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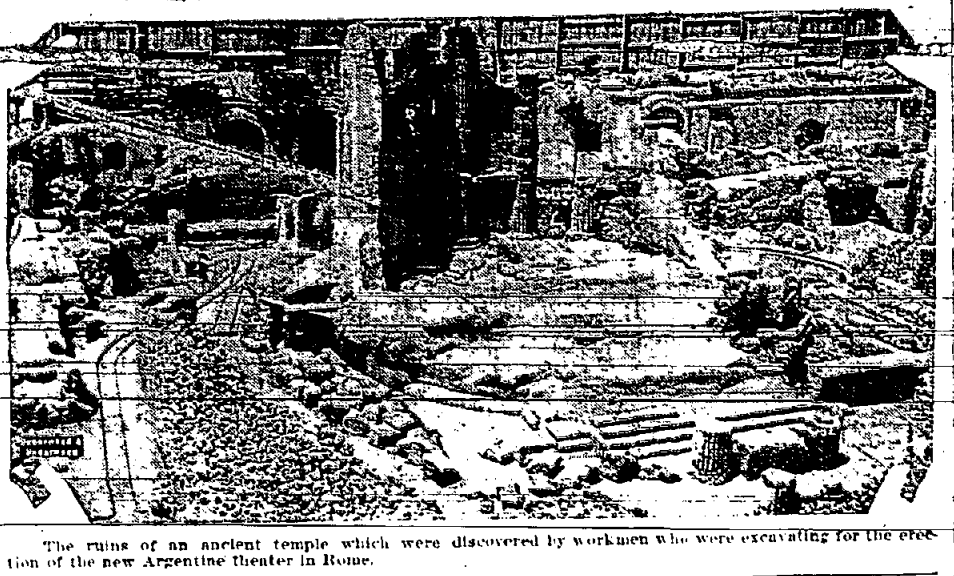

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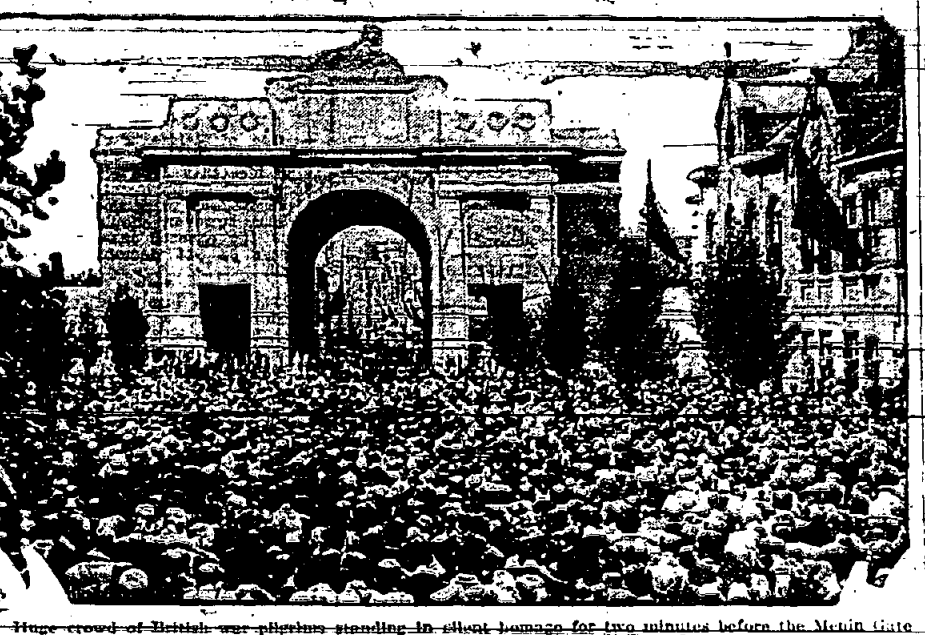
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British War Pilgrims at Menin Gate, Ypres

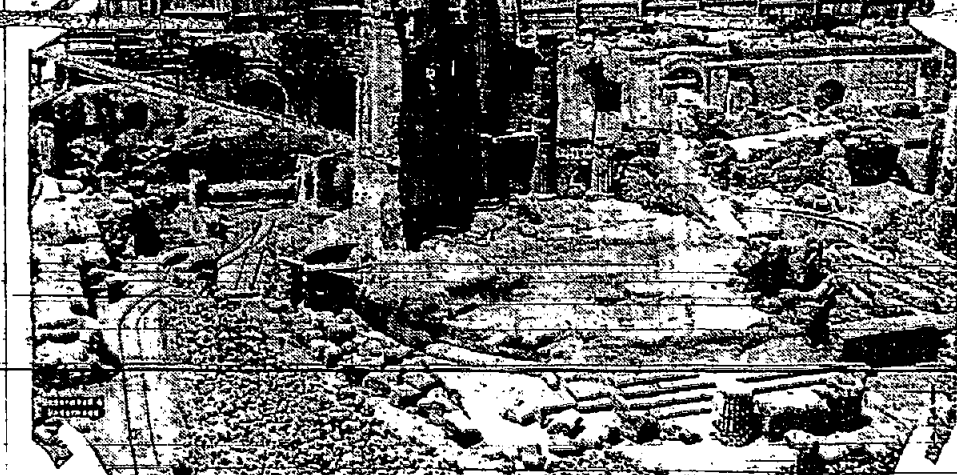

The Rahway boys are among the first group to be admitted under the new, more stringent entrance requirements instituted by the University. They will be the first to enter the University under the new plan.

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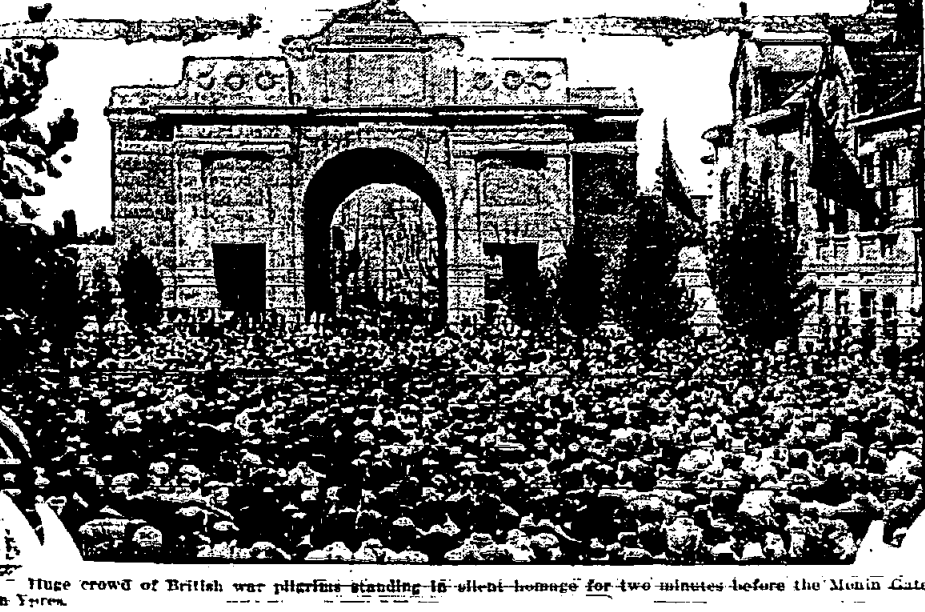
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British War Pilgrims at Menin Gate, Ypres

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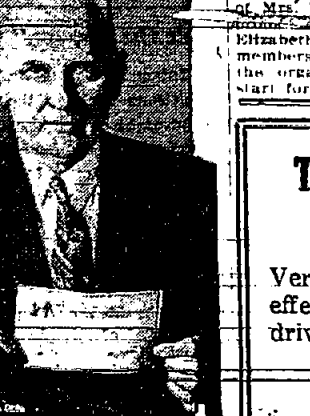
