FRAZER CALM

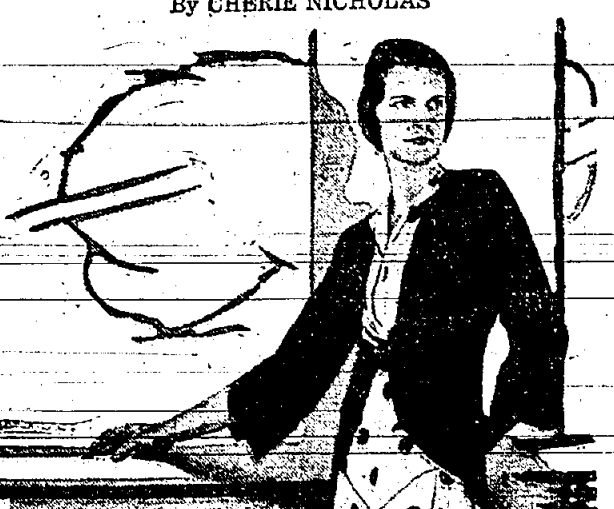

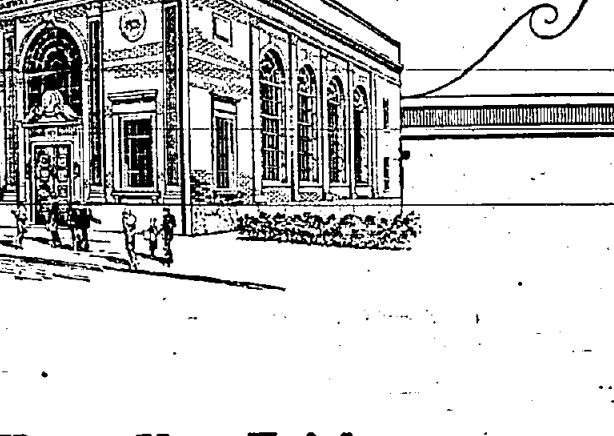
