FIREFTELLS OLD INDIAN HISTORY WORTH BILLIONS

Preserves Relics of Pueblo Tribe; Inhabitants Were Trapped.

Washington.—A tragic catastrophe which laid waste to two thousand years ago is now proving an exceptionally favorable period for presenting the charred ruins of the ancient city of the Pueblos. A Smithsonian scientist, who every summer has found there important evidence of a missing link in American history, says:

"The village is in a remote district of the Colorado Plateau, in the San Pedro River. Dr. Frank H. H. Roberts, a Smithsonian archaeologist, says: "Three years ago we found a variety of skulls, many bones and pottery. These finds are now being studied by scientists, and Dr. Roberts believes that they may be the remains of the Indians who were the last to live in the village."

The older known inhabitants of the village, the Hopis, have been living in the same house since the days of their ancestors. These were followed by the cliff-dwelling Indians, who brought with them the first signs of high intelligence and the first records.

Fate of Basketmakers
"Our work is to reconstruct the architecture and an understanding of the culture of the ancient Indians," says Dr. Roberts. "We have found what happened to these Basketmakers in the course of civilization." He says:


