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## WOULDN'T YOU LIKE TO SAVE JUST A LITTLE BIT OF SANIBEL?

### 1 OPENING UP PANDORA'S BOX (BAY BRIDGE REVISITED ROUND 3)

At the Council meeting of December 4, 1984, City Manager Gary Price presented the lowest bid (\$42,857) for replacing Bay Bridge. I really recommend that we bite the bullet, go ahead, accept the low bid or Pittsfield Construction and get on with the darn thing," said Mr. Price.

The Council was on the very verge of voting when Councilman Klein asked, "Do we have to do this?" Mr. Klein suggested that the City could save money simply by giving the bridge and a bit of road (public property) to the owner of the property it serves (Sanibel Capital, Inc.).

Following considerable discussion, Mayor Valtin urged the Council to go ahead and replace the Bay Bridge, and referred to the recent referendum of 1982 when a majority of Sanibel's citizens had voted against vacating the bridge.

### MAYOR VALTIN'S PANDORA'S BOX SPEECH

I have to respectfully disagree with the proposal that we not go through with this. I think it will be interpreted by the public as manipulative, badly motivated. I think the people have spoken on this. We have assumed all along that we would go the route of doing it. It isn't that much more than the figure we've previously considered. I just feel the people have spoken. I agree. I think they were dead wrong, but that was their will, and for us now to almost gimmicky go back and vacate the bridge is just not going to be understood. Discussion Mayor Valtin continued, "I still feel that we're, despite our best motivation, we are opening up a Pandora's box, public misperceptions that are going to haunt us."

On February 5, 1985, the Council adopted an ordinance to vacate Bay Bridge. Now we must go to the polls again on Monday, March 25th, to vote on a vacating ordinance that is very similar to the vacating ordinance that a majority already voted against in the fall of 1982.

### 2 BAY BRIDGE (ROUNDS 1 & 2)

Round 1: On November 4, 1975, the final judgment of the Circuit Court of Lee County was that Bay Drive to the east of the Bridge, 4 feet of Bay Drive to the west of the bridge, and the bridge itself were public property.

Round 2: Special referendum of September 7, 1982. The City wanted to vacate Bay Drive and the bridge, a majority voted against vacating, thereby reaffirming the Court's judgment of 1975.

In the special election of March 5th (Round 3), the City's vacating ordinance seeks to circumvent both the Court's judgment (Round 1) and the will of the people (Round 2).

### 3 IF WE VACATE BAY BRIDGE, WHO WILL GET IT?

Sanibel Capital, Inc., duly licensed in the State of Florida as a for-profit corporation. Past owners of the property served by Bay Bridge were private individuals; the new owner is a corporation.

### 4 WHAT DOES SANIBEL CAPITAL, INC. STAND TO GAIN?

A great deal. The ordinance calls for vacating Bay Bridge (56 feet), 4 feet of road on the west side of the bridge and 2 feet of road on the east side, a total of 62 feet. Since Bay front property currently sells for about \$1,000 a foot, Sanibel Capital, Inc. would be given public property that is worth about \$62,000.

### 5 WHAT DO SANIBEL'S CITIZENS AND TAXPAYERS STAND TO LOSE?

One of the few jewels of unspoiled undeveloped public property that the City has not yet given away.

Over the years, the City has vacated a great deal of Sanibel's public property through ordinances, road cuttings, a hole and in situ actions and at times, private. Portions of Ferry Road, portions of Sagrada Lane, portions of W. Cliff Drive, Coquina Drive, the Old Trail Cemetery Road, a number of dead ends, public beach cesses that are no longer accessible, these are but a few of the properties once publicly owned that we have lost forever.

Why does our City Council want to give away public property on Sanibel at a time when that same Council strongly supports the State's proposal for a 2% tax on real estate transactions in order to help property to keep and preserve in the public domain?

### 6 WHY ALL THE RUSH TO VACATE BAY BRIDGE?

On January 2, 1985, the State inspected Bay Bridge. The City has not yet received the report of the State's inspection and has been informed that they will not receive that report until well after the vote concerning Bay Bridge on March 25th. Thus on the one hand, we are told that we should vote to vacate a bridge that must now meet state standards. On the other hand, we are told that we will not know what the State recommends before we go to the polls.

Moreover, the same Council that has publicly stated that we, the citizens, did not fully understand the issue when a majority voted against the City in 1982, now refuses to cancel or at least postpone the special referendum until all the facts are available for the voters to consider.

### 7 WHY IS SANIBEL CAPITAL, INC. CURRENTLY SUING THE CITY?

Sanibel Capital, Inc. recently acquired some 21 acres that are served by Bay Bridge. The Corp. at once subsequently applied for a permit to build a 208 foot dock (for the corporate canoe? for corporate birdwatching?).

The City denied the request for a 208 foot dock with the result that the Corporation to which the City wants us to give 62 feet of Bay front property is currently suing us for permission to build its 208 foot dock.

### 8 A VOTE AGAINST VACATING BAY BRIDGE TO SANIBEL CAPITAL, INC. COULD COST EACH TAXPAYER \$5.20

It would cost each one of Sanibel's 8,246 taxpayers precisely \$5.1973077 to pay Pittsfield Construction \$42,857 for replacing Bay Bridge.

## for the record

**■ALL THAT GILTTERS** The gold leaf sign on the door of the First Independence Bank next to Thrift Star Grocery on Palm Ridge Road will have to be scraped off the door.

City council decided to enforce the ordinance which limits businesses to only one street graphic Tuesday.

The wall mounted sign is fairly obvious, asserted Mayor Fred Valtin. Vice president of the bank Jack Milner said people still seemed to mistake the grocery for the bank and went in there looking for the tax collector more often than not.

**■DRINKS LIABILITY** Those selling drinks to people already drunk should be liable for damages if that person causes injury or hurt to someone else, city council members said Tuesday. Council voted unanimously to ask the Florida Legislature to impose civil liability on dealers who serve people who are visibly intoxicated.

**■MARINE COMMITTEE** A Marine Advisory Committee has been set up by the city to advise the council and to make recommendations for preserving the marine environment for boating, fishing, and other water-related activities.

Five members will be appointed by the city council and a council member will serve as an ex officio member of the board.

**■COUNCIL MEN FOR A DAY** Student Government Day for Sanibel Elementary School fifth graders will be held Wednesday, May 15 at city hall. City council members will take part even though councilmen Francis Bailey and Mike Klein cannot be present.

**■HOUSE WITH A HISTORY** A tradewinds resident who wants to continue renting his house on a short term basis was granted a two month continuance of the hearing to enable him to contact the previous owners to attempt to establish that it has a history of being used for short term rentals.

Mike Palmer, a resident of Miami and owner of the four bedroom house, Sandy Bottom in Tradewinds subdivision, said he was told by the owners when he bought the house five years ago that they used the house from time to time for spillover from the Tradewinds Motel which they managed.

About ten people in the audience disputed that claim, however. Col. Millard Libby said he had intimate knowledge of the ownership of the house that he used to check on the security of the house and that at no time was that house rented to anyone.

If it was it was the best kept secret since the development of the atomic bomb, he said. The hearing was continued until May 21 at the request of Palmer.

**■AFTER THE FIVE PENALTY SLUGGED** It's going pretty far to demand a contractor to slow off half the roof of the second story he's already erected but nevertheless some punitive measures must be taken.

So spread city council members in obvious sympathy with the plight of Dennis H. Jones, 1737 Venus Drive, whose contractor failed to obtain a building permit for an addition to a pool deck.

Jones mentioned learning that coverage with imperious surfaces exceeds 30 percent of the parcel would like an amendment to the Comprehensive Land Use Plan after the hearing.

At first reading, the council considered doubling of fees for amendments and development permits after the fact at the suggestion of City Engineer John Jones.

A building permit costing \$150 up in application for construction started would cost \$300 if obtained later, Klein said.

City Attorney David L. Fox suggested a provision for automatic doubling of the fee and Mayor Fred Valtin gave him the opportunity to try his hand at an ordinance for a second reading at 1:30 p.m. April 16 with Jones' addition to the deck remaining intact during the interim.

**■RIGHT OF WAY** The city has been given 25 feet of right of way along Periwinkle Way. The gift came as a condition of the development permit for the 8,148 square foot Periwinkle Shopping Center approved December 10 last year. Andrew Szurhansky, general partner of Periwinkle Garden Associates, signed the quit claim deed Tuesday, the end to the city.

## Anderson seeks to break even on land

Developer Don Anderson would like to have some relief on his property fronting on Periwinkle Way bounded by Vinca and Ardsky Ways.

The relief Anderson would ask for is in lieu of the rezoning of the parcel from residential to commercial when Anderson claims it is any way could be at city council's suggestion, he said. He had already received the planning department's correction that no cemetery exists on the land as previously stated.

After questioning Island Realty about the feasibility of developing the site with five duplexes of 800 square feet each, the bottom line

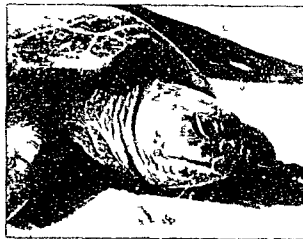
after six (number of) years of expenses would be \$63,146 and the ten units rented out would be a realization of \$65,000 — a break even point, said Anderson.

## Dead turtles buried in 'Ding' Darling refuge

Migrating loggerhead turtles which washed ashore or Sanibel's beaches over the weekend after apparently drowning have been laid to rest in the J.N. Ding Darling Wildlife Refuge.

Charles LeBluff of Caretta Research, a non-profit turtle research organization, said Tuesday the loggerheads of which four had been found by Monday were either buried or left in isolated areas of the refuge by city public works crews. A fifth turtle was found at Fort Myers Beach. The turtles posed a public health nuisance, LeBluff said, and there was an arrangement with the city to do this, he added.

He termed the incidence of dead turtles on the beach more than normal because of the offshore wind blowing them into shore Sunday.

He attributed their deaths to possibly accidental drowning from shrimp trawls. Nets, he said, which do not allow the trapped turtles to get out are responsible for deaths of many of the large amphibians.

LeBluff examined two of the turtles which he said had been dead for days. A 180 pound female

## Lucy Armenia hurt in fatal accident on Gladiolus Drive

A Sanibel woman received minor injuries Saturday in an accident at the intersection of Gladiolus Drive and Winkler Road when she reportedly drove her car into the path of a car driven by Larry Shipp of Fort Myers Beach, according to Florida Highway Patrol.

Lucy Armenia, wife of John Armenia, one of the owners of the Sanibel Hilton and of the Jimmy Connors U.S. Tennis Center, Punta Rassa, was accompanied by three passengers who also received minor injuries.

Shipp, a former golf coach at Edson Community College, died Sunday of injuries received in the crash. He was owner of Shipp's Sport Shop, Fort Myers Beach.

According to an FBI spokesman, the accident report had not been filed as of Wednesday morning and it was unknown if charges would be filed.

### ROGO may be phased out by 1986

**W**ill Sanibel see an explosion of single family homes causing premature build out and a strain on city services if ROGO is abolished?

This and other concerns were expressed at a city workshop with the council and planning commission and staff last week to explore the idea of removing the much criticized Rate of Growth Ordinance which was designed to regulate the building of single and multi family dwellings to 180 a year.

ROGO would be phased out by Jan. 1, 1986 for all single family construction according to a planning department proposal.

Bruce Rogers, planning director explained that the phase down would permit for each ROGO period in July and November an additional allocation of 75 single family dwellings until Jan. 1.

When asked by the council why the number 75 was chosen Rogers admitted it was on the basis of "reasonable process" so as not to overwhelm the building department which had recommended the number.

Allocations granted in July and November would have to be carried through and building permits obtained he explained. Otherwise applicants would have to withdraw and reapply he said.

ROGO would continue to be in effect for multi-

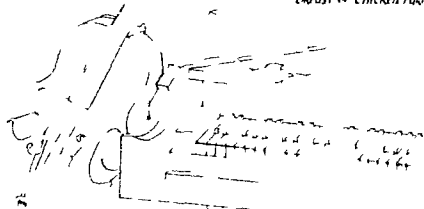
family development which would include duplexes Rogers said. The number available would be the same as available now.

Councilwoman Louise Johnson estimated applications for single family houses at 220 a year based on today's applications. ROGO allows for 180 dwellings a year whether single or multi family. She cited three possible problems of early buildout.

Rogers however had stated earlier that the original motivation for ROGO — that of slowing down multi family development along the beach — had been served. There is very little vacant land left in the resort area and we'll be seeing redevelopment of existing programs.

President Andy Seipos stated that 100 condominiums and 200 single family houses are presently for sale. "So we need a lot more to sell?" he asked.

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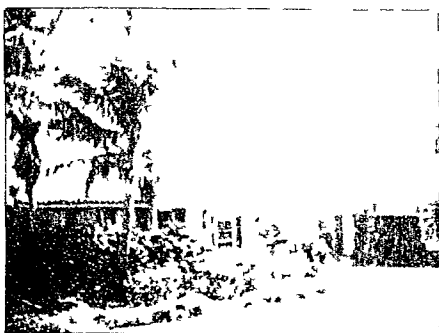
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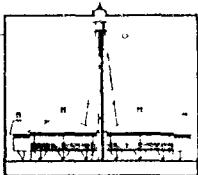

... problems that every restaurant runs into from time to time, and that the business had been discriminated against by city and county officials.

I don't know of another business on the island with a concrete slab under its dumpster," she added and went on to suggest that professional jealousy and competition were the reason for the discrimination.

Officer Richard Kennedy claims that Guy has been convicted of theft and extortion," she said. In fact, when Guy took over The Fountain it started to do well and have an impact on other supper clubs in the area.

Kennedy is actively pursuing my clients because he has a vested interest in Wils Landing," she said, adding that Kennedy had come into The Fountain on the evenings of Thursday, March 7, and Friday, March 8, and told staff that he would personally arrest them if they attempted to serve food or drink.

Kennedy is a sworn officer of this city and I take exception to your comments," said Mayor Vultin Ingram. There is no evidence he was in-

ing other than proudly as a sworn officer. He added that the fact that Kennedy had an interest in Wils Landing was not in question.

City Attorney David La Croix added that Kennedy was acting on the authority of the city and that he went along with his request and the request of the city manager.

To say we're trying to shut them down is ridiculous," commented City Manager Gary Price.

Contacted after the meeting, Kennedy said the reason he was the one to go into The Fountain was that he had "drawn the short end of the straw" and been working nights.

On the evening of March 7, Guy reports that Kennedy entered the restaurant and told staff that he would personally arrest them if they sold either food or drink. This despite no formal notice being issued against the restaurant by the Lee County Board of Alcohol, Firearms and Tobacco. The staff stopped serving he said.

Kennedy, however, says he went to the restaurant with Sgt. Janet Cobi and Lawrence Lott and that there were problems with the liquor license and that there was the possibility this could be closed down.

their sale to minors in view of the area driver's and finger of fire. Smoke bombs and some hand held sparklers have been removed from the shelves.

■ **ASHBY COMMENDED** Police Officer Scott Ashby was commended for his investigative techniques which resulted in the arrest of Joe Daniel Cox, 22, for thefts and burglaries on the island. The letter from Police Chief John Butler to Officer Ashby said that a large amount of stolen merchandise was returned to its rightful owners as a result of the arrest.

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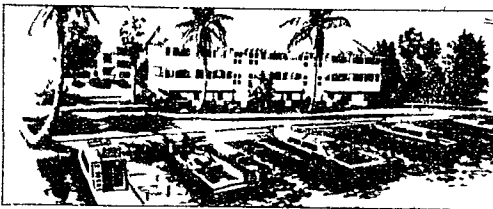
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# FACT SHEET

## BAY DRIVE BRIDGE

### SPECIAL ELECTION

### MARCH 25, 1985

The following facts are prepared to assist citizens of Sanibel when casting ballots on the Bay Drive Bridge Special Election. Each statement can be verified by various documents, surveys and judicial actions.

#### FACT:

There is no legal public access, without trespassing over intervening private property, to the bay waters or bay beach along Bay Drive west of the city's Daisy Mayer Park. Daisy Mayer Park provides over 100 feet of direct public access to the Bay, and once access is obtained to the Bay waters at or below mean high tide line, any location is open. This fact is based upon court decisions and professional land survey.

#### FACT:

There is no legal public access to the bay waters or bay beach on the west side of the Bay Drive Bridge. This is a 21 acre parcel, formerly owned by Shell, now owned by Mr. Theodore Cross; Sanibel Capital, Inc. Also based upon court decision and professional land survey.

#### FACT:

There is no legal "back entrance" to the one property now owned by Theodore Cross served by the Bay Drive Bridge using Venus Drive and the Water Shadows Subdivision. Fact based upon unrecorded plat and property divisions in Water Shadow Subdivision.

#### FACT:

There is a privately owned strip of property no less than 6' wide between the public portion of Bay Drive and the mean high tide line as established by a Florida registered land surveyor in July, 1982 using recognized State and Federal standards, leading from the Daisy Mayer Park approximately 240' west to the bridge. Fact based upon court decision and land survey.

#### FACT:

Any possible public rights of access through the former Shell property, now owned by Cross, on the west side of the bridge were lost in accordance with a final judgment of Case No. 74-2769 CA JHS Theodore J. Official Record Book 1108 at page 379 and 371, October, 1975. This final judgment established the width of the existing right-of-way and terminated the public access four feet past the west end of the bridge.

#### FACT:

There are no long range plans or Comprehensive Land Use Planning requirements for a northern bypass. Development in the Dunbar Subdivision, Water Shadows Subdivision and J. N. "Ding" Barringer National Wildlife Refuge would make this route, even if current plans were revised, extremely difficult.

#### FACT:

The plat of the previously planned Dunbar Subdivision was recorded in 1975 by the Sanibel Capital Corporation. 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#### FACT:

The width of Bay Drive ranges from 15' to less than 40'. This fact was established by the final judgment, Case No. 74-2769 CA JHS Theodore J. Official Record Book 1108 at page 379 and 371, October, 1975. This fact is based upon court decision and professional land survey.

#### FACT:

On October 18, 1984, after an incident with an overweight delivery truck and consequent structural deterioration, the City posted the bridge for a maximum 2 ton gross vehicle weight.

#### FACT:

In the face of safety standards and Department of Transportation requirements that bridges should be closed if they will not support a weight of at least three tons, the City faces significant potential liability if the Bay Drive Bridge is not closed and not replaced. On the other hand, the City cannot simply close the bridge and deny a property owner his only legal access to a public road. Based on opinion of City Attorney.

#### FACT:

Page 93 of the Florida Department of Transportation Manual of Uniform Minimum Standards for Design, Construction and Maintenance for Streets and Highways states, "The minimum design loadings for bridges shall be H-15 on local roads with current ADT volumes under 400." Local roads are defined in State Statutes as "a route providing service which is of relatively low average traffic volume, short average trip length or minimal through traffic movement and high land access for adjoining property."

This means that on local roads with average daily trips (ADT) under 400 vehicles the minimum bridge must be designed to carry at least 15 tons. Bay Drive is a local road that carries less than average 400 vehicles per day. There is no lower classification and the proposed new bridge is designed to this requirement.

#### FACT:

Regarding the existing Bay Drive Bridge, the City was advised on May, 24, 1992, by the City's consulting engineer (Harry Bertossa of Hog and Needles Tammen & Bergendoff) that we are, "now at the point where we need to bring the bridge up to standard for public bridges."

#### FACT:

In the cover letter, dated November 15, 1992, which transmitted the detailed inspection report, the City's consulting engineer stated, "Basically, it is recommended that certain minor repairs be made as soon as possible, and the entire bridge be replaced in the near future."

#### FACT:

A Lee County bridge inspection dated December 3, 1984 recommended that the existing two (2) ton load capacity be retained on the bridge.

#### FACT:

The State Department of Natural Resources had indicated that a single span replacement bridge would be required. The proposed new bridge with a 100' bid of \$2,857,000 plus City participation costs, was designed to meet this requirement.

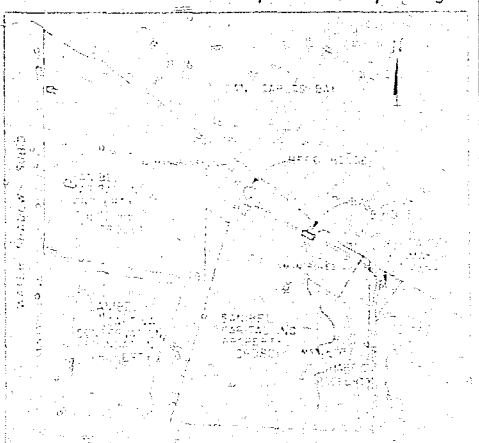
#### FACT:

The 21 acre tract now owned by Sanibel Capital, Inc., which is the City's property served by the bridge, has a total density of 2 dwelling units. There are two dwelling units already there. It is made up of approximately 19 acres of mangrove. Any change of density or use would require both Planning Commission and City Council action at advertised, noticed public hearings.

A Vote "for the ordinance" will result in a portion of the right-of-way being vacated (the bridge itself, two feet on the east end of the bridge and four feet of right-of-way — being all there is — on the west end of the bridge). The City would then have no liability for the bridge and no obligation to maintain or replace it.

A Vote "against the ordinance" will result in the bridge remaining a public right-of-way, with the City retaining liability for the condition of the bridge and the obligation of replacing it with a new bridge.

- I am one of the leading environmentalists on Nantucket Island in Massachusetts and much of my life has been devoted to protecting habitat for birds in Nantucket and Sanibel. If you are to check this, the City Manager's office has a brochure published annually by the Nantucket Conservation Foundation, Inc. that lists and locates each of the properties I have donated to the Conservation Foundation during the past several years.
- If I intended to commercially develop the Bayshore property, wouldn't I be in favor of having the City build a new bridge sufficient for commercial use?
- At a time when public money is scarce, why should the voters and taxpayers of Sanibel be stampeded into spending \$50,000 of Sanibel City funds on a new bridge for my sole benefit when the same money could go a long way towards the purchase of additional wetlands by the City for preservation.

### Residents protest noise, chemicals at helipad

The Bowman's Beach Helipad issue has taken off again.

This time it was raised at the Sanibel City Council on Tuesday by nearby residents concerned about the noise of helicopters taking off and the danger of toxic chemicals being stored near their homes.

The helicopters land and refuel with insecticide. There is jet fuel and other toxics stored there; the entire operation is hazardous, commented Umbrella Pool Road resident Robert Thompson.

The prevailing winds from the Gulf mean they spray all over my house every time they take off, said another resident. The surety can't be healthy.

The noise on take off is also immense for residents.

There is no way you can talk on the telephone when they are taking off, claimed a resident who owns property north of the helipad.

It was disconcerting enough to meet someone on the beach, she said, referring to the characters in *The Day of the Dead*, a movie recently shot at the helipad. Now this.

The helicopter pad, which is used by Lee County Mosquito Control for refueling, is built on

county-owned land in the city's jurisdiction.

Nevertheless, city council members said they would like to do something about the problem. They agreed to write a letter to the Department of Transportation asking for continuation of the April 2 hearing on the issue to give enough time to investigate the problem.

A license is currently being sought for the helipad even though it has been in use several years. According to city manager Gary Price, the mosquito control board were under the impression that they did not need a license because the landing pad was used only sporadically.

As a result, the board had been operating with out a license for some years.

Lee County Mosquito Control director T. Wayne Miller said the landing pad was used at most once or twice a week and that no increase

in intensity of use was intended.

According to aviation engineer George Williams at the Department of Transportation in Bartow, Fla., the board should not have built the helipad before they got a license.

The license was applied for by Thon as a permit chief pilot with the board in October last year but owing to residents' complaints could not be granted without a public hearing. A hearing was scheduled for December 4 last year but was not advertised properly and had to be rescheduled. Williams said. Meetings must be advertised in the Fort Myers News-Press.

The next public hearing is scheduled for April 2 at 7 p.m. in room 3717 of Lee County Courthouse.

Williams will be at the meeting to hear residents' complaints and he will report to Richard Greenup, chief of the Division of Public Transportation in Tallahassee.

## This bread is well bred

The croissant — currently consumed with passion throughout America — can be made right in your own home.

But producing that flaky buttery yeast pastry may be made easier by classes in the art and these classes are now available on Sanibel.

Classes break down the awesome time-consuming process of creating delicate flaky butter-drenched croissants into surprisingly manageable steps even the busiest person can handle, claims instructor Claudia Burns who is offering classes in croissant and rye bread making in her home on Seagrape Lane.

Classes teach you technique you can't get from a book, said Burns. Things like working with yeast, kneading dough, the amount of flour to use — all of these vary according to the situation but once you've been shown the techniques for dealing with them, you don't forget.

Burns says that she often hears people say that they tried making bread and it was a disaster. These same people consistently make bread without any failures after the classes she says.

Burns limits her classes to four people because she wants everyone to be able to observe and participate fully. Classes are taught in her own home and last from two to three hours depending on the bread being baked.

Frances see the whole process from beginning to end when they sit down to enjoy the freshly baked croissants and breads.

They usually like to take part home to the families to taste, she added.

Burns thinks breadmaking should be fun and a relaxing experience and disapproves of machines being used to knead or mix the bread.

Kneading bread is soothing, she said. There should be a Bread Therapy set up. If you're mad at your boss, you can take it out on the dough. The more you mistreat the dough, the more wonderful the bread.

In Milwaukee Wis. where Burns spends most

of the year, she teaches five classes in making French whole wheat Italian breads French and English muffins. She has also set up a program for teachers of breadmaking.

I discovered that I couldn't handle the number of students so I started teaching them to teach others," she recounted.

She also set up her own company Breadwinners.

Burns says that giving classes in breadmaking is a good job for women because they can do it in their own home, write their own schedule, create their own hours and still make a good profit.

Nobody's going to get rich out there with a minimal capital investment and low overhead and it's nice for a woman to have money she can call her own," she explained.

Burns has put together a comprehensive system of tapes and inventory to go with her classes. The videotapes explain the techniques of baking French whole wheat brioche Italian English muffins and white bread. Each lasts two hours and covers two breads. These tapes cost \$200 for all six breads. She also has tapes on making rye bread and pumpernickel for an additional \$100. They are available also in some 200 library systems around the country.

In addition, she has aprons, pans and other accessories which trainees will often purchase when they take the class.

Burns says the interest in baking bread is growing in America. There's a back to basics trend with more leisure time available. Plus it's fashionable to be able to say at your dinner parties that you made the bread or the pasta yourself, she said. It's a very positive and desirable trend.

Charles Frederick complained about boxes blocking the fire escape at the back. Later that weekend a complaint was filed by city attorney and nearby resident David La Croix about noise in the car park at 12:17 a.m. Sunday.

There were four boxes out by the back door and it took five seconds to remove them and put them in the dumpster. That's all there was to it," commented Guy.

The week beginning March 11 the restaurant was almost closed down again this time by Lee County Health Department Galvin said on Wednesday, March 13 that since he found they had complied with about 50 percent of the items

he allowed them to stay open.

That same week Sanibel police received four separate complaints from restaurant staff that they had not been paid since mid-January and were owed up to \$500.

This was because the previous managers took the time sheets. Guy said last week at the restaurant. And it was only a couple of them most of the staff have been paid.

Eight reports have been filed with Sanibel Police Department on the restaurant in the past week alone. Three of them came from Guy who reported Sunday that two employees had removed the cash register from the restaurant and that items had been removed from the kitchen Tuesday while he was attending the council meeting.

He also called to claim that the whole of the Sanibel Police Department was corrupt and guilty of harassment.

The cash register was brought to the police department by two of the employees because of the dispute about salaries. The employees claimed they had not been paid for up to two months and were owed between \$300 and \$479.

Other complaints came from a resident of Rosalie Lane, Marsha Wagner, who said loud music was coming from the restaurant at 1:30 a.m. Tuesday and from two local businessmen, Allen Betton who said that Guy had not paid him

### Read fact sheet says mayor

To Island Reporter: Under the voting ordinance to be decided upon by the voters in referendum on March 23 the public loses nothing except to talk the bridge itself plus two feet of roadway on the east and four feet of roadway on the west.

The rest of the roadway remains in the same status as right now, including the fact that both sides of the roadway are private property and thus cannot be legally used to get to the public portion of the Bay beach.

### How to slow commercial development

Gil Bursley, chairman of the Committee of the Islands has taken the admirable initiative to organize a town meeting on Wednesday, March 27 at 7:30 p.m. at the SCA Community Center and has asked for input from Sanibel residents to slow down the rapidly escalating commercial development on our island. Since I contributed to raising the issue to begin with, I feel obligated to follow through with a proposed solution of the problem.

#### Definition of the problem

First, there should be agreement on the nature of the problem and its causes. This is essential to make sure the causes of the right problem are eliminated instead of its symptoms merely alleviated. I have studied the Burton Aschman Report, commissioned by the City of Sanibel, and have concluded that the methodology and the information in the report are basically sound and still valid. Only the assumptions have changed. The original assumption was that the projected commercial development under the current CITP ordinances would only be supported by residents and short-term visitors. It did not assume that Sanibel would be developed as a shopping destination for daytrippers. If free enterprise bases its projections on the buying habits of residents and short and long term visitors there will be little commercial overdevelopment. However, if

developers assume that daytrippers must justify their commercial ventures, then Sanibel will be in deep trouble. The problem then is now to reduce the inflow of daytrippers who want to make Sanibel their shopping for commercial destination.

#### Proposed solution

##### (a) Principle

The City of Sanibel owns all public roads on the island. These roads and public parking lots are maintained with taxpayers' funds. It stands to reason that all Sanibel taxpayers should have free use of the city's public road system. All non-taxpayers should pay for this privilege. To Sanibel's public roads and parking spaces.

##### (b) Implementation

First, at the end of the cruise way, which marks the beginning of Sanibel's road system, a booth to collect a road tax fee. Taxpayers are allowed to pass free through a special lane. Non-taxpayers will have to stop and pay a \$20 road tax per vehicle for each entry to Sanibel.

Taxpayers will be issued annually, free of cost, colored window stickers (different tint for each year) to be affixed on the inside of the car's front window. Taxpayers include Florida Sanibel Captiva residents (two stickers per family) all other property owners on Sanibel and Captiva (one sticker each) and individuals who are permanently employed full time or part time on Sanibel (one sticker each) off the islands (one sticker each). All others have to pay the \$20 vehicle road tax for each entry to Sanibel.

(c) Advantages

■ The \$20 vehicle road tax will

definitely discourage daytrippers from

visiting Sanibel and Captiva.

■ Loss of the daytrippers' market potential will force the market to slow down commercial development since the feasibility of additional projects will become highly questionable.

■ Taxpayers can still do their shopping of island if they so desire without any financial penalty.

■ Non-taxpayers (i.e. short and long term visitors) will be motivated to do their shopping on the islands to be the left of existing business establishments.

■ Revenue from the proposed road tax will easily support the system's implementation. Excess funds could be used to lower property taxes.

■ For a long term visitor (one month or more) proof of rental payment entitles them to one annual sticker at \$50.

■ A legal precedent could be found in the incorporated city of Jupiter Island (Johannes Sound) north of Palm Beach.

■ The solution is fairly easy to implement on a short notice starting September 1985 when the commercial building moratorium expires.

■ Politically the solution is acceptable since daytrippers do not vote for the election of city officials.

■ Commercial vehicles may pass the extra cost to their customers. The road tax will justify their heavy use of Sanibel's roads into their maintenance.

I do not think that any changes under the existing CITP ordinances are required, provided however that the city council is making exceptions which overrule the recommendations of the planning department.

## MASTER SURGEON

At 81, Dr. Robert Zollinger keeps a hectic pace, but still finds time to get away to Sanibel — for more than 40 years

**"I**t's not work, it's fun. I wouldn't do it if it were work. I've never worked in my life."

This from Dr. Robert Zollinger, master surgeon, teacher, editor and rose grower who at 81 follows a schedule which would defeat most people half his age.

Even here on Sanibel, ostensibly on vacation at the Island Inn, he is at work writing about the first surgeon ever to perform open heart surgery, Dr. Elliott C. Cutler. And despite having supposedly retired ten years ago, this formidable man is still chief editor of the *American Journal of Surgery* published monthly, has travelled more than 16,000 miles throughout the United States and South

America in the past year speaking on surgery, and has produced a fifth edition of his internationally-known handbook of surgery, "An Atlas of Surgical Operations."

But the self-effacing, personable, witty surgeon dismisses all this with an airy wave of the hand. "I don't have your Sanibel go slow rot," he comments jocularly. "What I do is quite normal."

But then Zollinger is a master of understatement. For example, On surgery: "Believe me, it's sim-

ple. You think all this would be going on if it wasn't."

On his handbook of surgery published in every country in the Western world: "It's just a picture book on surgery... a sort of how to book."

On teaching: "Sure I like teaching. I like to harass people."

But beyond the humor is a distinguished man of letters who has contributed tremendously to the medical community as a scholar, a teacher, a disseminator of information and a leader.

As a scholar, it was Dr. Zollinger, along with Dr. Edward Ellison, whose discovery of what is now termed the Zollinger Ellison Syndrome led to significant further discoveries relating to tumors in the pancreas.

As a teacher, reportedly the medical equivalent of Dr. Kingsfield in "The Paper Chase," and by his own admission "demanding" and "unable to be pleased," Dr. Zollinger is so highly regarded that his former students founded the Zollinger Club with 125 now very distinguished members who meet each year.

As a disseminator of information, Dr. Zollinger has been a guest speaker at conferences throughout the United States and abroad. He has also authored, initiated

with Dr. Elliott C. Cutler and most recently with his son, Robert, the world respected manual of surgery, "The Atlas of Surgical Operations" which has been translated into many different languages, most recently, Japanese.

As a leader, Dr. Zollinger has been president of the American College of Surgeons for a year, and is a member of the American Surgical Association and the Board of Surgeons. He is also an honorary member of the Royal College of Surgeons in England.

But despite his lofty distinctions and remarkable achievements, Dr. Zollinger remains a very practical and warm human being.

One of his major hobbies is gardening because, he says, "it gives me something to do in the evening." He is, in fact, a good and rose grower of some distinction and is a frequent judge and exhibitor at state fairs.

"I think old people like agriculture because what they want to be alive next year to see what happens to what they plant this year," he comments.

Asked how he remains so remarkably vigorous and alert at 81, Dr. Zollinger is characteristically whimsical. "You ask me why the hell I'm still living at 81?" he jokes. "Is there any surgical advice I can give you? Well, no. I've had no surgery, no antibiotics. I've got no secret recipe. I drink coffee, tea, booze. I use the lot."

"They say the ways of sin are many and most of them enjoyable but well worth it," he said, adding that his wife of 56 years, Louise, is a nutritionist and makes sure he eats well.

Dr. Zollinger was raised in Ohio on his father's farm and both he and his brother went to medical school, his brother to Harvard and Robert to Ohio State University.

He graduated from Ohio State in 1927 and was interned to Harvard under the great neurosurgeon, Dr. Harvey Cushing, in 1932.

When America entered the second world war, Zollinger was sent to Europe working first in Northern Ireland, then in Salisbury, England, and finally, after the Normandy invasion, in Farenton, France, where he was made commanding officer of the Fifth General Hospital.

At the end of the war he returned to his alma mater, Ohio State University, where he entered the Department of Surgery. He retired as chairman of that department ten years ago.

Dr. Zollinger's son, Robert, is a graduate of Harvard Medical School and Associate Professor of Surgery at Western Reserve University in Ohio, and a daughter, Myra, who is a graduate of Wellesley College and a realtor in Chapel Hill, North Carolina. He also has five grandchildren.

He has been visiting Sanibel since 1939 staying at various resorts on the island.

"Why don't you write about what makes people keep coming back to Sanibel for more than 40 years?" You won't be able to write more than two paragraphs about me," he challenged.

### FAMILY STROMBIDAE

Genus *Strombus*

Species 11 (1756)

Common Name *Strombus*

This member of the large family Strombidae is not found in Sanibel but is native to the east Florida Keys, the West Indies and the mid-Atlantic. Over-shelling for food and souvenirs has severely depleted this species in many areas where often even immature shells are taken leaving few to reproduce.

The mature shell is large and heavy, varying in height from 6 to 12 inches and is characterized by its large flaring outer lip which is sometimes higher than the spire. Rich shades of pink, orange and yellow, occasionally in center of the lip, are visible in the aperture. The inside of the shell is yellowish white with a thin tan or brown stripe which flakes off easily when dry. It has a high, strongly angled spire with large pointed knobs on the last three whorls. Like others in this family, *Strombus* has a strophodont

mouth at the lower end of the flaring outer lip

and a small, fleshy, dextral siphon which is a lever against the sand for breathing and against predators. The adult mature shell is typically 10 to 12 inches high without siphon as pearls for shell oysters.

Immature shells called "nipples" have a quite different appearance. They are relatively high spired, narrow pointed base and lack the expanded lip of the mature shell.

World wide there are about 70 species in five genera with approximately 11 in the Americas but only one genus, *Strombus*, is found in the Florida Keys. Two of the *Strombus* species, *Strombus pugilis* and *Strombus alatus*, have previously been included in this column. They are shallow water species which has helped lead to their rapid decline in the West Indies and Florida Keys.

Habitat is in the sand and rubble, usually near or in the grass in water five to 15 feet deep.

Range is from southeastern Florida to the West Indies and as far south as Venezuela.

### The Samoyed: a delight to behold

When the famous Norwegian explorer Fridtjof Nansen was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1922 one wonders if his thoughts went back in time to the monumentally grueling undertaking he and his companions underwent in 1893 to reach the North Pole. At age 32, he overcame many perils and hazards by his determination and zealous ambition to fulfill his dreams. The journey was to last a long three years with many difficulties to conquer and a big factor insuring the success of the expedition was the team of his 28 Samoyed sled dogs.

Many other famous explorers such as Scott and another Norwegian called Roald Amundsen, to name just two, were to use Samoyeds to pull supplies, often twice their own weight, joyously and tirelessly.

The magnificent Samoyed is a delight to behold with his dazzling white coat seeming to symbolize the Antarctic snow and icebergs.

Originating in Siberia with the nomadic Samoyed Indian tribes, this dog was originally bred to guard herds of reindeer and is one of the oldest northern Spitz breeds.

When the breed was first taken to England more than a hundred years ago, the color was often black or brown, but gradually the predominantly white became the officially accepted color.

Admitted to the American Kennel Club in 1909, the Samoyed has been a consistent contender and many times winner in the show ring.


The height of the Samoyed is about 23 inches, with a medium length muzzle and black lips. If ever a dog was to be described as smiling, it is certainly the Samoyed which in reality, has a slight curve at the corners of his mouth.

Ears should be strong and thick, erect with lots of hair covering inside as well as out. Dark animated eyes which always look lively and sparkling are indicative of the breed.

Tail should be fairly long and well feathered, sometimes carried over the back or side, and straight sturdy legs. A large, hare-like foot with arched toes, having a protective covering of hair, and thick tough pads, are characteristic.

The Samoyed is double-coated with an undercoat of short soft hair, while the outer coat consists of longer harsh hair. This weather resistant coat should have no curl or waviness to it whatever, with the male having a longer coat than the female. A ruff around head and shoulders frames his head with a glistening, silver like sheen.

For a docile, devoted, intelligent companion one could do no better than having a Samoyed for a lifelong companion.




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
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
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

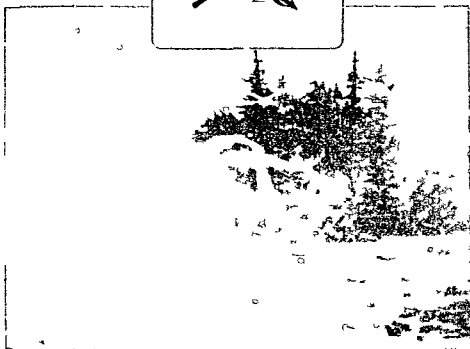

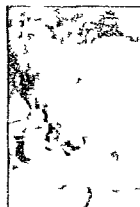
He and his wife, Alice, now make their home in Fort Myers.

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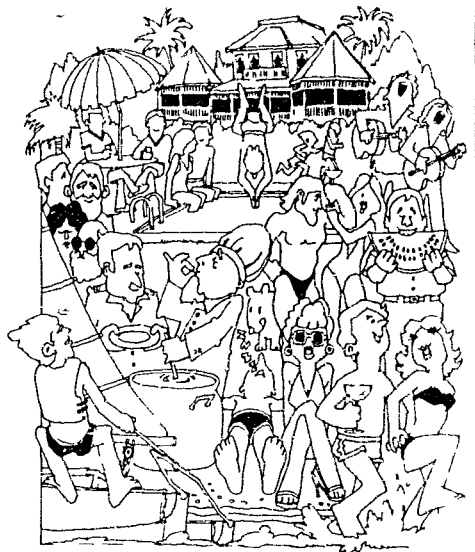

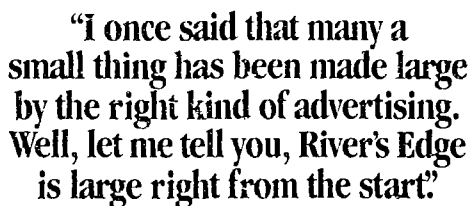

### Grouper, snapper, sea bass bag limits should apply to all

A press release issued by the Marine Fisheries Commission (MFC) states that the commission temporarily withdrew its rule recommendations for grouper, snapper and sea bass from governor and cabinet consideration to allow the commission time to study unintended impacts of proposed bag limit regulations.

The rule was withdrawn because Florida League of Anglers (FLA) representing the interests of Florida's recreational fishermen strenuously objected to having the primary burden of conserving the fisheries placed once again on recreational fishermen.

Although the proposed rule would have limited the number of hooks that could be used on commercial longlines, it put no limit on commercial catches. Longlines are little used in state waters, but slash nets and sink nets are proliferating in the keys. Those nets take not only the target species but homelish and other game fish. No restrictions were proposed for the net gear.

FLA argued that if the problem with the grouper, snapper fishery is as great as enough to warrant bag limits on recreational fishermen, bag limits should also be placed on commercial fishermen.

Further, the definition of a recreational fisherman as one who does not hold a license to sell fish would be ineffective in conserving the resource. Anyone who purchased a \$25 saltwater products license would not be subject to the bag limits, nor would a businessman in the seafood industry who possessed a seafood wholesaler's license.

The impact of fishing on Florida's economy surpasses that of citrus and cattle.

Saltwater recreational fishing pumped nearly \$5 billion a year into Florida's economy, while saltwater commercial fishing contributed only \$288 million — and that was back in 1981. When an extensive economic study of Florida's marine fisheries was conducted by Dr. Frederick W. Bell and Associates in Florida

State University.

The university's *Research in Review Bulletin* in 1984 summarized Dr. Bell's conclusion. "No matter who is to blame for the alleged ill health of Florida's fisheries, Florida's government officials would be foolish to consistently favor commercial interests over sports interests in deciding how Florida's saltwater fisheries should be managed."

The time is long overdue for those charged with the responsibility for managing Florida's saltwater fisheries to grasp the reality of Florida's saltwater fishing, and that reality is that recreational fishermen produce many times the revenue generated by Florida's entire commercial fishing industry (the major part of which comes from shellfish harvesting — not finfish).

Over the years, the economic impact of recreational fishing in Florida has grown until it far surpasses that of commercial fishing.

Over the years, recreational fishermen have willingly accepted restrictions on sizes and bags imposed on advice of fishery managers as the best way to conserve fish stocks and preserve the resource for future generations. Put recreational anglers see no justification or equanimity in releasing their catches to comply with bag limits while commercial fishermen are permitted to make unlimited catches and profits.

Recreational fishermen are still willing to accept restrictions deemed necessary for conservation of the resource, but the time has come for fishery managers to consider the economics of fishing, and decide where each species will have the most value to all the people of the state — as a commercial species or as a recreational species.

For those species determined to be of primary economic value as a recreational fish, commercial harvest should be curtailed or prohibited.

Recreational anglers no longer should be asked to continue to pay for the past sins of users of exploitive harvesting gear.

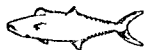
Most local anglers feel that redfish should be immediately named a gamefish with no sale permitted and netting for trout should be prohibited.

Bait and method: Sandbugs, shrimp or small nylon lugs sometimes tipped with piece of shrimp or a sandbug. State law: Minimum length 9 inches from tip of nose to fork of tail.



### SHIVER SPATROUT

— Season: Year round

Location: San Carlos Bay, Pine Island Sound, Caloosahatchee River. Feeding habits: Bottom to mid water. Bait and method: Shrimp live or dead, pilehards, small jugs. This is a small fish seldom more than 1 inches in length.



### BLUESH

— Season: Migratory

A few stay along the upper shore line year round. Location: Along the Gulf shoreline, a few come in to San Carlos Bay and Pine Island Sound in passing. Feeding habits: Mid to surface water feeder. Bait and method: Live shrimp or pilehards, silvery spoons, lures or feathered jugs on wire leaders due to sharp teeth of bluesh. State law: Minimum length 10 inches from tip of nose to fork of tail.

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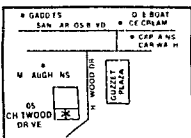
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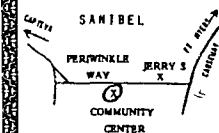
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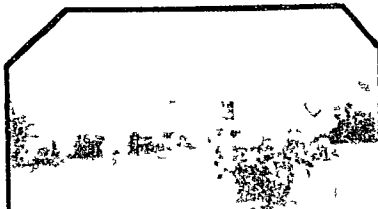
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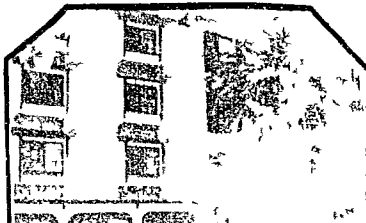
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The Metropolitan Opera broadcast premiere of George Gershwin's "Porgy and Bess" will be broadcast live in stereo from the Metropolitan Opera House on Saturday, March 23, at 2 p.m. over WSFP-FM 90.1 Concert 90.

Roberta Alexander, in her Met broadcast debut, will sing Bess, and Simon Estes will be heard as Porgy, with Marvis Martin as Clara and Florence Quivar as Serena. Making their Met broadcast debut will be Charles Williams as Sportin' Life, Greg Baker as Crown, and David Arnold as Jake. James Levine will conduct and Peter Allen is the announcer. During the first intermission, Robert Jacobson, editor-in-chief of *Opera News* and *Ballet News*, will talk with Francis Gershwin Godowsky, the sister of George Gershwin about Gershwin and "Porgy and Bess." "Texaco's Opera Quiz" returns for the second inter-

mission with panelists Alfred Hubay, the Metropolitan Opera's box office manager; Robert Jacobson; and David Reuben, press and public relations director for the Met.

The Metropolitan's production of "Porgy and Bess" celebrated the 50th anniversary of the work which had its premiere in Boston on September 30, 1935. Gershwin was first attracted to the story after reading the novel "Porgy" by DuBoise Heyward in 1926. Heyward provided the text for the opera and he and Gershwin spent much of 1934 in Charleston, S.C., the setting for "Porgy and Bess," observing the local people and customs. It was at this time that Otto Kahn, chairman of the Metropolitan Opera's board of directors, approached Gershwin about presenting

"Porgy and Bess" at the Metropolitan, but Kahn died early in 1934 before these arrangements could be completed.

"Porgy and Bess" received only mixed notices at its 1935 premiere, but extensive performances since then, including U.S. State Department-sponsored tour from 1952 to 1958 to Europe, Asia, and South America, featuring Leontyne Price, William Warfield, and Cab Calloway, led to its great popularity today. It was during this tour that it became the first American opera to be performed at La Scala.

For many years 'Porgy and Bess' was presented in compromised versions.—Cuts were made, recitatives were replaced by spoken dialogue, or less than the full orchestration was used. The Met's production is being performed without cuts, with recitatives as composed by Gershwin.

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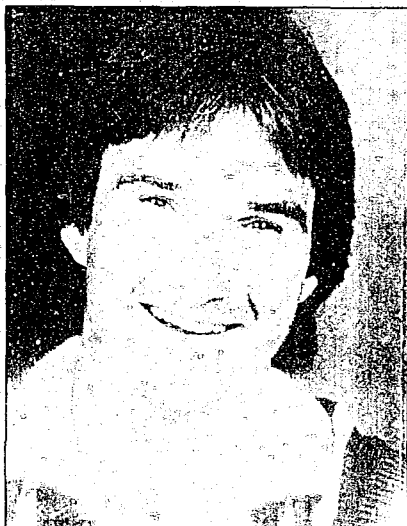
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### Modern works by CSO

The conductor, Peter Allen, will be the announcer.

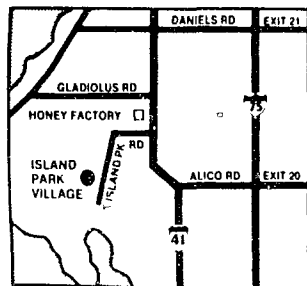

### Rules of thumb about home buying

**QUESTION** We are a young couple and would like to purchase a home. As this will be our first home, can you give us some information that would be helpful to us?

**ANSWER** A home will probably be one of the largest investments you will make in your lifetime, and at the same time if it is your first it may cause many sleepless nights up through closing and possibly a little longer. This is typical of all first time home buyers.

The price of your home as a rule of thumb has been no more than two and one half times your gross income. This generally is true unless interest rates go back to 14 per cent and higher. You should spend no more than 25 per cent of your average monthly income on housing expense.

**EXAMPLE** If your gross income is \$20,000 you can handle a payment of \$415 a month principal and interest, \$25,000 gross, \$520 and \$30,000 gross, \$625 a month. Taxes and insurance will be added to this payment which could add another \$65 to \$100 a month.

Find yourself a good real estate agent that you feel comfortable with. Be honest with them as to what you make and your other long and short term expenses. Have them show you how much you will be able to save on your taxes and what your deductions will be and buy location.

**QUESTION** I have been told to put in estate in a trust. What kinds of trusts are there?

**ANSWER** There are basically two kinds: those you create while you're alive called living or inter vivos trusts and those that become active after your death called testamentary trusts.

Living trusts can be either revocable or ir-

revocable. The former means you can get your assets back according to the terms of the trusts. The latter means you give the assets away for good with no strings and you can never get them back.

Trusts can be used to assure a lifelong stipend for a spouse or other relative from the income they generate with the assets going say to a child or grandchild on the income beneficiary's death.

This serves two valuable functions: first, it assures an income for someone who might not otherwise possess enough financial income to use the capital wisely; second, it can save a good deal in estate taxes because in effect the assets are taxed only once while serving two functions.

Trusts can fill other important roles to even while you're alive in terms of preserving capital and splitting income among family members.

**D**espite the cliches and corn 'Micki and Maude' is fun. But don't expect anything new or in sightful from this movie. The plot centers on the old familiar love triangle with a television newsmen called Salinger played by Dudley Moore in love with both Micki, a young cellist and Maude, his successful lawyer wife. Racked by guilt because he doesn't feel guilty about the affair, Moore can't decide which woman he wants because he wants them both. 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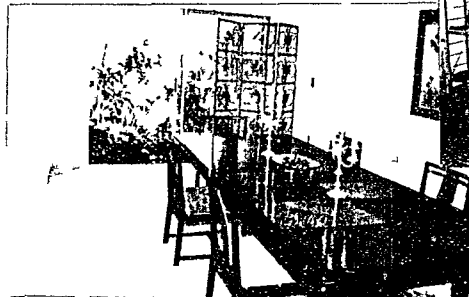



The congregation, founded by Dr. James Enhart in 1977, has met in various locations over the years, including the Lighthouse Condominiums, Sanibel Community Center and The Dunes clubhouse, where worship was often accompanied by the ringing of the cash register in an adjoining room. In the fall of 1981, Father James D. B. Hubbs and the parishioners of St. Michael and All Angels Episcopal Church invited the group to use their building. Since that time, and under the leadership of the Rev. Richard Stein, the congregation has grown to 116 members.

In March 1984, the building fund drive was held. Architect George Tuttle of Captiva was hired to design the building, and contractor George Parker was hired as builder.

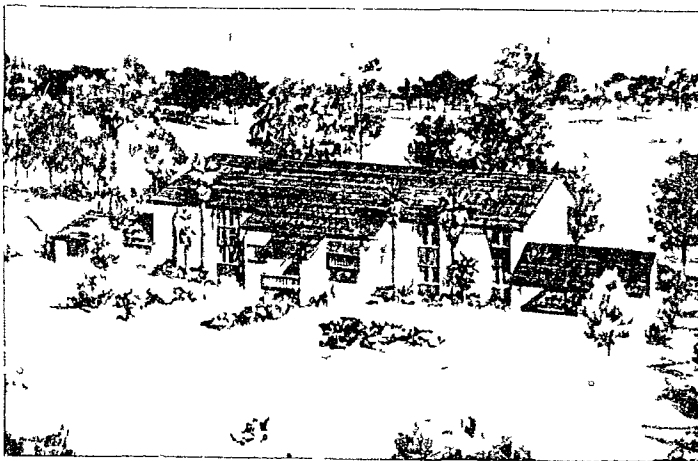

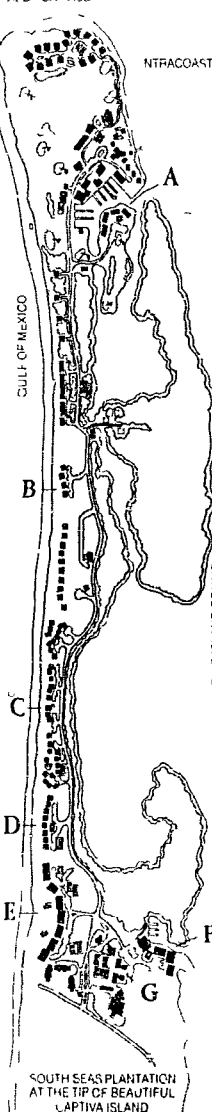

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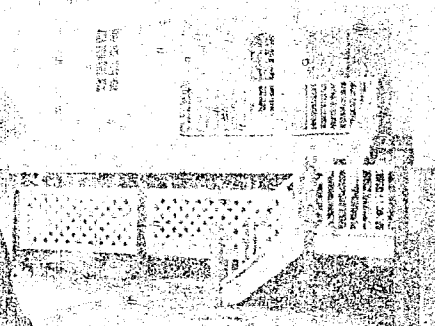

citizen of it. This implies respect for fellow members and also respect for the natural community.

One hundred years ago the Plains section of the United States was being purchased from Indians and opened to homesteaders. Native Americans had little concept of land ownership. They believed land was not a commodity to be bought and sold, but a gift to all living things. One young chief tried to describe their land ethic to the Great White Father:

Our land is more valuable than your money. It will last forever. It will not ever perish by the flames of fire. As long as the sun shines and the waters flow, the land will be here to give life to men and animals. We cannot sell the life of man or an animal, therefore, we cannot sell the land. We cannot sell it because it does not belong to us.

But the land was sold. Farming began in earnest without regard to the natural community. Nutrients were taken without being replaced. Moisture holding native vegetation was stripped, soil was tilled and open to the erosional forces of wind and rain. Poor farming practices dried up wetlands

and wildlife. Wetlands all added up to the Drying. Thirty years ago, the wetlands took flight and disappeared. With the loss of the wetlands, the wildlife, particularly waterfowl.


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

## GYMNASTICS CHAMP

11 year old Carrie Weaver earns a chance to compete in a state tournament

She charges the springboard with lightning speed and performs her vault with one thing in mind: stick it.

Some day I might want to make it to the Olympics, says island gymnast Carrie Weaver who will be competing in state championships this weekend in Tampa.

The 11 year old earned her spot in state competition after placing first overall in the Class II sectional tournament in Miami on March 9 where she captured first places in both uneven parallel bars and floor exercise, second place in the vault and fourth on the balance beam.

Her consistent scoring won her top honors overall in the intermediate level of the nine teams group.

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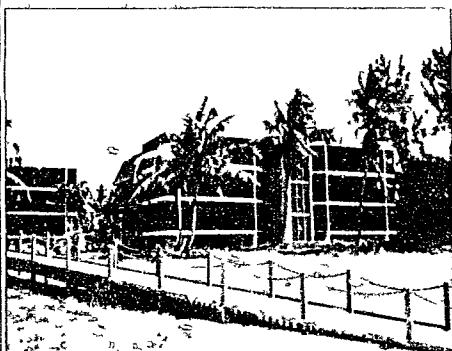

## sanibel sightings

### Rare rail and black-necked stilt seen in Bailey Tract

By George Weymouth

Allen Riske tipped the nose of the rental Piper up and his friend Barbara and I were airborne from Pope Field. I was about 3:30 p.m. Thursday, March 11, and they had invited me to help them look for myrales.

We flew over Cape Corri and were awed at the immensity of this huge development, and then on to Pine Island Sound and its barrier islands including Sanibel and Captiva.

Though we failed to spot any myrales we did see schools of bottlenosed dolphins and for this area, very clear water around Boca Grande Pass. Since my article mostly covers bird sightings etc. of this area, the plane trip did confirm one hunch I had for a while: the white pelicans have departed this area. Earlier that morning I conducted a tour through the J.N. Ding Darling

Refuge's Memorial Drive. Just after crossing over the traffic count we looked back over the most recent nesting of the hooded malaris. On a flight through my Bushnell spotting scope we sighted five western kingbirds and a song-crowned flycatcher that have been sighted near that area now for about three weeks. So they were still there.

The next day, the 14th, Barbara and I saw just down river for east of the tower along the Sanibel Captivity Conservation Foundation trails, the glossy ibis thus been here also for about three weeks, usually being seen in the Bailey Tract.

That same morning I thought I saw an eastern kingbird near the refuge headquarters but failed to confirm it. However, the next morning K.C. Emerson did see an eastern kingbird. He also saw

a Cooper's hawk past the tower about the 14th. On Sunday he sighted in the Bailey Tract a blue rail, an extremely small rail, and a very rare black-necked stilt. He also saw a black-necked stilt. Finally, they returned to Sanibel's winter residents to nest about St. Patrick's Day (about May 1st). This year from a number of sightings they were seen about one week earlier.

This last weekend I had the pleasure of coming down Peace River near Arcadia with a group of young people and their parents. We cruised about six miles and would check out the birds where there were gravel bars, for example. We did find some and I had the added pleasure of pointing out a number of swallow-tailed kites courting above us. If I were reincarnated into a bird I'd either pick a frigate or this species of kite for they are to me the masters of the air.
