





Co-operating with the radio service of the department, the stations broad-cast for farm listeners one ten-minute talk each week to May 1.

Two zeries of talks are given: "Living With-the Corn Bover," for broad-cast in states invaded by the insect, and "If the Corn Borer Comes." for farmers in states not yet reached by


