Liberalizing its restrictions on the manufacture of footwear in a number of respects the War Production Board has announced that manufacture of two-toned shoes with silver-toned leather soles will be permitted on September 1. This and several other actions were accomplished in amendments to the footwear conservation order, No. 1. The revised ruling also provides that, beginning September 1, while cattle hide leather will be permitted in the manufacture of shoes, officials predicted that this provision will make a more suitable material available for infants and children's shoes. 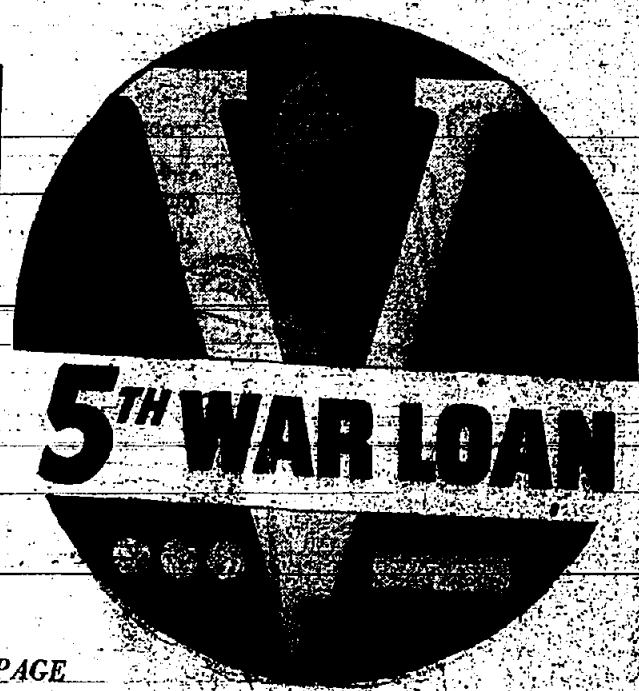

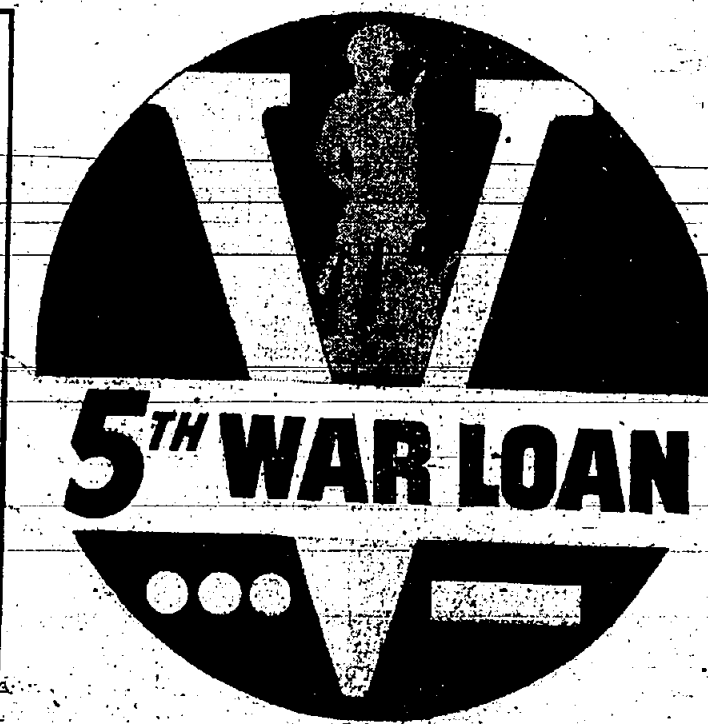
