### Merck Will Be Heard From

The opening gun of the 1945-46 basketball season was fired Monday night when the Merck quintet ran into the Watson-Stillman aggregation in a Union County Industrial Basketball League game and came off second best. The Chemists were handicapped by lack of practice and were also unfortunate enough to not have a drag with the schedule makers who pitted them against one of the strongest outfits in the league for the opening game. However, you can't sell that Merck combination or Coach Charlie Maurer short, because after a few workouts and a little more teamwork they'll be right in there kicking the best in the loop around.

Charlie Maurer has the makings of a really strong team in spite of the fact he will not be able to have left Dinocento in the lineup this season. Dinocento, one of the best basketball guards in these parts, was injured last year in basketball, twisting a knee and tearing some ligaments. These ligaments have not responded to treatment and he has been sidelined for the season by his doctor.

However, Maurer has a couple of new additions to his squad this season that will be able to fill in for Dinocento. Of course we can't discount the old reliable Lou DuBino, Frankie Yarnell, Percy Wukovets and Rumpfen. They worked together all last year and were a plenty smart combination for any team anywhere. Yes, yes that Merck outfit will be heard from in the County circuit before too many more games are played, and Watson-Stillman will be just agglut at a later date and the story may be different then.

### Ray Hoagland Getting Busy
