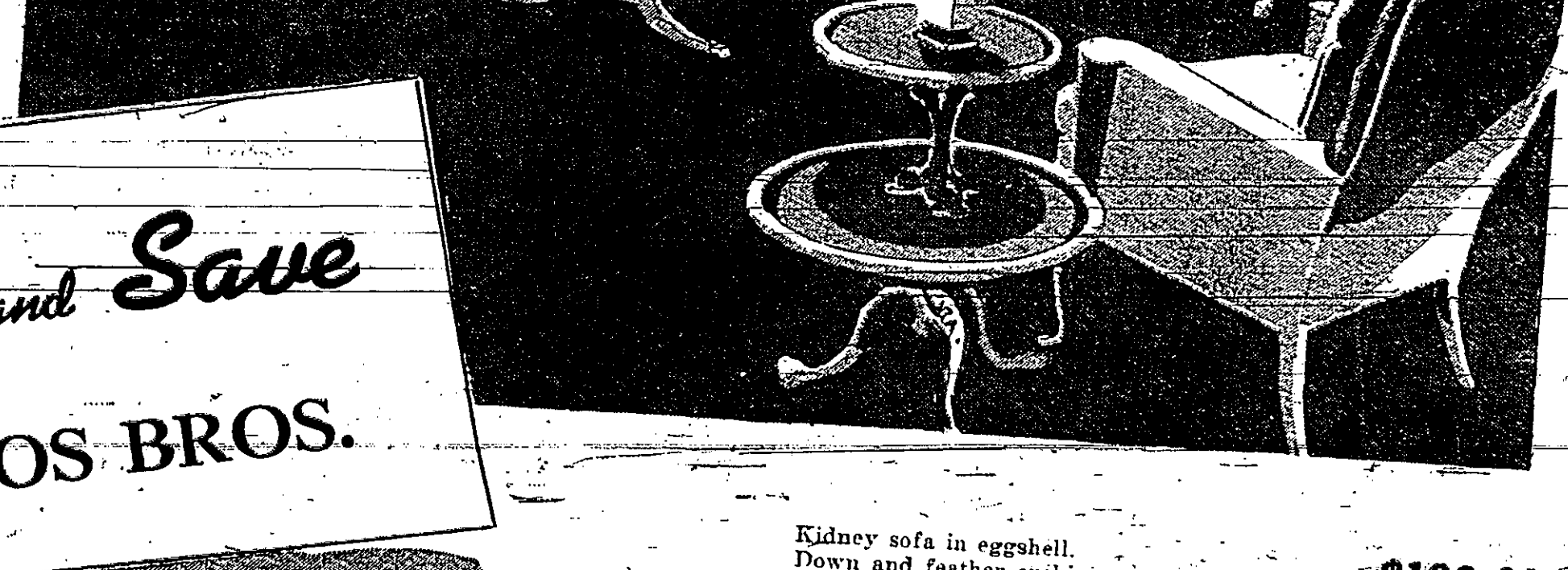

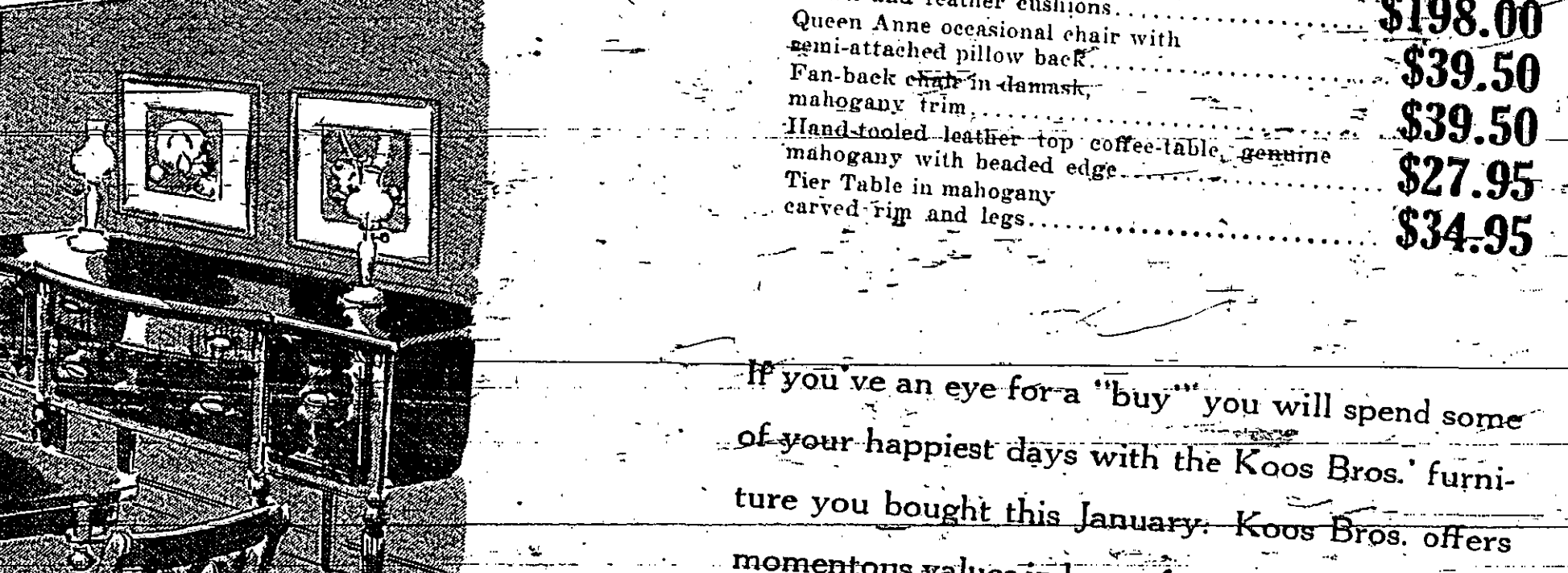

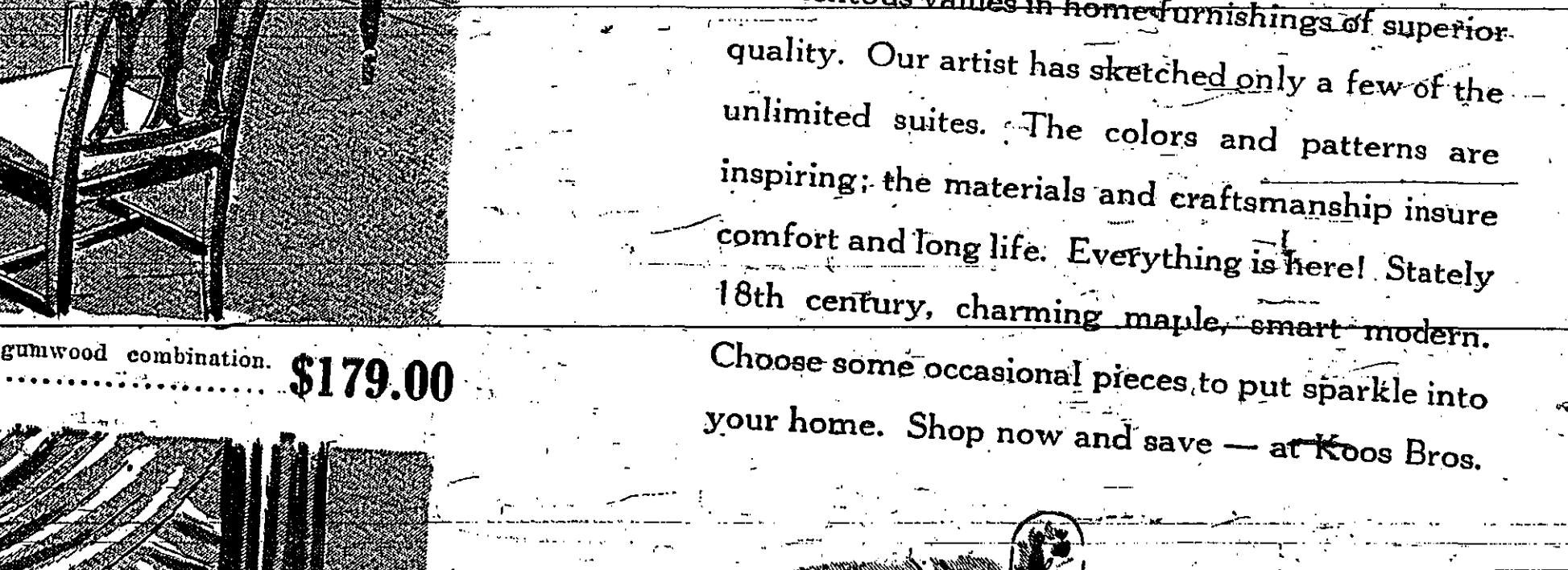

PRECEDENT, A CONVENIENT ALIBI

Last week a Republican Councilman questioned the use of the Police to deliver notices of committee meetings to the members of the City Council. The specific instance mentioned was a notice of a meeting of the Finance Committee. The Republican called attention to the fact that the United States Post Office is still in business as the Telephone Company. It must also be noted that we have been hearing for some time of the shortage of newspapers in the Police Department and that the present members of the Police Force are overworked, even to the extent of being on duty during their time off. However, it seems to be necessary for the Police to run errands and deliver notices for certain members of the City Council. In using this means of calling committee members to meetings, it is the fact that years ago, when the Police were in power, they were used for this purpose and this made it alright today. Of course, they didn't recall the days when the City Fathers transacted their business by the light of kerosene lamps or even under light. Perhaps the members of the Police Force would like a precedent for meeting in total darkness.

Possibly there can be some excuse in the specific case of the Finance Committee. In the specific case of the Finance Committee, the Finance Committee is a messenger-boy, for he must be overworked with so many important committee chairmanships and being a member of so many other committees. The Finance Committee could hardly be expected to take the time to write letters or use the telephone.

However, as long as the precedent has been set and the rule of the City Council is followed, in the future, when Mrs. Black wants Mrs. Black to come over for a spot of tea or needs some groceries from the store, just call the Police to fetch Mrs. Black or the groceries. In fact, why not have the Police do all of the errands? The taxpayers are paying for it and the Council has approved. The Police Force can always protect the City and solve any crimes when they get through with their errands.

Then again, it also appears evident there is no apparent need to conserve gasoline, tires, automobiles and manpower during a war program, as the Police, garbage collection and the only ones expected to make the sacrifices. Conservation was meant for public officials, at least not when there has been a precedent set years ago which obviates all present day conditions.

WHY THE DELAY?

At the last meeting of the City Council, held in 1941, that body adopted a resolution which authorized the naming of a committee of ten, to survey the situation which exists with respect to recreational facilities of the negro population of the city. The committee was to consist of five members named by the Mayor, three members of the City Council, named by the president of the Council, the Chief Engineer of the Fire Department, the Mayor and two members of the City Council named by the Mayor.

LET'S NOT FORGET THE LIVING

Just this last fall the Railway schools were closed as a precautionary measure against the spread of the dread influenza pandemic. There were three cases on record and these three were in many of the homes and population of the city. The Railway was fortunate more fortunate than many towns and cities in the United States, where the plague took a heavy toll and left thousands of helpless and miserable bodies that were unable to move.

If for no other reason than gratitude alone, we here in Rahway should support the campaign now being waged to raise funds to prevent and combat this pestilence. We never know when this disease will strike our very own with such force that there may be more victims than we can care for. Then we will have to look to this National Fund-raising effort to fight this horrible disease.

What we are striving for, as a result, is time. Time to produce adequate instruments of war—time to send them to the battlefronts—time to create and perfect an all-embracing plan for combat. To send inadequate reinforcements to Luzon or anywhere else would be futile. It would mean a possibly ruthless disposition and waste of our efforts and our resources. Many people may have thought that MacArthur's stand was useless—that fine soldiers were dying in a battle which could not be won. But whether or not the enemy finally takes all of the Philippines, the fact that the Japanese are paying a high price for every inch of ground they gain, and that MacArthur's stand makes Manila and its bay of no use to Japan so long as the defenders are able to fight on, is in itself a military achievement that will play an important part in the eventual winning of the war.

On some fighting fronts the tide runs in favor of the United Nations. It is clear to all that the Germans are not carrying on a "strategic retreat" from Russia—Correspondents who have followed the Russian troops tell of seeing whole trainloads of tanks, guns, munitions, food and other supplies left behind intact by the fleeing Nazis. Hitler certainly did not plan on that. The Russian Army, which, according to an announcement made by General Zhukov, Chief of the Russian Army, in October, was "totally destroyed" as an effective fighting force—has produced a first-rate miracle. It has turned the proud German divisions into disorganized, routed remnants of a once-great army. Late reports say that the Germans are trying to muster new armies in the occupied nations, to make up for the appalling toll the Russians have taken. Hitler may be able to make these new armies march and do his bidding, but he can hardly infuse them with fighting spirit.

The Chinese, always fine soldiers, are making splendid use of the materials of war sent them by Britain and this country. Great areas of land have been wrested from the invader. Chinese generals tell of almost incredible Japanese casualties. And Chinese forces are aiding in the defense of Singapore.

In Africa, Nazi General Rommel escaped with part of his force from Libya with the aid of a sandstorm. But the British have the territory firmly in hand, and the great bulk of the German tank divisions have been destroyed or captured. In the long run, this victory may prove to be the most important Allied success so far. Many an expert thinks control of Africa may eventually prove the key to the winning of the whole war.

In the Battle of the Atlantic, British shipping losses remain low. The American-British convoys and naval patrols are working far better than they ever did before. Destruction of Nazi U-boats has been heavy.

The battle which will be won at least of the American production front. The President's plans for expansion of arms production, as laid down in his State of the Union speech, are universally approved. But many are concerned that it cannot be done in the time scheduled unless the defense set-up is overhauled, with one man of ability and courage placed in supreme command. 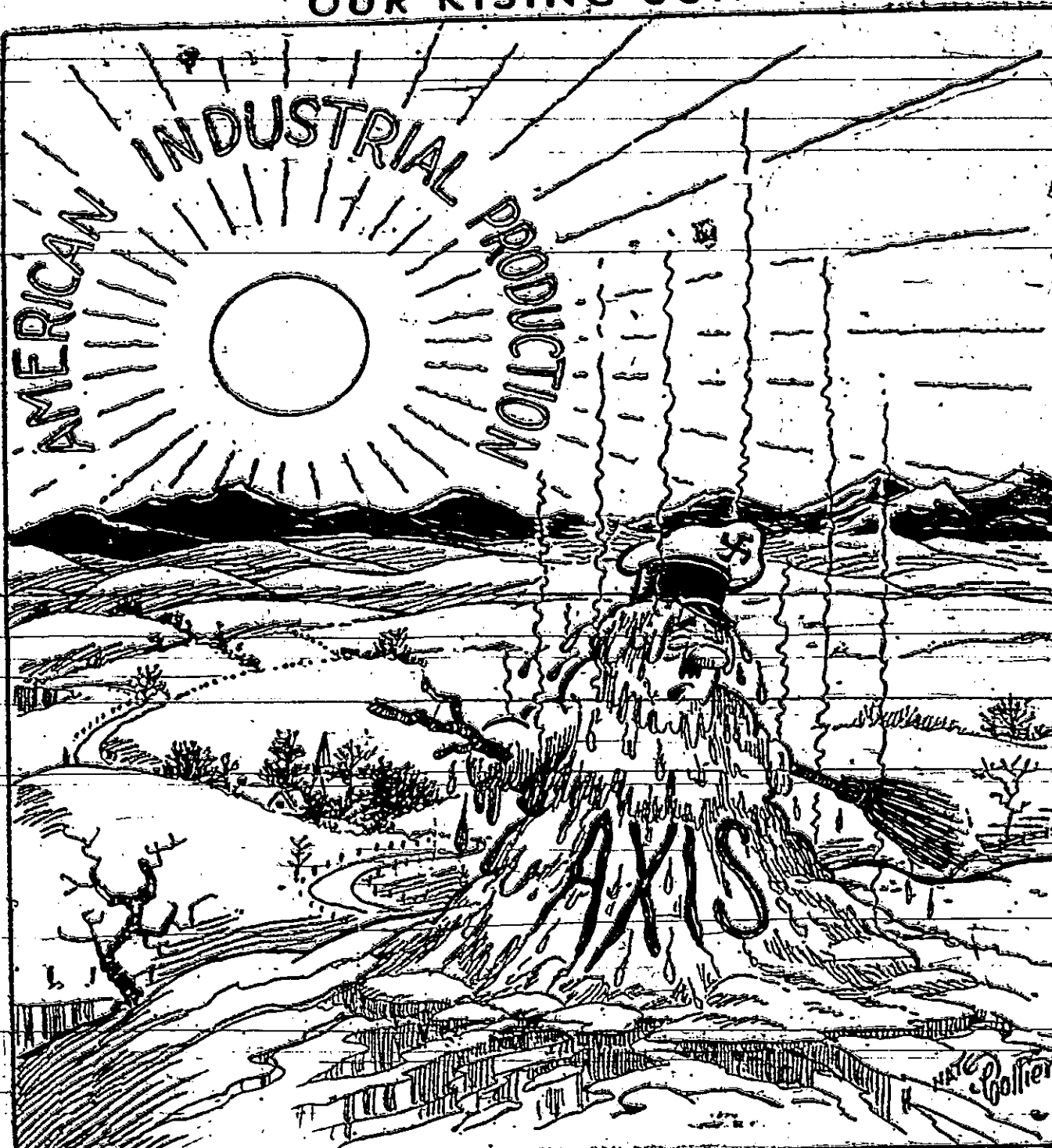
