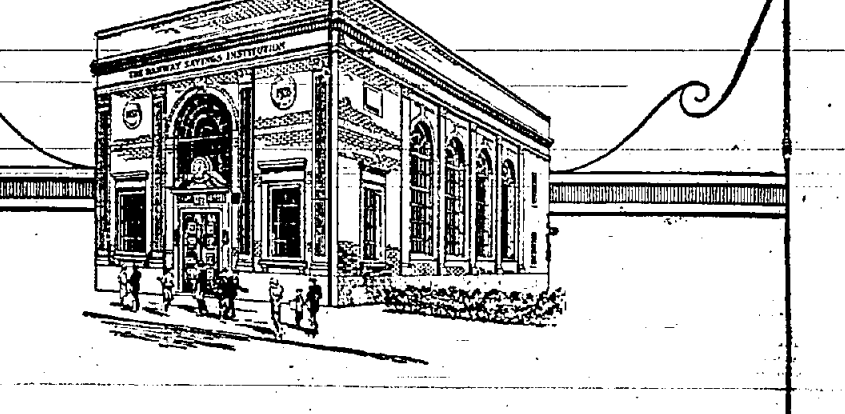

School Board Acts Wisely Realizing the present financial condition of the city, the Board of Education acted wisely in further altering the plans and specifications for the proposed Junior High School in order to bring the cost of the building down to \$300,000.

The figure of \$300,000 does not mean that the school, which will probably be constructed at this price, will be the same as that planned at \$450,000, except that many unnecessary features will be eliminated.

With the school authorities making every sacrifice possible it is only right that the Board of School Estimate and the Common Council approve this new figure as soon as possible so that work might begin at once on the new structure.

The fact that Rahway gained little satisfaction from the Joint Meeting in this latest ultimatum should not be any shock as this city has never been given any consideration in the project since its inception.

A shining example of how costly delay can be was shown Tuesday night when the Joint Meeting replied to the resolution received from Rahway on the trunk sewer project.

Since the special meeting last December the Common Council, to our knowledge, did not seek any further advice from the consulting engineers. Despite the receipt of the supplemental contract some months ago, which was far from satisfactory to this city, the matter was not given much extensive consideration until recent weeks during which time a frantic effort has been made to recoup lost ground.

Rahway should not accept the latest report of the Joint Meeting as a final rebuke but should use this as a stimulus for concentrated action in an effort to gain some of their points.

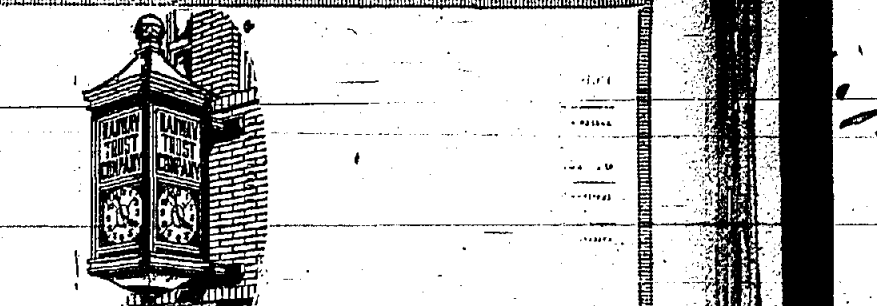
