## INDUSTRY'S CONTRIBUTION TO RAILWAY'S WELFARE

New Jersey industry every day is making a substantial contribution to the well-being of the citizens of this state. It is providing gainful jobs for about 450,000 men and women and an annual industrial payroll of about \$600,000,000 for replenishing the pay envelopes of New Jersey.

This is a sizeable job these days, viewed from any angle. Robert T. Bowman, president of the New Jersey State Chamber of Commerce, speaking at Auburn Park recently, urged a number of local chambers of commerce and trade groups assembled there, to acquiesce all the people of the state with the scope of this contribution by New Jersey industry to the general public welfare.

This state's industrial star is rising, Bowman believes. "The feeling," he feels, "is the result of a fine job by New Jersey's present industry and the success of the state's trade organizations in persuading new industry to settle within our borders."

All and sundry are learning that this is a good state in which to do business. It is. Maintenance of New Jersey's favorable tax position and the tax excesses of other commonwealths are helping our steady industrial growth.

Yet, as the State Chamber's president points out, the importance of the never ceasing contribution to the public welfare made by the State's industry and by our local trade groups is often forgotten, minimized or altogether lost in the clamor of the local chambers of commerce and industries which pay much of its taxes and support many of our families.

New Jersey industry and New Jersey trade groups need not hide their light under a bushel. They are, as Bowman points out, doing an unselfish and sizeable job.

We need perhaps greater consciousness here by all of us of the great truth of the slogan now being used by organized chambers of commerce in New York State and elsewhere that "What Hurts Industry Hurts You."

## JERSEY'S STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT COSTS INCREASE FASTER THAN IN ANY OTHER STATE

It becomes increasingly difficult to reconcile a drift toward new state imposts with revelations on the crushing weight of the present New Jersey tax burden recently made by the State Chamber of Commerce.

A Chamber news release points out that during the four years, from 1922 to 1927, the combined cost of state and local government in New Jersey increased at a higher rate of percentage than in any other state in the nation.

Thus, New Jersey hangs up a record, but taxpayers who wish that this particular laurel had gone to some other state.

The rate of tax increase in New Jersey has been alarming. Where will it end? From 1922 to 1927, New Jersey taxes, state and local combined, have increased twice as fast as our taxable wealth and the combined state and local public debt has increased five times as fast. The result is that our per capita state and local tax in 1927 stood at \$21.00 as compared with New York's \$12.00, and here are the figures to prove it.

During the seventeen-year period between 1920 and 1937, while our State's population increased by 33% and our taxable wealth increased by 68%, our taxes for state and local government jumped from \$13,600,000 to \$340,000,000, an increase of 153%, and our gross public debt, state and local jumped from \$264,100,000 to \$1,164,000,000, an increase of 341%.

And yet, under the pressure of the task of scraping the bottom of the state treasury in the never-ending search for funds for relief purposes, there is discernible a tendency to create new state taxes.

The way out of New Jersey's present difficulties is not the imposition of new state taxes. New state taxes mean new burdens. No relief for the real estate owner on any body else lies in that direction. Replacement taxes are too likely to turn out to be new taxes, replacing nothing, but increasing the burden on all.

Unfortunately, there is no easy way out. There remains only one way to reduce taxes, that is, the hard road of economy in state and local government. Difficult as it seems of attainment, this and not new levies must continue to be the objective of all citizens and all agencies desiring to see a lightening of the general tax burden in this State.

## MORE THAN A QUARTER OF RAILROADS ARE IN THE RED

We owe billions of dollars, but we pay in pennies. Pennies spent every day in hidden taxes by New Jersey housewives help pay for nearly two thirds of the nation's twelve billion dollar tax bill.

Hidden taxes are found in the purchase price of every article. There are 58 hidden taxes on a loaf of bread, 172 hidden taxes in medicine, and even in death, hidden taxes.

The only market we have that is worth a cent is the market for hidden taxes. If we don't pay them, we are being brought to the attention of New Jersey home makers by the Emergency Consumers Tax Council of New Jersey, an organization of housewives fighting for reduction of the present tax burden.

A family with an income of \$34 a week may not be able to visualize the payment of billions of dollars, the women of this group point out, but taxes take \$3.90 every week from that family to pay Uncle Sam's tax bill. That's where it hurts most.

The Emergency Consumers Tax Council claims that hidden taxes reduce the value of a family's income. Twenty nine cents of every dollar of income in New Jersey, they have found, goes for taxes—hidden and direct. This is a threat to the decent standard of living housewives have tried to maintain for their families.

## Mosquito Breeding Places Inspected

County Commission-Male, 2,573 Inspections  
In Rahway

The inspection of yards in this city has been completed by the Union County Mosquito Commission inspectors. In Rahway, there were 2,573 inspections in 250 properties traveling through the city.

The Commission plans to take all properties once every two weeks to locate mosquito breeding places. Upon locating such places, the inspectors will remove them and instruct the property owner how to avoid breeding places.

In 1937, the inspectors made 512 inspections, and located 1,200 breeding places. Last year, portions of the city were not inspected, and the 1938 results were better.

**Know Your Government**  
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE  
The chief executive of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control is a joint session of the Legislature for a term of seven years. The commissioner has appointed three Deputy Commissioners, one of whom is designated to act in the absence of the commissioner. The commissioner is empowered to promulgate such rules and regulations as may be necessary for the proper regulation and control of the manufacture, transportation, sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages, and the enforcement of the laws relating to the same. The commissioner is also empowered to suspend or revoke the license of any person who is engaged in the manufacture, transportation, sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages, or who is engaged in the business of selling or offering for sale alcoholic beverages, if he is found to be guilty of any of the following offenses: (a) selling or offering for sale alcoholic beverages to a minor; (b) selling or offering for sale alcoholic beverages to a person who is intoxicated; (c) selling or offering for sale alcoholic beverages to a person who is under the influence of any narcotic or other intoxicating substance;
