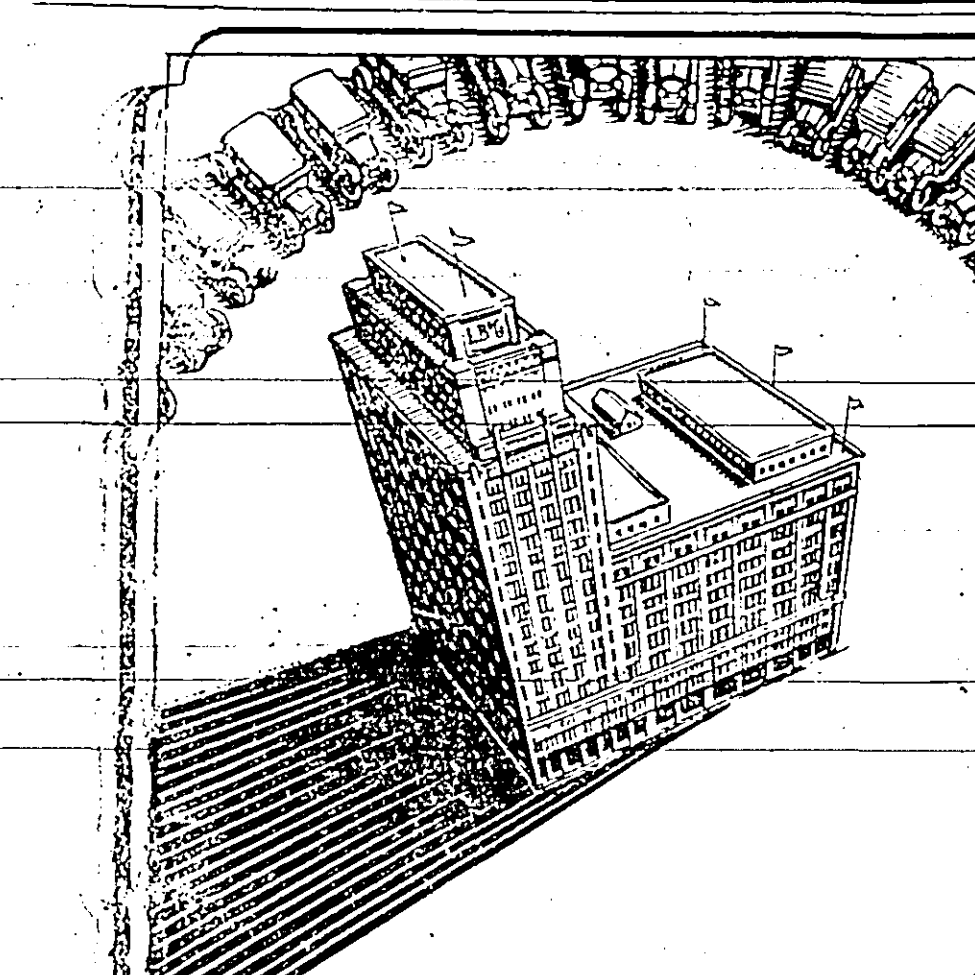

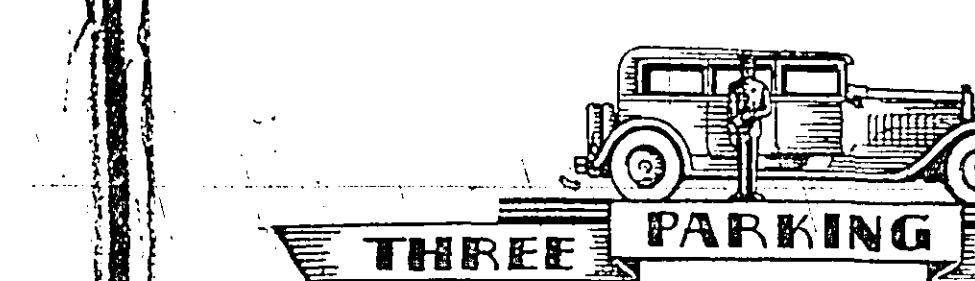

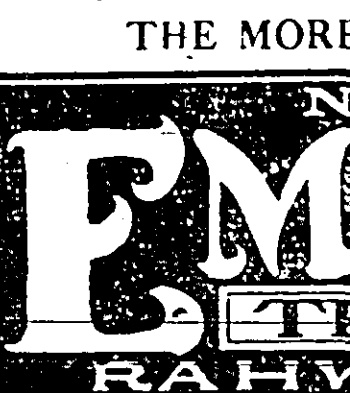
331 New Buses Ordered By Public Service Co.
