To relieve the pressure of "must" expenditures, the New Versey State Legislature in 1933, through the prompting of the New Jersey Taxpayers Association, passed laws that provided temporary relief from mandatory laws. From 1933 until the end of 1936, the suspension of mandatory laws saved taxpayers millions of dollars. Without these savings many municipalities would have been forced to default in payment of salaries, and payments on bonded

Even though the duration of these temporary laws gave ample opportunity to enact permanent laws to relieve mandatery expenditures, the Legislature continued the suspension only through 1936, and failed to renew it for 1937, evidently assuming that the days of "easy money" had re- powers.
