Trenton, June 26.—Employment and wage increases in New Jersey industries in May were the greatest of any month since the start of the depression, according to a report by the Commissioner of Labor.

The additional number employed was 6,817, an increase of 4.7 percent. Payrolls increased 6.5 percent, and average weekly earnings rose from \$20.52 to \$20.65.

The code provides that minimum wages for male employees shall be \$10 a week for senior clerks and \$12 a week for junior clerks, with maximum working hours of 41.5 hours a week, and a two-hour day, and for female employees the minimum pay shall be \$11 a week for senior clerks and \$13 a week for junior clerks, and that the maximum hours shall be 40 hours a week and a nine-hour day. It is provided that these wages shall be one dollar a week less for all classes in states south of the Mason and Dixon line.

MacDonald Calls for Aid

London, June 26.—Prime Minister MacDonald, president of the World Economic Conference, has sent a hurried appeal to President Roosevelt to help save the conference from a complete breakdown.

MacDonald's appeal emerged from a crisis that developed when Europe's policy "told him" led by France, delivered in ultimatum, demanding temporary stabilization of the dollar and pound sterling at the price of keeping the conference alive.
