Independence Day: a memorable celebration



Crews from Stemic Marine Construction have built a temporary dock at the Sanibel Boat Ramp as part of their project to dredge the entrance to Shell Harbour. The landing space provides a place to load and offload equipment and dredged shell as the project progresses.

The dock consists of twelve-inch concrete pilings arranged in a criss cross pattern, resting on flat concrete slabs on the sea floor, according to Butch Jones, coowner of Stemic. When the dredging barges return to the dock with the "dirty shell" from the harbor entrance, a crane transfers the shell from a barge to a dump truck for

The shell is a good quality material, according to the City of Sanibel Department of Public Works, and will remain on Sanibel for use in re-grading roads.

The project will remove approximately 1200 cubic yards of shell from the harbor entrance, according to Jones, and is expected to be complete early this month.




meringue. An alternate topping is fresh bananas and fresh cream.



- 1. More than 98 percent of convicted felons are bread users.

- 3. Fully HALF of all children who grow up in bread-consuming households score below average on standardized

It is also hypothesized that Florida's bread eaters are utterly unable to distinguish between significant, relevant, scientific fact and emotionally potent but meaningless statistical pap. It's not as if someone had actually paid Save Our Bridge to change the name or if Save Our Bridge might have fabricated a possibly fraudulent name for financial reward, they just over-reached a bit.

Unquestionably these people are concerned about the bay — we all are. S.O.B. members are smart, energetic, organized and well led. Legitimate efforts to Save Our Bay need true leadership. So please, S.O.B. become what your new name professes and bring forth the leadership that we need. But until the group attains relevance with its name, we must recognize overreach for what it is.

The point of this letter is that everyone be alert and question rather than blindly


accept the relevance of statistics and emphasis. Insist that folks and committees represent themselves as what they truly

AN OPEN LETTER TO THE CITY OF SANIBEL

July 01, 2004

RE: Referendum Vote Proposing the Sale of City-Owned Land to J.N. "Ding" Darling National Wildlife Refuge

Dear Fellow Citizens:

Sambel City Council unanimously passed a resolution on March 30, 2004 calling for a mail ballot referendum to consider the sale of City-owned land within the Environmentally Sensitive Lands Conservation District to the J.N. "Ding" Darling Wildlife Refuge. The property proposed for sale consists of two parcels along San-Cap Road adjacent to the Refuge with such sale conditioned upon the protection and preservation of both parcels in their current and natural states. Proceeds from the sale of the property will be deposited to the City's General Fund. The sale price for the two parcels is \$500,000.

In accordance with the City Charter, Section 3.10.1, actions by the City to sell, exchange, donate or otherwise alienate City-owned land within the Environmentally Sensitive Lands Conservation District requires affirmative vote of the majority of electors at a referendum called for that purpose.

The mail ballot election for the qualified electors of the City of Sanibel will be held on July 15, 2004 to determine if the majority of electors participating in the referendum are in favor of the sale of this property. If you are a registered Sanibel voter, the Lee County Supervisor of Elections will mail a ballot to your home address asking if you approve of the sale of the two parcels of property. You may answer either "yes" or "no" relative to the sale of the property. For your vote to be counted, you must return your ballot to the Supervisor of Elections for certification of the results. The City Council will declare the election results at a

We would also like to take this opportunity to enclose additional new City material. We have enclosed the City's alligator brochure, our updated recycling magnet and very important flood facts.

In closing, we strongly encourage you to participate in the July 15, 2004 mail ballot referendum.

Tree dracaena is a tropical relative of the Spanish bayonet

Dear Ron: I bought a plant that was tagged "blooming Dracaena arborea" I've been trying to find some information on this plant, which I really like, but I can't come up with anything. Can you help?

– Linda, Cape Coral

Dear Linda: Commonly known as tree dracaena, this tropical member of the Agavacae family is not a true dracaena at all, but more closely related

to yuccas, such as the Spanish bayonet. Its downward-arcing, thick leaves are lush and green; they emerge in single heads from each cylindrical brown trunk. About once a year, they produce very pretty, creamy white flowers. Reaching typical heights of 45 feet at maturity, the tree dracaena likes full sun to partial shade and moist soil. It has a moderate growth rate.

Dracaena arborea is native to tropical America, adaptable to Florida hardiness zones 10 and 11, and is highly salt-tolerant.

Brown leaf edges indicate presence of spider mites

Dear Ron: Why are the edges of my mango leaves turning brown? It gets plenty of water and the fruit is fine.

Dear Lynn: Your mango has likely been infested with spider mites, which are prevalent during the dry, hot conditions we've experienced lately. The brown edges of your mango's leaves is a

typical indication of their presence.

Spray the foliage with an insecticidal soap solution made of 2 tablespoons of "pure" soap (Ivory, Dove or Castille) per gallon of water. Do it in the morning before 10 a.m. and repeat the spraying in a week.

Until the rainy season sets in, it would be wise to hose down the foliage with water once a week thereafter.

Use fresh seeds when trying to plant mangos

Dear Ron: How do we start a seedling from a seed of an apple mango? We have yet to find a nursery that sells this variety of mango, which is

apple-size, very sweet and not too fibrous. We have a few seeds from the original tree and would like to grow them with the intention of growing the tree in our yard.

– Mimi Čochran, Cape Čoral

Dear Mimi: It is difficult to germinate mango seeds that have dried out, so I'm not optimistic. However, you could try soaking the seeds for 24 hours in lukewarm water. Then plant them 3 to 4 inches deep in a porous planting mixture. Keep the soil

moist (but not wet), and — if you successful —seedlings should emerge within a couple of weeks.

By the way, mangos produce two kinds of seeds: Some contain single embryos; others have multiple embryos and will produce more than one seedling. It should be pointed out, however, that mango trees grown from seeds rarely produce quality fruit, so I would continue your search of nurseries.

The mango (Mangifera indica) is native to India and Burma, adaptable to zones 10 and 11,

and is moderately salt-tolerant.

Magnolia blooms are showing signs of fungus

Dear Ron: I have a young (year-old) magnolia tree about two feet tall. A few weeks ago it started having buds all over. The first one grew very

large (about 3 inches long), and was white and waxy-looking. Just as the flower was about to open it turned all brown (in two days) and the inside appeared to be rot-

The other buds seem to have stopped developing also. What happened?

- Elisabeth Benny Fort Myers Beach Dear Elisabeth: Your magnolia is suffering bud rot, which is a fungus that is likely the result of poor soil drainage or overwatering. Drench the soil and spray the foliage with fungicide, and ease up on the watering.

Your magnolia is probably the "Little Gem" cultivar of the traditional southern magnolia. It is more heat-tolerant than the original, doing well in Florida hardiness zones 8-10, and is the best choice for South Florida.

The little gem has the typical glossygreen, leathery leaves and the familiar showy white, very fragrant blossoms, which it produces spring and summer. But unlike the pure species of southern magnolia, which can tower to 80 feet, the little gem rarely exceeds 30 feet.

The smaller size and its dense growth habit makes it good for a tall hedge or landscape screen, as well as a specimen tree. When full grown, it will have a canopy width of 10 to 12 feet.

The little gem magnolia (Magnolia grandiflora "little gem") is a slow-growing Florida native cultivar that likes full sun to part shade and is moderately salt-tolerant.







Most of a house can be recycled

Sandcastle Construction Company of Sanibel and Gruelle Construction Inc. of Fort Myers are completing the first recyused for the slab foundation and driveway of the new house that will be built on the lot.

A building, according to Michael Valiquette of Sandcastle Construction, is "99 percent recyclable." Recycling with the concrete crusher is also a less expensive process than shipping material off Sanibel

cling of a residential structure on Sanibel.

After the structure, a house on West Gulf Drive, was demolished, workers separated out wood, aluminum, copper, steel and concrete. According to Michael Valiquette of Sandcastle Construction and Dan Macauley from Gruelle's Demolition Division, the wood was mulched and the metals sent to the mainland for recycling.

The concrete remained on Sanibel for processing by a concrete crusher. Once the concrete is fully pulverized, it will be reand bringing back newly quarried rock, says Valiquette. It also reduces the amount that goes into landfills.

Dan Macauley adds that Gruelle has been recycling structures on the mainland, including shopping centers, for approximately four years. The company also recycled materials for a Sanibel sewer plant project. This is the first time a house on Sanibel has been processed in this way.



apartment on Beach Road. The officers found two females Annette Cummings of Fort White and Sandra Bonds of Gainesville, FL, standing in pajamas at the comer of East Gulf Drive and Beach Road. On 06/26, Officer Rachel Bauer-Fithian, on uniform patrol in a marked Sanibel Police Department vehicle, responded to a dispatch regarding a car swerving on the road eastbound on the Sanibel Captiva Road at Mile Marker #5. On the Sanibel Captiva Road, and again on Palm Ridge Road, the officer reportedly observed the full width of the driver's side tires cross the center lane marker. At 2146 hours, the officer initiated a vehicle stop.

Sgt. Thompson joined the officer at the scene. As the officer and the Sergeant approached the vehicle, both reportedly observed the back seat passenger attempting to push something under the front passenger seat. When the officer asked the driver, Lois Kerly Dezura, for her driver's license, the officer reportedly observed that Mrs. Dezura's eyes were bloodshot and watery and that her speech was slurred. 








"When we were told about the river otters, we became excited, knowing that Michael would have loved to have been thought of in this way". CROW shared with the Hardenbergh's that their river ofter patients usually come as orphans, and because of this, they are the longest term patients, as they typically stay with the mother for seven months before the mother sends them off on their own. As a result, CROW also keeps them for that length of time. Because of their boundless energy and high metabolism, river otters are voracious eaters.

In preparing them for the wild, it is important to feed them live fish etc., which can get very expensive. Otters are also excellent swimmers, after they learn how to swim, and as a result, the otter compound has a pool area which needs regular cleaning and maintenance. All in all, the cost of preparing a baby river otter for release back into the wild is approximately \$600 per otter.

Because baby season is now over and the last baby river otter patients were released successfully back into the wild a few weeks ago, the Hardenbergh's will wait until next January when CROW typically receives six to eight baby river otters each season. They will be sent photographs of the babies and mailed updates, with a final photo of their release back into the wild.


