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Rogers and Zimomra lauded at COTI's 30th

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Bruce Rogers, who recently retired as director of planning for the City of Sanibel, was honored by the Committee of the Islands at their 30th annual meeting on Friday, March 18 at the Sanibel Congregational United Church of Christ.

Rogers was presented with a Lifetime Achievement Award by COTI in the form of a large glass vase etched by noted Sanibel artist Luc Century.



Rogers worked for the city from 1978 until this past January. During this time he has been instrumentally involved in a great many of the issues and decisions faced by the city since its incorporation.

COTI also presented their Outstanding Citizen of the Year award to City Manager Judie Zimomra for her acclaimed work and planning for the city and the island before, during and after Hurricane Charley last August. As we go to press, Zimomra is preparing to fly to New Orleans for a national hurricane conference where she will also receive an award and make a presentation later this week.

Zimomra was unable to attend the COTI meeting in person but was presented a similar Luc Century vase in absentia by Wayne Ponader, past president of COTI. Reached for comment on Tuesday, she said "It's always nice to be recognized — I always appreciate it, but I only accept such awards on behalf of the entire city team."

Zimomra also stressed that she is going to the conference in New Orleans "not to brag — we're going to learn. You don't do this sort of thing to earn awards — you do it to make this a better community."

Following a brief review of the past year and recent election results, the secretary and the treasurer presented their annual reports. The committee then elected new directors and Carla Benninga and John Harries became the newest members of the board, replacing Andrew Reding and Past President Wayne Ponader. Herb Rubin and John Liljequist continue on the board

Planning denies Periwinkle development

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How much is too much? That question regarding Sanibel development was the focus of Tuesday's planning commission meeting as they conducted a public hearing and debated a proposed development permit and preliminary plat approval for 7.9 acres at 1881 Periwinkle Way. The property is adjacent to the former site of the Old Schoolhouse Theater and was previously occupied by Sanibel Landscape Company, a nursery business.

The application, submitted by owners Spring and Ronald Rosen, proposed dividing approximately 2.6 acres into seven lots for single family dwellings, to be clustered near the "front" of the property along

Okay, Maura, who was the best: Peter, Paul & Mary, Bob Dylan, Pete Seeger?

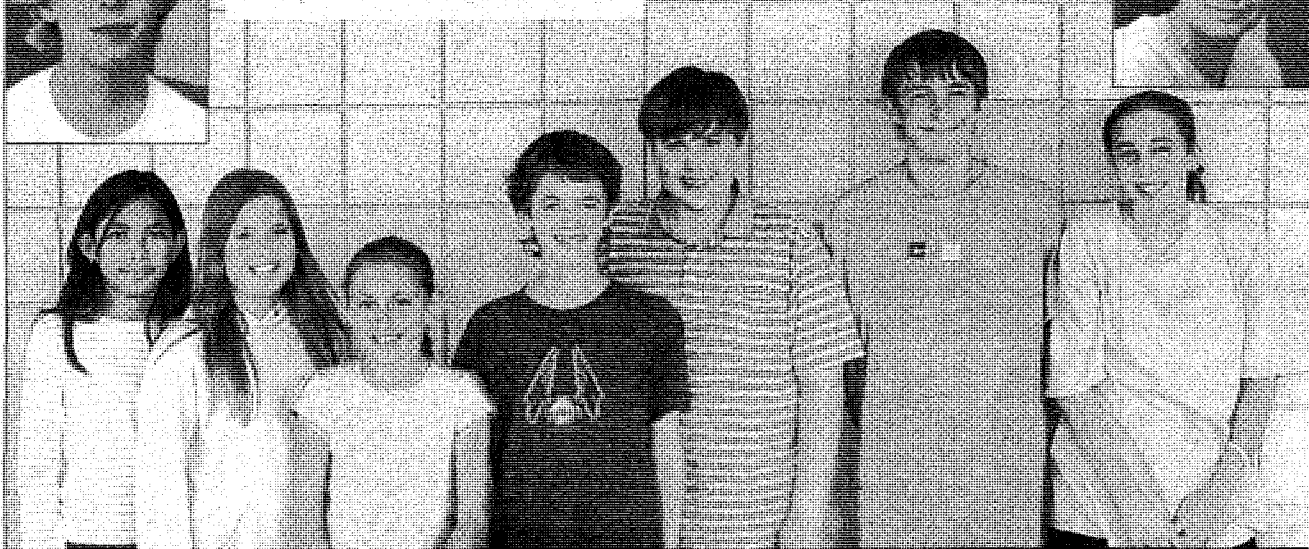
"My favorite was Neil Young," Maura said.

as do Tom Gilhooley, president, Jill Dillon, vice president, John Kramer, treasurer, and Bernie Lubetkin, secretary.

Bruce Rogers was the guest speaker for the event and for about 45 minutes he delighted his audience with some of his "reflections." Having been on the job for the past 27 years, he is in the rare position to explain to his listeners just how certain aspects of island life came to be.

He harked back to the early days of the city and some of the challenges it faced, such as the Rate of Growth Ordinance (ROTO) which was intended to limit the number of permits for new houses each year. City council at the time decided to let the question go directly to voters as a referendum where it passed by a wide margin.

Ironically, Rogers reflected on how the actual result of the ordinance was the reverse of what was intended. Fewer single family homes were built while more condominiums and time-shares were erected. ROTO was eventually repealed.

Rogers also recalled the battle over McDonalds and whether or not the island should have a fast-food restaurant. Citizen groups opposed the chain and fought hard to keep them off the island. McDonalds was accustomed to community opposition, however, they had already agreed to forego a drive-through window for take-out. According to Rogers' recollections, the McDonalds which had already been built on Fort Myers Beach turned out to be based on flawed traffic studies before construction. That, coupled with well-organized and vigorous community resistance, led the company to reconsider their plans and sell the land.

Rogers also spent some time recalling various arrangements negotiated with different developers over the years which resulted in improved beach parking areas for the public and more attractive architecture for the neighbors. His recollections made it clear that the atmosphere and environment enjoyed by islanders and visitors today is the result not only of dedicated citizens staying actively involved in the governing and growth of their community, but by less conspicuous efforts of equally dedicated civil servants willing to think creatively and solve problems for the benefit of all, not just a few.

Council and planning meet in joint session on EAR

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Sanibel City Council met with the planning commission in a special session Wednesday, March 16 to discuss changes and improvements to the city's Evaluation and Appraisal Report (EAR). The report is required by state law to be submitted to the Department of Community Affairs (DCA) every seven years. The deadline to have a final version of the EAR to the DCA is May 1.

A preliminary draft of the report was recently submitted to the DCA for critique and was returned with five suggested improvements, the focus of Wednesday's meeting, presided over by newly-elected Mayor Carla Johnston.

The five points of concern were received by acting City Planner Ken Pfalzer in a letter from DCA Principal Planner Bernard Piawah. The letter requested more thorough information and data on the subjects of intergovernmental coordination, beach carrying capacity and the development of programs to preserve nature. The council and commission addressed and discussed the recommendations point by point through the course of the meeting.

Sanibel City Manager Judie Zimomra began by explaining the EAR sent to DCA was a "work in progress," not the final report.

"The staff is prepared to make further revisions to the EAR," she said. "We did not submit a formal draft."

Zimomra added that cities sending preliminary versions of the EAR for review is a process the DCA prefers and encourages.

Pfalzer agreed.

"Planning is an ongoing process in the city of Sanibel," he said. "These are not complaints, but suggestions on how to make the document better."

The preparation of the EAR has also been ongoing with the planning commission and city council beginning work on the document in February, 2004.

Councilman Steve Brown praised the planning commission and compared writing the EAR to composing a college term paper.

"The planning commission has done a wonderful job of getting all the material together," Brown said. "This is like writing a college paper. We've done the research but the hard part is rolling up your sleeves and just doing it."

Brown also said DCA's requests are fairly straightforward.

"We know what they want. Let's do what they tell us to do," he said. "I don't mean to oversimplify this. I'm very proud of the work that's gone into this but it's a very sim-

ple thing they are asking us to do. They want us to identify the problems, find a course of action and solve the problems."

Planning Commissioner Patty Sprinkle said it's largely a matter of putting the EAR in a DCA-compatible format.

"The professor (Piawah) has said 'this is what I want' and it's loud and clear," Sprinkle said. "All you have to do is put it down and give it back to him in the format."

Public input was welcomed by the council and planning commission near the end of the meeting. Alice Robinson said the DCA should be made aware of Sanibel's unique culture and community involvement.

"Perhaps we should acknowledge in the introduction, Sanibel's accomplishments already," Robinson said.

Karen Storjohann said on the issue of intergovernmental cooperation, Sanibel should express a strong position regarding Lee County and the causeway.

"They want it as a money-making proposition, we view it as how we get to and from our homes," she said. "We want the money it costs to get here to be low, they want it to be high. It's not winnable."

It was decided to continue studying and discussing the EAR at the council's next regular meeting April 5.

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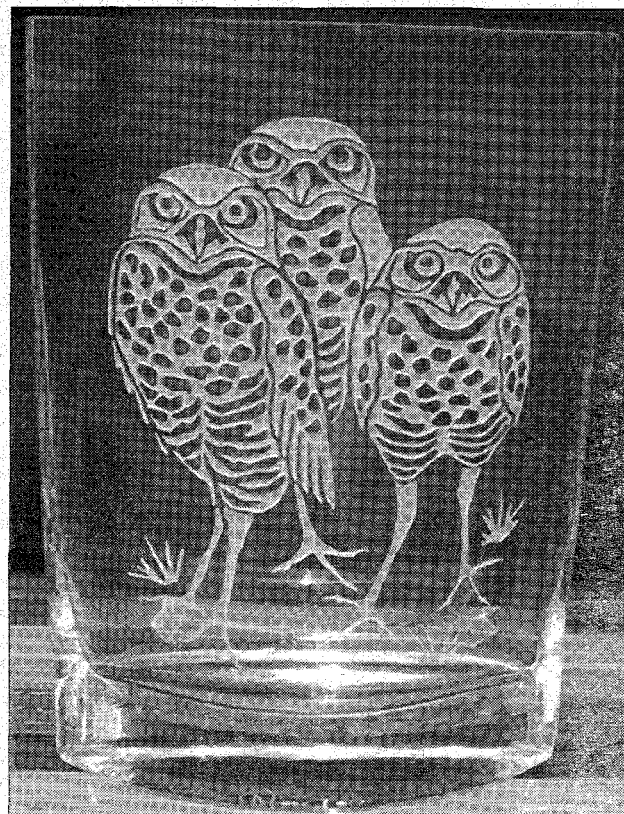

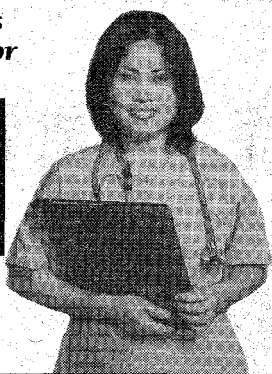

Sanibel Council adopted Ordinance 05-002 during February, 2005. This provides an Amendment to the Sanibel Code, adding a new section 126-940. This new section is to allow building access for people with disabilities and those who are elderly. It allows for deviations from the city's regulations without the need for any variances. And the city manager is authorized to issue the permit in a short form process. In other words, if a resident has a disability, or is elderly and needs special accommodations, such as an elevator or ramp, the process is short and uncomplicated. The City Manager issues the permit.

Recent statements to the contrary made in a letter to the editor by Maureen Valiquette, the wife of a planning commissioner, are just wrong. ECOSanibel is alive and well on Sanibel. In fact, their annual

Sears still stands

In today's dot-com world mail-order is a given. But 80 years ago? Well, yes. In fact, back then home sweet home could have been just a mailbox away.

Case in point is Morning Glories, the carefully renovated and meticulously maintained house alive and well at the Sanibel Historic Village and Museum.

Originally ordered from the Sears Roebuck 1924 Honor Bilt Homes catalog, this Springwood model was priced at \$2,211 not including plumbing, heating, wiring or the kitchen sink. And where to find these necessary extras? No problem. The Sears catalog had a sizeable section devoted to all these required items plus a wide

variety of doors, windows, moldings and other interchangeable building materials.

All a purchaser need do was select, order, and wait for boxcars to arrive, assuming you were within hauling distance of a railroad siding. (Here, of course, that meant adding a final barge leg for its island destination.)

Lacking available funds? Not to worry. Sears also provided money to finance it by granting mortgages. The

only money-related question asked, "what is your vocation?" Even English-language competency was unimportant; they boasted an entire department of interpreters.

When completed, the final order included about 30,000 pieces. Nails and hardware weighed in at some 750 pounds. Paint and varnish totaled 27 quarts. There was a detailed set of blueprints and a personalized 76-page instruction booklet.

Every stud, board, rafter, joist and molding was cut, notched, mitered and numbered to match the plan. The do-it-yourselfer needed only to provide masonry, labor and a building lot.

Two families, Ross and his brother Martin Mayer, lived next to one another on a waterfront site near the bottom of Bailey Road. Between them lay a shared artesian well, generating plant and bathhouse big enough to house the children and the servants. Electricity, relatively unknown on the island until 1945, made these two houses nearly unique in their being able to boast such a convenience.

Both homes were born in a Sears catalog. The first one, much larger, has had numerous extensions added over the years. Recently up for sale, its location no doubt helped determine the hefty asking price.

In 2001 Morning Glories, the smaller of the two, was given to the museum. Let curiosity be your guide and wander through the house, fully furnished in historically accurate Sears-provided furnishings.

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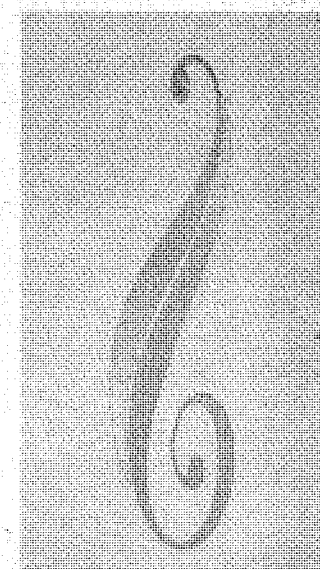

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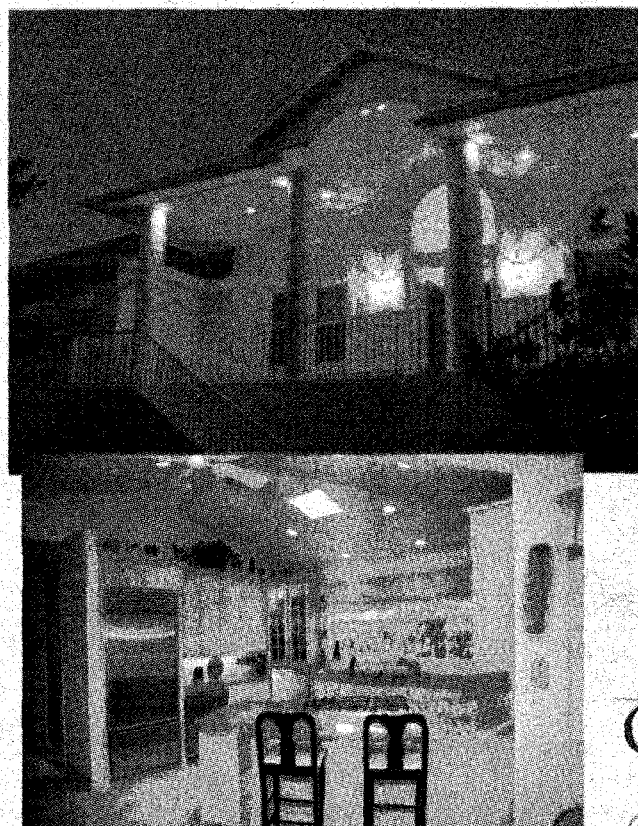

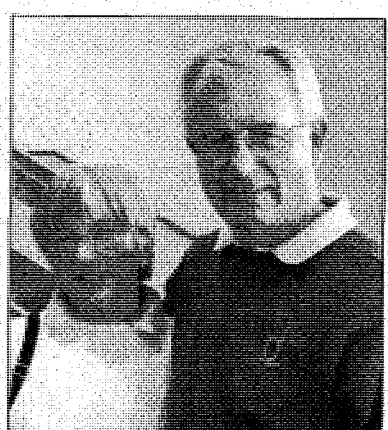

interesting trees and wildlife. And I think I have a better understanding of their culture."

Also a repeat winner was Carl Von Harten, who won previously at the state-wide level. This year he took a county prize in the Exhibit category, for his project "Unspeakable Ways of Communication." In this context, said Carl, "unspeakable" referred to the transmittal of information without speech. Native Americans of the Great Plains, he explained, used extensive nonverbal communication, including, "sign language, pictographs, narrative blankets, trail signs, and smoke signals."

Britt DeGenarro, who won first place in the Historical Paper category for his work "NAZI Propaganda," took inspiration for his project from the experiences of his grandmother, who was a civilian in Germany during WWII.

"I heard her stories and was intrigued to find out more," said Britt. "Her house was bombed during the war. So many Germans were blinded by the propaganda and did not realize that lives were being lost."

Asked "What lives were being lost?" Germans really thought the majority of going on under the Nazi regime, he replied, "I think most people didn't realize what was going on. They had devoted themselves to a cause, and it was hard to accept that the cause was wrong or unethical."

Britt's grandmother read his paper, and liked it. "She said the facts were right according to her experiences."

Students placing in first and second place at the county level move on to the State History Day in Tallahassee on May 6. Jones said they will be submitting the same entries.

"They can make minor improvements in them," she said. "But they are all really good already."

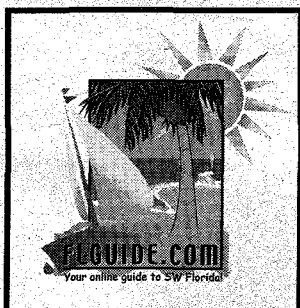
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'Shell Searching on the Coast of Ecuador, and a Visit to the Galapagos Islands'

The Island Inn began in the late 1800's as the home of Will and Harriet Matthews and their four children who traded in the

harsher climate of the north for the more temperate weather of Sanibel Island. Constantly entertaining friends and relatives from the north who flocked to visit, the Matthews decided to turn their home into a boarding house. And from this grew the gracious tradition of the historic Island Inn that now hosts families and friends from around the world.

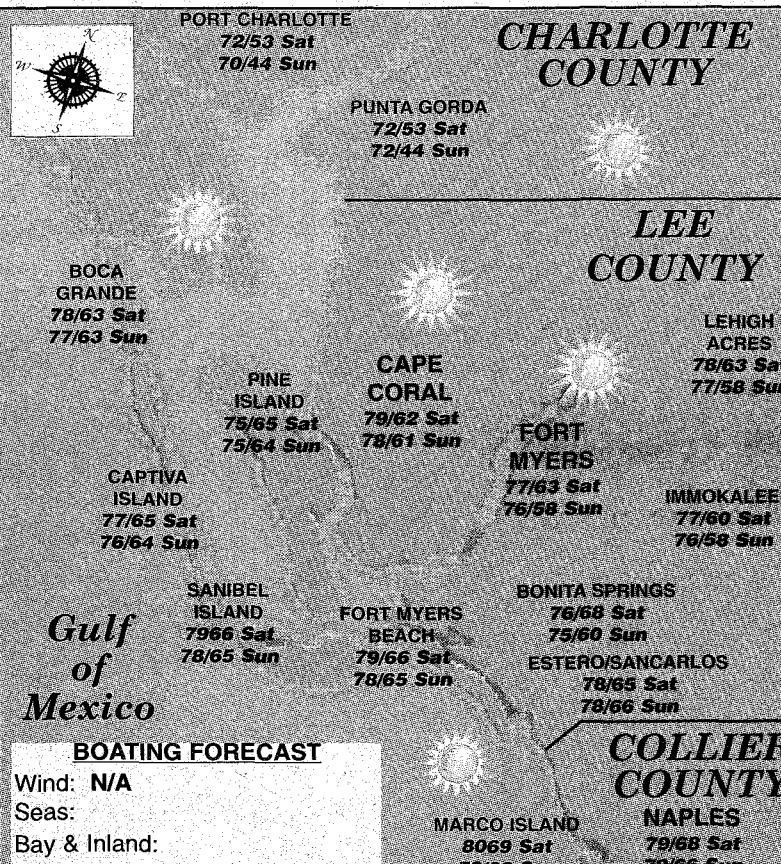

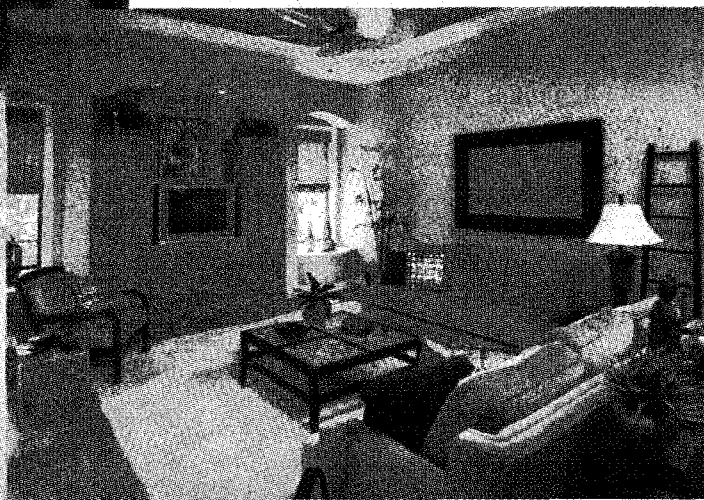
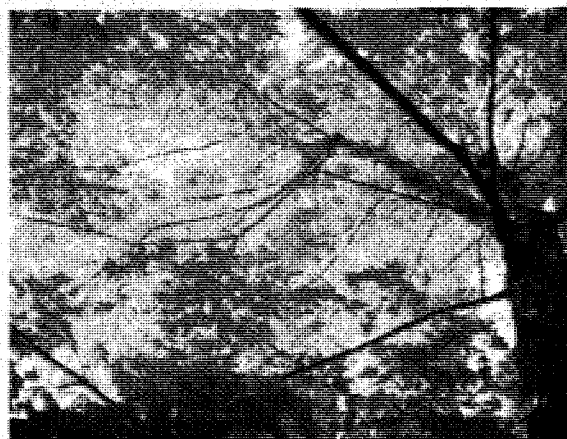
