Wear Shows Defects of Car by Rumbling Noise

One of the best ways to find out what is wrong with your car is to listen for a rumbling noise. A rumbling noise is usually caused by a problem with the engine or the transmission. If you hear a rumbling noise, stop the car and check the engine and transmission.

Reason Why Rear Tires Are Often Punctured

The fact that the rear tires are often punctured is
