Police Arrest Dr. Wynekoop In Chicago Murder Mystery

Chicago, Nov. 24.—In a dramatic move late last night, Chief Deputy Coroner Albert Brody demanded that Dr. Alice L. Wynekoop be formally arrested and held at the Millmore street police station.

He also demanded that her son, Earle, whose wife Rheta, was found shot to death Tuesday night in the Wynekoop mansion, be held in the cell where he was placed yesterday for questioning. He asked that neither be permitted to leave the station pending imminent developments.

Detective squads left at once for the Wynekoop home to take Dr. Wynekoop in custody.

Brody's action was taken after Virgil Grant, assistant coroner's physician, reported he had found sufficient chloroform in the organs of Earle's wife to completely anesthetize a person.

Authorities regard this as strengthening their theory that the young woman was first chloroformed and then shot to death.

President Will Stand by Policy

Warm Springs, Ga., Nov. 24.—Despite recent criticism of his monetary policy, President Roosevelt is going to stand by the present program and ignore the challenge to defend his position.

The gold program was launched as an acknowledged experiment and in administration circles, it is felt no answer can or should be made to criticism until the outcome is known.

There have been concerted efforts to force a White House statement by an intermittent harassing fire of criticism, but it is definitely learned these efforts have come to naught.

Arrest Pair for Fraud

Newark, Nov. 24.—Jay Connolly, for 30 years an employee of this city and at present employed as a bond clerk in the office of the city treasurer, was arrested last night on a charge of having obtained money under false pretenses in connection with the sale of concessions in the new Pennsylvania railroad station now under construction here.

Arrested with him on a similar charge was Charles Gerard, 45, of 153 West Colonial avenue.

Connolly is 45 and lives at High and Clinton streets, this city.

According to the complaint filed against the two, they are alleged to have obtained money from five men with the promise that they would obtain concessions in the new station for the men who gave them the money. The concessions were not forthcoming nor did the railroad authorities know anything about the concessions, the complainants claimed.
