre, of Albany Park, were elected trustees. The secretary will be appointed by the new governor. Appointment of a committee to study the possibility of constructing a recreation center at the shore for underprivileged children and their mothers was authorized at the closing business session of the convention. District Treasurer Hudson W. G. was responsible for the move to erect a shore recreation station. He suggested that it be situated somewhere between the Atlantic Highlands and Cape May and would be as well for their children for a week's vacation. He expressed the belief that the plan is financially practicable.

Charles E. Henderson, of Atlantic City, then moved the appointment of a committee to discuss and perfect plans for the center. The committee will submit recommendations to the district trustees.

Upholding the recommendations of the district trustees, the convention adopted a resolution calling for the district trustees to prepare a plan for the public highways. The various clubs were urged to unite in eliminating play-walking and existing the cooperation of State and municipal authorities to wage war against speeding and to teach children and adults to use necessary care in crossing the streets.

Other resolutions approved included those recommending the adoption by the district and by the clubs of the United States flag; the preservation of a history of the activities of each club; the organization of a district-wide system of meetings by each club throughout the year; and a resolution that the summer session of the Jersey City club, with an average of 34 per cent, with the attendance of 100,000, having over 100 members, and Albany Park, averaging 52 per cent, the club for 1934 under 100 members. Newark won the other trophy offered for efficiency and Atlantic City captured the trophy for convention attendance.

Atlantic City was chosen for the 1934 convention of the district. Speakers at Saturday afternoon session included International Trustee H. Walter Gill, of Atlantic City, the Rev. P. M. Simons, of Passaicville, chairman of the grievances committee; Charles E. Henderson, of Jersey City, chairman of the interclub relations committee; Dr. Matt Pearce of Orange, chairman of the publicity committee; Lieutenant Governor William S. Elmer, of Atlantic City, chairman of resolutions committee; and Conrad J. Broderick, of Newark, chairman of the executive committee.

Caricatures and illustrations of the part of motorists and pedestrians were blamed by the visiting governor in his recommendation that proper corrective measures be taken to prevent loss of life and accidents. In closing, the New Jersey club of the district united in an educational campaign to back the continuous "not for a day's work" but in such a manner that the facts would be constantly before the public.

The feature of the morning session was an address by that International Trustee George R. Geller, of Newark, Canada. Jules Bratt, of 115 Commerce street, the immediate past leader, "pegged things up" throughout the day.
