Mutual respect and understanding in the best interests of the workers and the employers. Such a condition is a thing, it is more than one thing, it is responsible for the satisfied relations between the men who sign the checks and the men who actually do the work.

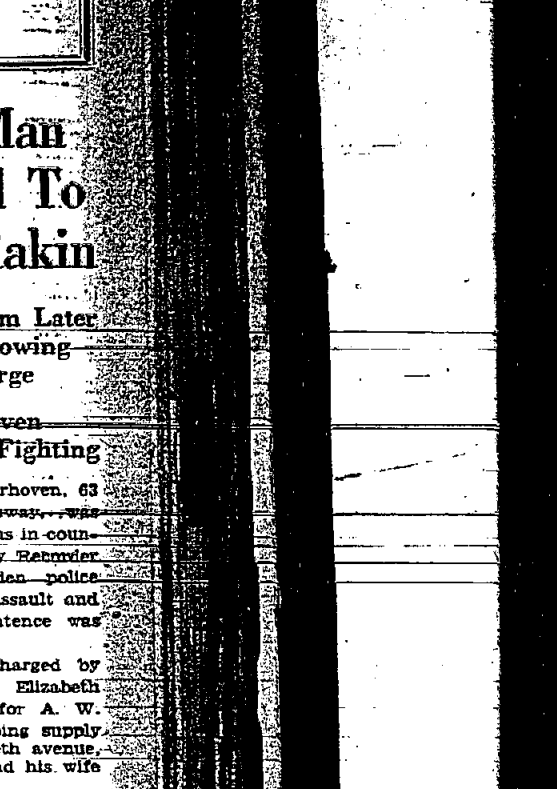

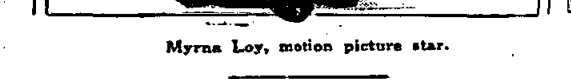
