

## Jersey Scene of Epochal Air Communication Tests

**Bell Laboratories at Whippany "Take the Air" in an Effort to Develop the Best Means for Voyagers to Talk to Land.**

Whippany, New Jersey, is now the scene of another important series of experiments in the field of telephone and radio communication. The experiments recently begun there by the Bell Telephone Laboratories have to do with developing the most effective means of radio communication between an airplane in flight and land, the vital importance of which is obvious.

A trim cabin monoplane built by the Fairchild Airplane Manufacturing Company has been delivered to the Bell Telephone Laboratories at Whippany, and the Bell Telephone Laboratories have added to their staff of experts an airplane pilot who is A. R. Brooks, formerly a Captain in the United States Air Service.

Taking form in a broad study of radio-communication between ground and plane, the field investigation will first concern itself with the effectiveness of various types of antennas, and with the effect on transmission of the plane's height above ground. In this work, the Bell Telephone Laboratories are working in cooperation with the United States Army. Graduating from Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1911, he was assigned to the United States Army, where he served for several years. During his service in France, he was in the front lines, and he has been identified with military aviation in several capacities, with commercial aviation.
