Persons in Linden, Rahway and Carteret interested in deepening the river to Rahway had requested such improvement, but, according to former Mayor Verner of Linden, president of the Rahway Harbor commission, yesterday, evidence of promise of sufficient shipping tonnage could not

be produced to satisfy the army engineers that the dredging should be extended beyond the Linden point.

Colonel J. A. Woodruff, of the North Atlantic Division, has notified interested persons of the decision of his department.

**Verner Satisfied**

Former Mayor Verner said he was satisfied with having at least

a partial improvement in the river made. An appeal from the engineers' report can be taken within four weeks of the date of Colonel Woodruff's letter, but it is extremely unlikely that any action will be taken at present.

Dredging from Staten Island to Lamber's dock will have to await appropriation of funds by congress. Mr. Verner said he hoped

either the next congress or the Public Works Administration will provide the necessary money. The project will cost \$35,400, according to estimates, with \$8,000 annually for maintenance.

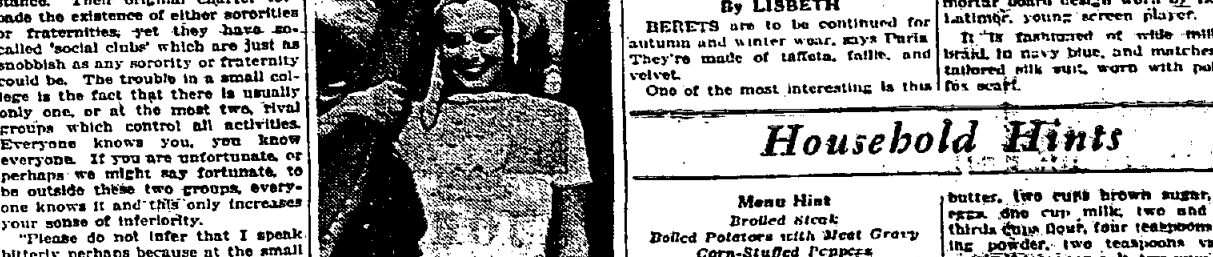

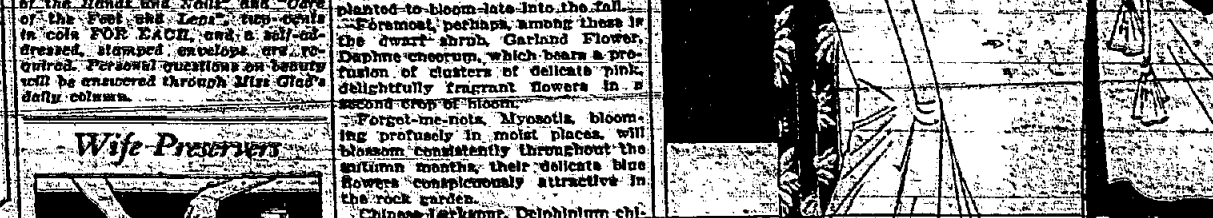

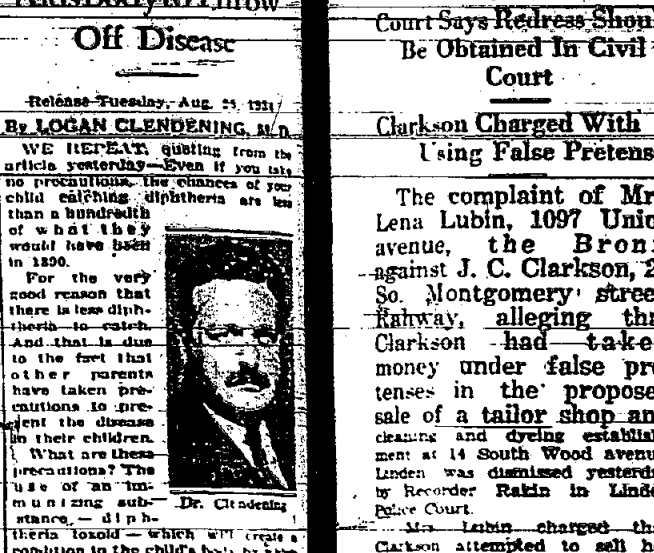
