Announcement was made that the members of the Rahway fire and police departments, teachers in the local schools, and city employees had responded 100 percent to the appeal for donations. Their figures have been obtained.

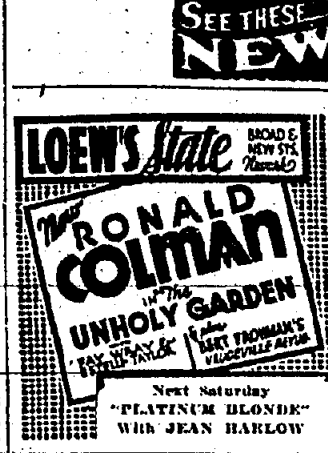

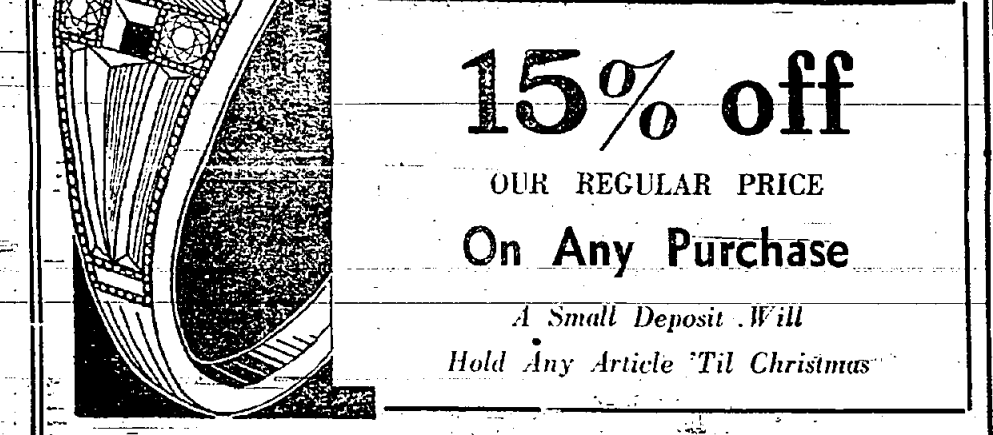

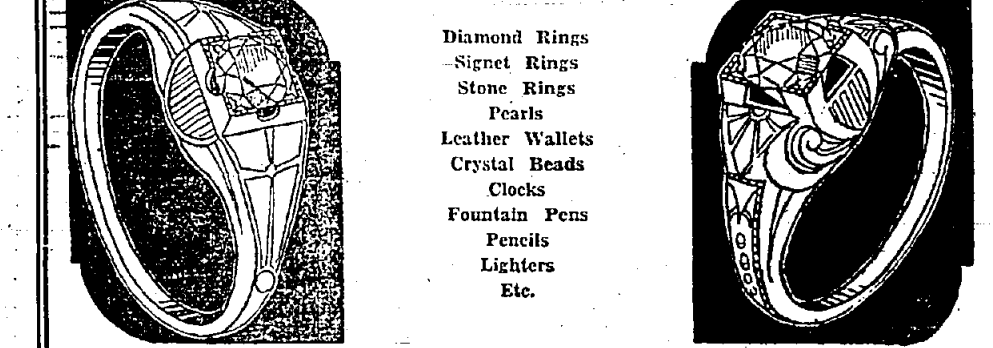

## Athletics Give Boy Self-Confidence

Rutgers Speaker Says Sports Of Great Value To Youth

Participation in athletics gives a growing boy self-confidence which will be of great value to him in after life, according to Professor James H. Reilly of Rutgers University, who spoke on "Your Boy and His Athletics" over Station WOR Monday afternoon.

"We must admit that there is a possibility of injury in all sports," he said, "but there are hazards also in life itself. Participation in athletics will help your son to avoid danger. It will teach him to direct properly his own activities, to react quickly to a given situation. It will develop his reflexes, give him a sense of confidence in his ability to take care of himself. Facing a dangerous situation, the trained athlete will react instinctively, while the boy who has never taken part in athletics will be at a loss as to what action to take. Ultimately, you will ignore the possibility of minor hurts and permit him to engage in competitive sports with other boys of his age."

Professor Reilly recommended baseball, hockey, tennis and golf as beneficial forms of sports for the adolescent boy, and strongly emphasized the value of swimming. He suggested that running be limited to shorter distances until a boy has attained his full growth.

"If your son has no aptitude at all for athletics," he said, "you should see that he exercises; that he takes his daily down in the morning, that he goes for long walks and works at intervals in the garden. If possible he should attend classes at the 'Y' and above all, you should insist that he learn to swim."

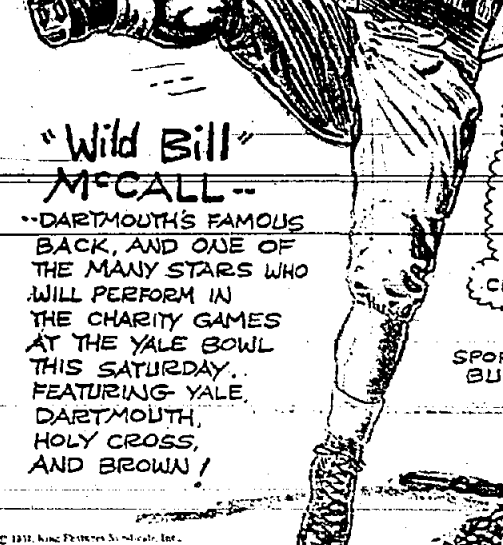

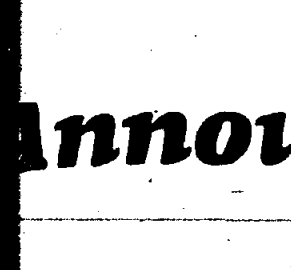
