Curbing Recklessness

The action in local police court of suspending a convicted reckless driver's license for two months is another step toward the elimination of the type of motorist who is threatening public safety in Rahway.

Acting Judge Richard Magner, who handed down the decision in this case, is to be commended for his action. Judge Ward is also proving to be of the same opinion. More decisions by the court in such cases would soon curb reckless driving which is becoming all too common in the city. Such actions are many more times effective than small fines.

It was suggested during Wednesday's Council session that a complete investigation of the department be made and a detailed report presented showing each man's duty. This idea certainly is not a bad one. If Rahway persons knew that some nights there is only one patrolman covering three beats in the city, they might realize that economy at the expense of adequate police protection is far from wise. Such economy is not to be commended. Let's cut out some of the other alleged necessities but, for the sake of safety of local property and lives, give the police all too common in the city. Such actions are many more times effective than small fines.






