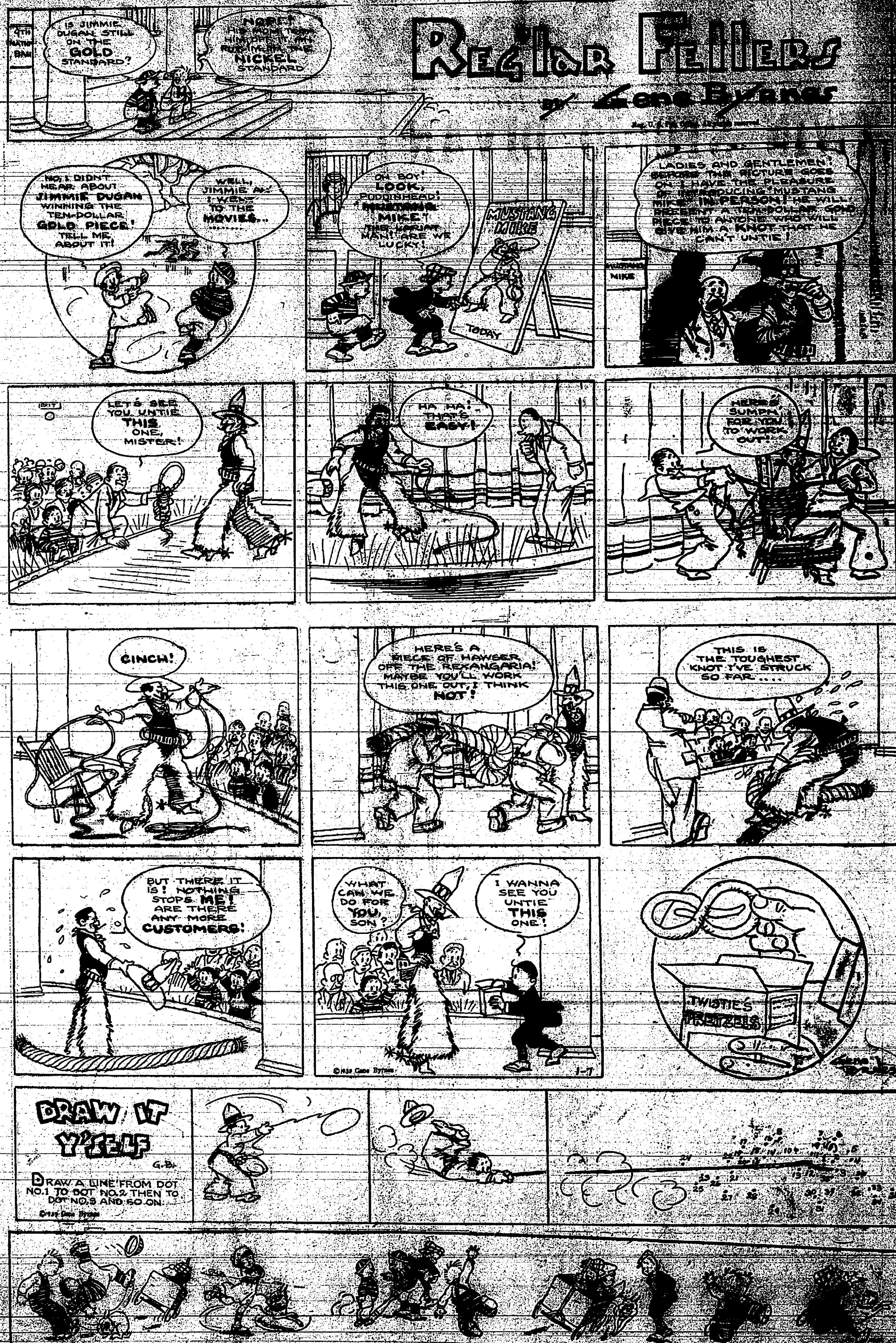

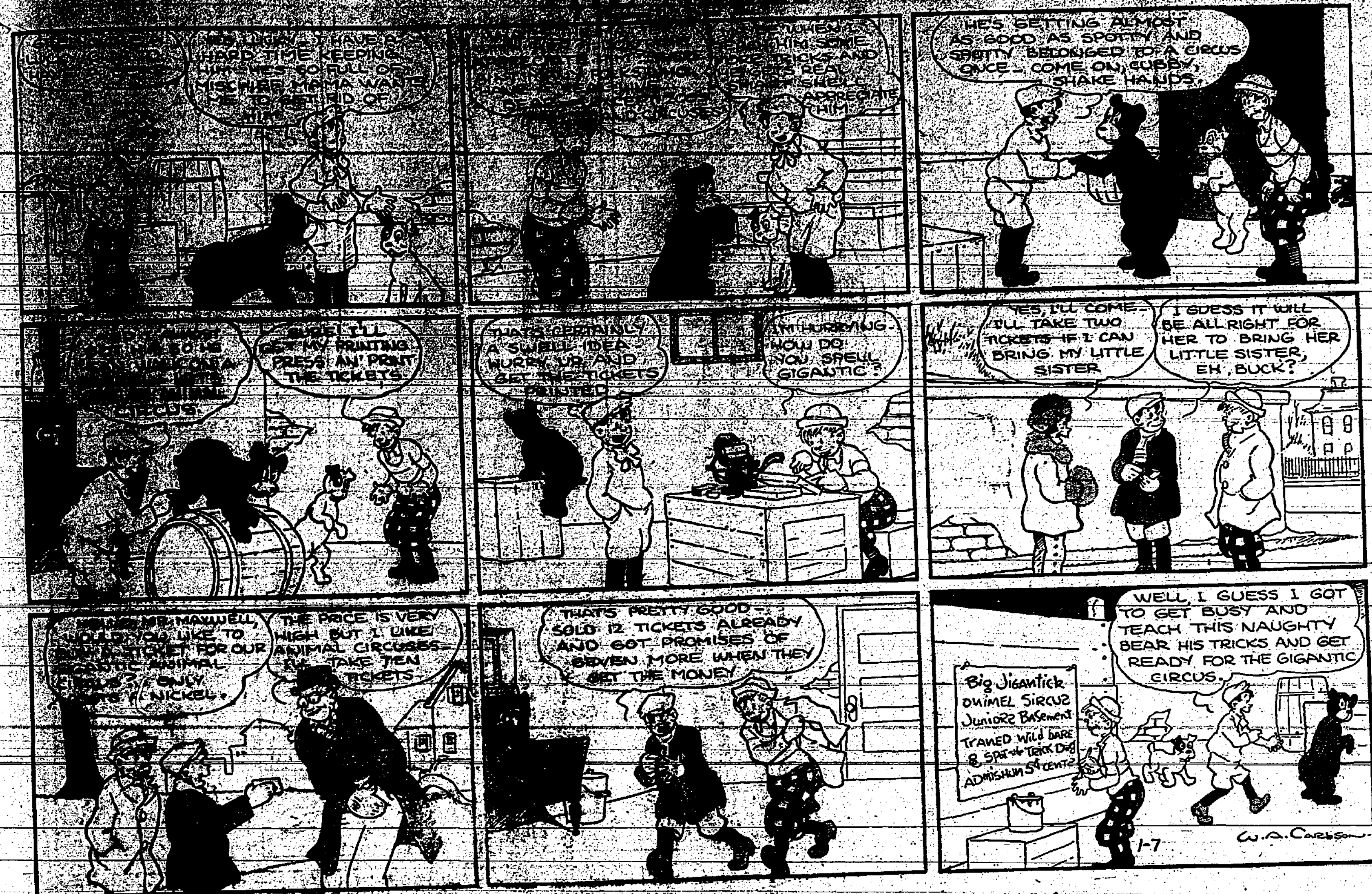

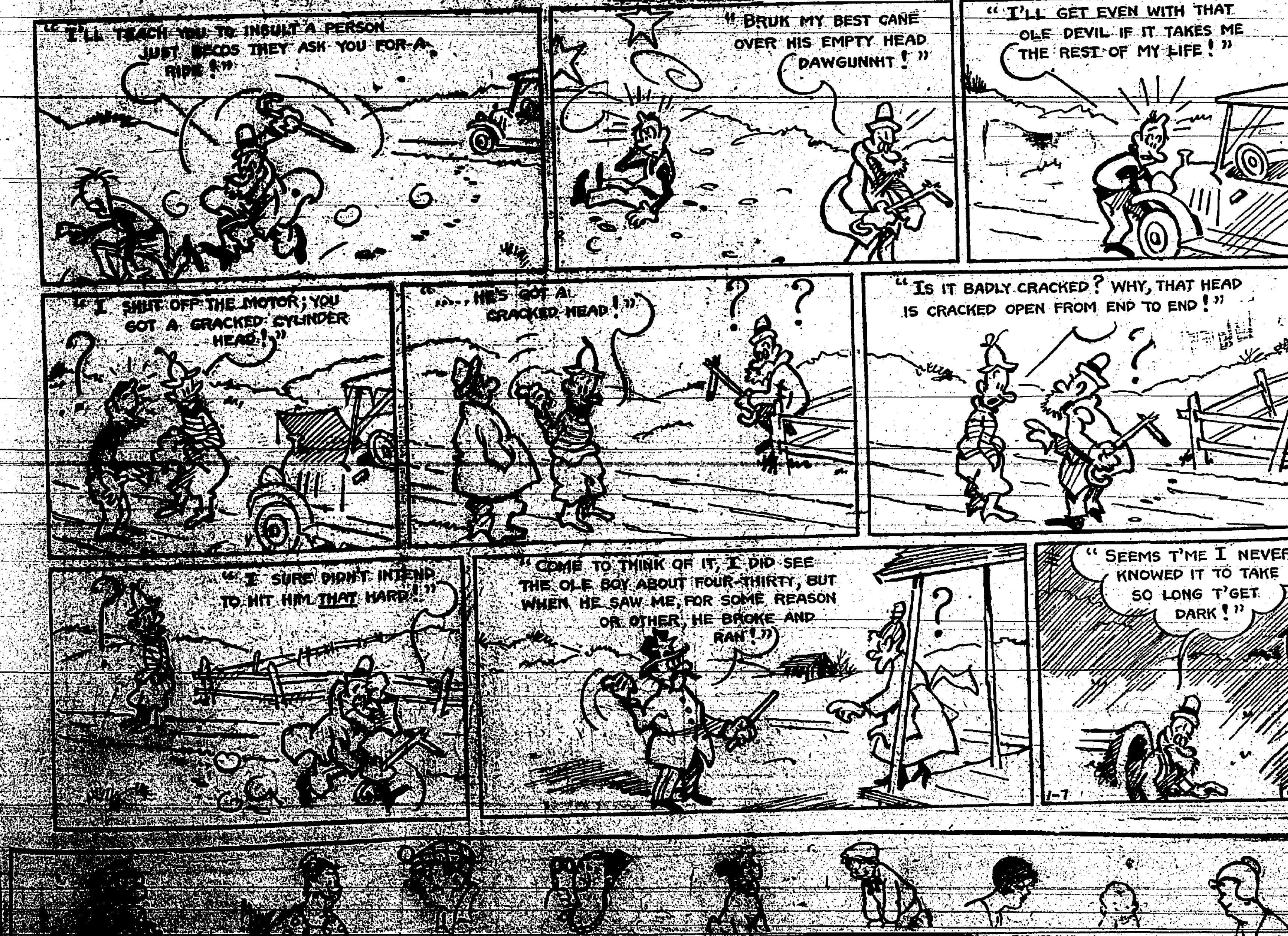

Trenton, Jan. 16.—A bill by Herbert Pascoe, Republican of Union county, to amend the election law, was before the state assembly. The measure provides for the holding of primary elections in September instead of May.

Upholds R. R. Tax Laws

Trenton, Jan. 16.—Dr. Harley Lutz, Princeton, today reported to the legislative committee on revision of railroad tax laws, that in his opinion New Jersey's present laws can be successfully administered if the state is given authority to fix valuations. Assessments at the present are determined by local assessors and it is on their figures that the average rate by which the railroads are taxed is fixed.

Would Abolish Excise Boards
