The Home Garden

Now that winter has started it is time to protect hardy outdoor plants. Keep the garden in a dormant stage for the rest of the year.

Plants should be covered with the old tops of anything that is left in the garden. Evergreens require a wrapping in burlap. Exchange and other wood plants may be protected with a wire screen around which chicken wire has been placed about six inches from the outside of the branches and leaves packed between the wire frame and the chicken wire.

Underground plants that do not carry any top over the winter may be covered with leaves. From the bottom of the leaves over bulbs such as gladioli, then cover the leaves with a piece of building paper.
