HOW AN OLD INDUSTRY KEEPS YOUNG

To the ordinary observer it would seem that shrinking a concrete pillar is a task that might be performed only by the prodigious energy of a Paul Bunyan and his blue ox. But today it is no unusual feat for building engineers to shrink concrete dam reinforcements, bridge piers, walls and floors.

The process was first developed at Boulder Dam when engineers embedded pipe every five feet in freshly placed concrete and circulated brine for six weeks. Shrinkage that once took a century to complete was thus effected in six weeks and contraction joints could be sealed almost immediately. According to National Business it was this expedient that led to adoption of the same principle wherever concrete is used in large building projects.

When critics of the construction industry falsely accuse its management of failure to keep in step with modern technology they overlook hundreds of developments similar to that at Boulder Dam. The industry itself is as old as history—its improvements are evolutionary rather than revolutionary. When the many spectacular new industries of today have added 50 years to their age, they too will doubtless be accused of senility because they haven't produced basically new products.

The construction industry has streamlined and modernized to a greater degree than even its own participants realize. The builders of the Woolworth Building, Keokuk Dam and Lincoln Highway, and all those who reconstructed San Francisco after its great fire, so trade-in values will be lower. The expected government excise tax will be little more than a nuisance, and there will be no aluminum for pistons, etc., after present stocks in carmakers' hands are exhausted.

Oil: The industry's capacity to produce is far beyond any demand that can yet be foreseen. But the transfer of tankers to Britain has created something of a transportation problem in this field. Main shortages is along the Atlantic seaboard, where some-thing rationing may be put in effect. In the foreseeable future, there will be no lack of petroleum in other parts of the country.

Household appliances—Heavy cuts in production will be made to conserve metals for military purposes. In the case of washers and refrigerators, the cut may be as high as 50 per cent. However, the cut will be made, as in the case of automobiles, on the basis of record sales. So far, for some time to come at least, production will be close to normal levels. It is reported that the substitutes being used for aluminum and nickel are satisfactory. Higher prices are to be expected.

Food: No shortage of any food is anticipated. In rationing of certain foods, such as in the last war, is imposed.

Housing: In certain areas, notably those which contain major defense industries, there is a very great shortage, and rents are soaring. This is one of the toughest problems the country has on its hands now.

Electric power: Shortages exist in a few areas, and utility experts say this is largely due to the government's "anti-utility" policy which has prevented much private expansion.

The utilities, however, are now planning an expansion development program, and are confident of their ability to meet the demand. In most of the country there is plenty of juice for both industrial and household needs.

What it all adds up to is that we will have less non-military production of a good many commodities—but the pinch will not be anywhere near so severe as it has been in the past. Inflation has not yet appeared. Great hopes are pinned on higher taxes as a weapon against inflation—they will deprive the consumer of a large part of the increased income which is being produced. In addition, Congress will undoubtedly pass some kind of price-control legislation.

Emphasis is being placed now on making goods give better service. Economists tell us to drive our cars slower to save motors, rubber and gas; to have our shoes resoled and our clothes repaired, instead of buying new. That is good advice.

Two Changes Made In Motor Rules

Aimed At Motorists Who Fail To Satisfy Crash Judgments

Motor Vehicle Commissioner Arthur W. Magee has called attention to two important changes in the New Jersey "Financial Responsibility Law," effective since September 1, 1940.

The purpose of the law change is to remove from the highway financially irresponsible drivers and drivers who have failed to satisfy judgments resulting from their own negligence. The law formerly provided for the revocation of licenses of those failing to satisfy judgments in excess of \$25, within 30 days after the date the judgment becomes final. The law provides, however, for installment payments of judgments.

Defendants in this class are also liable to motorists who have avoided compliance with the financial responsibility law by under-insuring. The law provides that, if a driver fails to insure for a period of three years after the judgment becomes final, the law applies to judgment secured against New Jersey motorists in any part of the United States or Canada.

The other important change pertains to motorists who have avoided compliance with the financial responsibility law by under-insuring.
