

Cuban Dictatorship Five Moves To Halt "Foreign Intervention"

Havana, Cuba, Sept. 8.—With the American intervention as the watchword, the Cuban Communist dictatorship five moves today to wipe out any excuse for a possible landing of American troops on the island.

Leaders of many parties that have been at the forefront during the days that followed the downfall of the Machado regime, and the subsequent overthrow on Tuesday of the short-lived reign of President de Cespedes, gathered in the Presidential palace and conferred with the dictatorship of five and built the foundation for a bold and united front against "foreign intervention."

Two additional American warships were off Havana today. The cruiser Richmond from the Panama Canal Zone last night joined the destroyer Macfarland, off the Moleon opposite the Maine monument, and the National Hotel where American residents are concentrated.

The destroyer Bainbridge, out of Norfolk, Virginia, followed the Richmond to anchor. A fourth American war vessel, the destroyer Sturdevant, is at Santiago.
