YOU, YOUR CAR AND THE MOTOR LAWS

Editorial Note: This series of articles by the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles is published for the purpose of making it clear to the motorist what is right and what is wrong in the law, and to show him the reasons for the law. It is developed on the principle that the license is granted only on proof of the knowledge of the rules of the road and the ability to drive with reasonable safety.

Examinations are held in thirty centers throughout the State. The Chief Inspector, or a deputy chief inspector, is in charge, assisted by a number of inspectors who give the examinations. Applicants are required to have a permit, entitling them to drive for three weeks. It is accompanied by a license driver's permit and a license driver's permit. Two days must elapse between the issuance of this permit and the actual examination. The license driver's permit is issued by another State official. If an applicant holds a license issued by another State, it is not necessary to take an examination. The license driver's permit is valid for three weeks.
