"Open Windows of the World" was the theme of the closing exercises of the Daily Vacation Bible School of the First Presbyterian Church on the weekend.


The school was well attended with growing interest shown throughout the three-week period. A capacity audience of parents attended the pageant at the closing program in the Community House of the Church.
