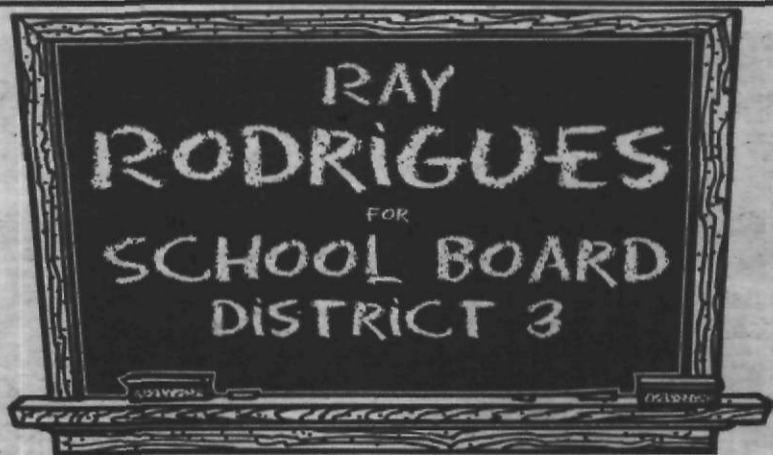

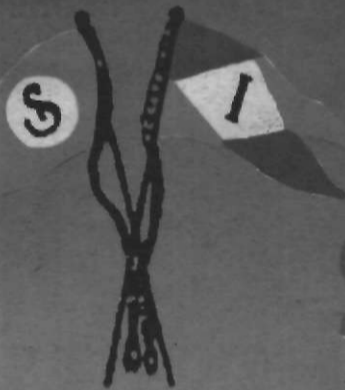

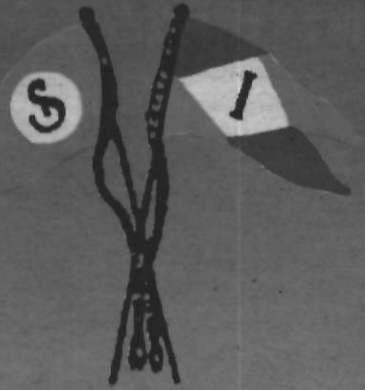

Schoolhouse gets two new additions to staff

The Schoolhouse Theater, located at 2200 Periwinkle way, is adding two new staff, a new music director and marketing director, to their employee roster for the fall season.

Former marketing director Mindy Montavon will be moving to Los Angeles in a month and Madison Mitchell, the actress who played Vicki Smith in the Schoolhouse's summer season production "Caught in the Net," will be taking her place. Mitchell is no stranger to the theater and is excited about beginning her new position at the Schoolhouse.

"I started doing theater when I was a little girl and have been hooked ever since! I've worked as an actor at many of our region's theaters doing both straight plays and musical theater. At the Schoolhouse, I was in this past season's "Lucky Stiff" and the summer's "Caught in the Net," Mitchell said.

"Currently," she continued, "I am a political communications major at Florida Gulf Coast University. I graduated from Cypress Lake Center for the Arts and lived in New York City where I attended HB Studios for theater. When not involved in the theatrical lifestyle I spend my time

with my multiple cats and dog, Clementine. I am looking forward to working with the Schoolhouse in the capacity of Marketing Director for this upcoming season."

Mitchell will be training for the next few weeks and will officially begin her new job on Sept. 8.

The Schoolhouse Theater hired their new music director, Justin Cowen, on Tuesday, Aug. 12. Cowen will be starting on Thursday, Sept. 25, just in time for local auditions for the upcoming Schoolhouse production "Play On."

The Schoolhouse's former music director, Mike Baer, left during the theater's production of "Lucky Stiff" last season. According to Montavon, "He wanted to play more independent gigs --he's a jazz musician by trade-- and wasn't looking for a career in musical theater."

"He'd been with us since the start of The Schoolhouse Theater at our new location. We were actually supposed to do two musical revues this summer, but without a music director it's impossible. So rather than rushing to try to find someone, Victor opted to do our two comedies instead," said Montavon.

But as for Montavon, she's excited about her upcoming move from the

sunshine state to sunny California.

"As for me, L.A. has always been where I wanted to go. I lived in New York City for seven years before coming here. I've always wanted to give the film/TV world a try, so that's the plan! I'm stoked, though of course sad to leave the area. Moving is always bitter-sweet," Montavon said.

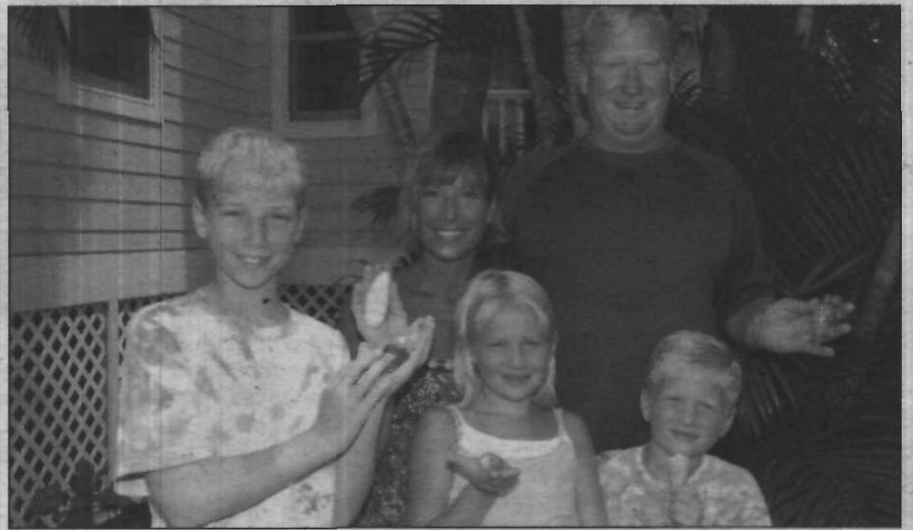

Sanibel resident made his mark on the toy industry

Life has been fun and games for Jack Elias — literally.

Elias, who is just shy of his 70th birthday, spent a portion of his adult life doing what most can only dream of. He designed and tested toys and games for a living.

Barrel Of Monkeys, Perfection and Aggravation's deluxe version are some of Elias's claims to fame. Currently, Elias owns Sanybel's Finest, a popular upscale art store in Jerry's Center on Periwinkle Way.

The Minnesota native never planned on being a toy and game inventor — it just sought of happened. A recent graduate from the Minneapolis College of Art and Design in the early 1960s, he took a job with the Lakeside Sign Company.

His first assignment at first a failure ultimately became his and his company's beacon of success.

On the assignment, Elias was asked to create a bar game using the eagle logo for the Anheiser-Busch brewery.

He decided to take the ensignia of the beer company's wings and bend the tips in order to use it for a hook game. Elias beamed at his creation. His boss even sent him to St. Louis to make the presentation to an executive at Anheiser-Busch.

However, moments after

making his pitch, Elias said he was tossed out of the office. Apparently, the top beer honcho didn't like the idea of having the Busch logo altered.

With two children to feed at the time, Elias was a bit worried about how things would turn out with his employer.

"I thought I was going to lose my job," he said.

Though his boss reassured him that his job was safe and to come back on Monday, Elias shuffled home dejected.

At home that weekend, Elias scooted on the floor with his children and settled in to watch Mutual of Omaha's Wild Kingdom.

It was at that moment when Elias noticed a monkey being held by the host reaching her arm down to hook and grab another smaller monkey on the floor.

"Eureka!"

It was at that moment, Elias's world changed.

He hustled to Lakeside's workshop and started creating plastic monkeys to fit into a barrel. The monkeys arms were shaped like hooks so they could be connected. The point of the game was to connect all of the monkeys together.

That following Monday, he showed his boss his invention. After a few phone calls, Elias was sent to a toy trade show in New York City, where he showed off the Barrel Of Monkeys game to buyers. A buyer from Sears bought an exclusive on the soon-to-be

famous monkey game.

And the rest, as they say, is history.

Elias went into the toy/gamemaking business at Lakeside.

"I was a one-man band," he said with a chuckle.

Elias was soon named the director of research and development.

During the rest of Elias's career, he created a deluxe version of Aggravation and the popular family game Perfection. He got the idea to design Perfection after a co-worker toppled a table with a preschool game filled with shapes on it. Watching the colorful shapes fly off the table gave Elias the idea to create a game with a timer on it. The point of the game is to challenge players to put all of the shapes in the correct places before the timer with a spring mechanism goes off, spraying the

pieces all over.

Elias also had a hand in redesigning Gummy and Pokey for television as well as characters such as Woody Woodpecker.

The gamemaker also took a turn at adding his magical touch at Disney. He helped design board games for Disney's Haunted Mansion and Pirates of the Caribbean.

Elias's time in the fun and games world also brought him to the White House on one occasion. President Richard Nixon was in office when Elias was invited to be a voice about toy safety.

"We were the forerunners for toy safety," he said.

And during this whole sort of fairy-tale like career, Elias got the chance to let his five children help him create safe and fun toys and games.

"I had a lot of fun," he said with a big grin.

His children didn't mind having a dad in the business of making fun. Aside from trying new games and toys, they got to travel and play

"Santa Claus" with their dad.

Elias treasures a memory book made by daughter Ellie that detailed her joy of getting the chance to give toys and games to the needy during a special Elias family ritual each Christmas.

Tears welled in Elias's eyes as he thought about the family tradition and what it meant to his daughter when they would walk into homes, where residents lived without much, and hand them over a pile of toys and games.

"They were elated," he said, wiping at his wet eyes.

And a charmed life it seemed for the now grown children.

"It was definitely not boring," said Joe Elias, general manager of Sanybel's Finest. "It was definitely a unique childhood."

Joe also remembers playing with race cars on a four-lane track that took up most of the basement and trying out new game after game.

With a tone of mischief in his voice, Joe recalled

shooting some new toy dart guns at his dad's office with his brother during a party. However, things got a bit colorful when the brothers decided to shoot pencils in Elias's boss's office taken from a canister on his desk. In a short time, pencils were lodged on the office ceiling. But Elias — being a man quick on his feet — told his boss that his boys uncovered a safety issue in the toy guns. They retooled the dart guns so pencils could not be jammed in them by other children.

"Everybody knew about the five Elias children in the toy business," Joe said.

But the fun and games had to end — well, sort of end — sometime.

Even with a tempting offer to work as an executive for the giant toy company Hasbro, Elias retired in 1975 and moved to Sanibel with his family.

Elias and his wife, Judy, honeymooned on the islands in the early 1960s and had stayed in love with the area ever since.

He ran several successful businesses on Sanibel, including the Port of Call near the Post Office on Tarpon Bay Road before buying Sanybel's Finest in 1984.

He eventually plans to give the business — which features local art — to his children and spend more time traveling with his wife.

As far as Elias is concerned, the game of life couldn't have had a better outcome for him.

"I have had a wonderful time on this earth," he said.

And if anyone has ever dreamed of making a hit in the game industry, Elias urges them to give it a try. He said game companies can be contacted with anybody's original ideas.

"If you have an idea and can put it together, play with and have fun and your friends like it, then you just might have something," he added.

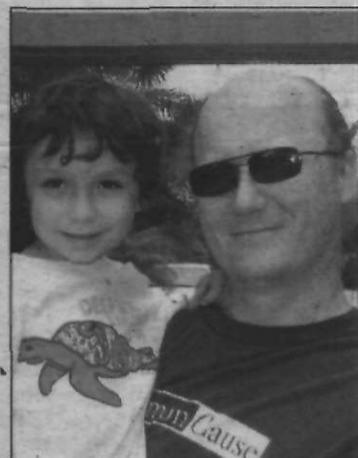

Shells with wildflower coloring and butterfly shape

Wedge clams are found in the sand of almost every tropical or temperate beach around the world. The Atlantic coquina, *Donax variabilis*, a type of wedge clam, can be discovered on beaches in the southeastern United States. This bivalve is no longer than about half of an inch. The color display of coquinas is reminiscent of the diversity of hues seen in wildflowers. It would be difficult to choose the most striking color. In warm waters the hues include bright orange, red, pink, yellow, and purple but from Maryland north, their color is a dull white with purplish rays.

Dead coquinas washed up on the beach often are still hinged, with their wings spread like a butterfly, which is a name shellers use when referring to them. In the cooler more northerly

distribution range, adults can be killed off by severe winters. In the spring, drifting larvae from the south replenish these northern colonies. Deposits of old shells, compacted over time and cemented together by their own lime, form a rock called coquina that has been mined since colonial times.

Coquinas are fascinating to watch and summer is the best time of year to do so. They are unique in their preference for a habitat along wave-dashed sandy beaches.

Their main territory is just below the surface of the sand, right at the surf line. If the telltale bubbles in the

sand don't catch your eye then wiggle your toes in the wet sand right where the waves are breaking and discover colonies numbering in the millions.

If you spy a live specimen, you will note twin siphon tubes extending from the two hinged shells that form this bivalve. The siphons look like snorkels. One takes in the oxygen, food-rich water and the other discharges the water and waste after the oxygen and food particles have been removed. Coquinas feast on plankton and they fall prey to sandpipers and a variety of other shore birds.

In order to remain in their terrain near the surf line where the sand is

always wet, the coquinas move up and down the beach as the tide goes in and out. They accomplish this by monitoring the vibration of waves on the sand. When the tide is coming in they emerge from the sand and hitch a ride to shore, digging in to prevent being washed back out to sea. If they end up too far from the water, they sense that the sand is dry and hop back on the next wave to allow themselves to be pulled further out to sea.

If uprooted, they use their foot to quickly burrow back below the surface of the sand.

Children are fascinated by the speed at which these little creatures move in order to bury themselves in the sand. They seem to mimic a gymnast, standing on their head, using their large foot to wiggle and wriggle into the sand with lightning speed. This has been coined the "dance of the coquinas."

Seafood enthusiasts gather up live coquinas (not something we can do in

Southwest Florida) to make a tasty broth. Most recipes call for water, pepper, butter and cooking sherry. The broth can be used as a soup stock or base for other seafood treats.

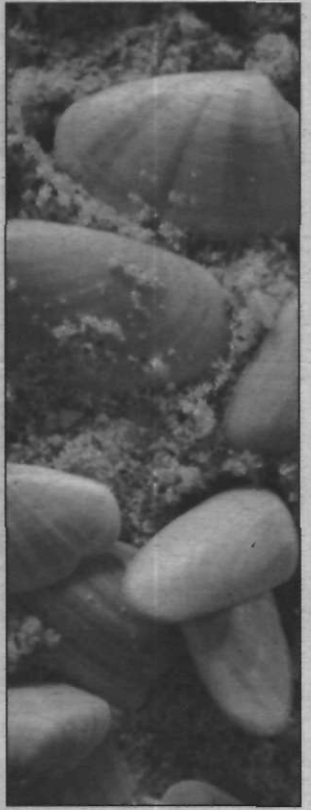

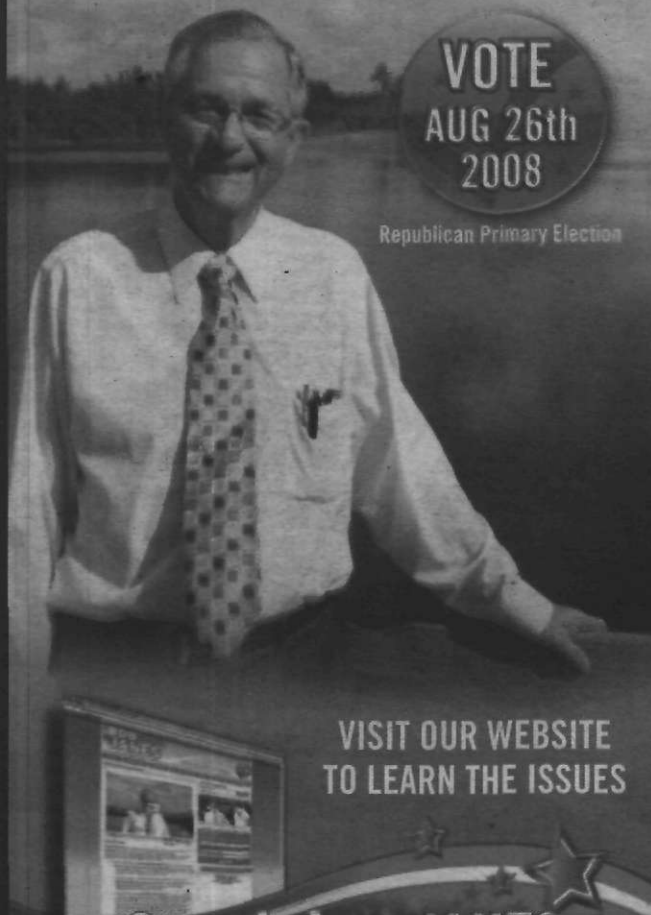

Though warm blue waters, sandy beaches and island atmosphere seems to be the main draw to Sanibel, there appears to be another lure.

People of all ages are encouraged to attend the entertaining and educational Periwinkle Bird Show. There, Baird will let fuzzy green talking parrots sit on shoulders and heads, all while she explains the exotic birds antics and lifestyle.

The park is located about a quarter of a mile past the Periwinkle Park visitor's gate.

A little bit up the road, folks can get their parrot fix satiated at Jerry's. The quaint shopping center features a variety of caged tropical birds, including macaws, an African Grey, an Amazon parrot and some cockatoos.

At any given moment, customers can be found chatting with the feathered fellows.

"People love to come to Jerry's to see the parrots," Muench said.

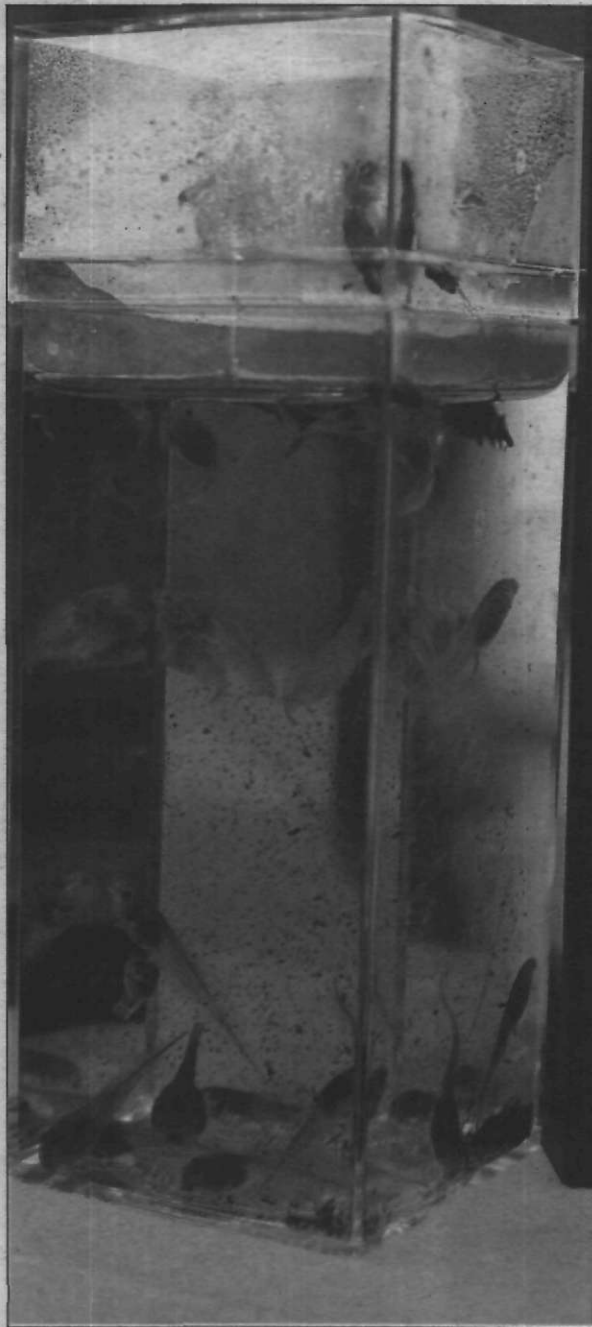

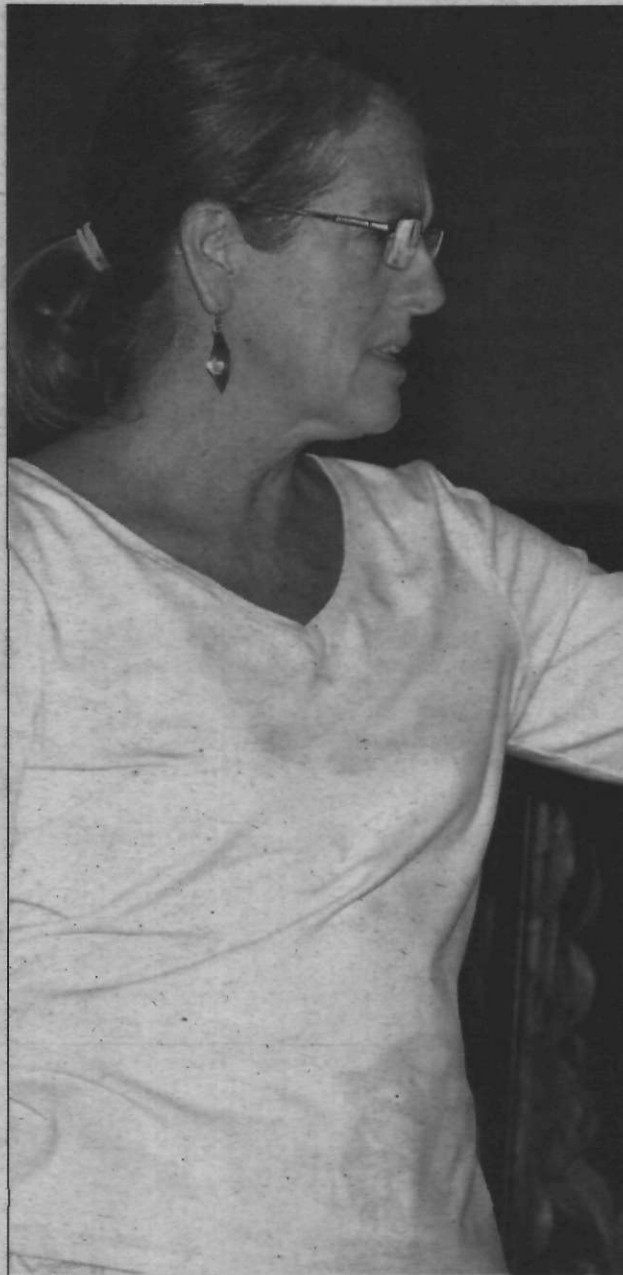

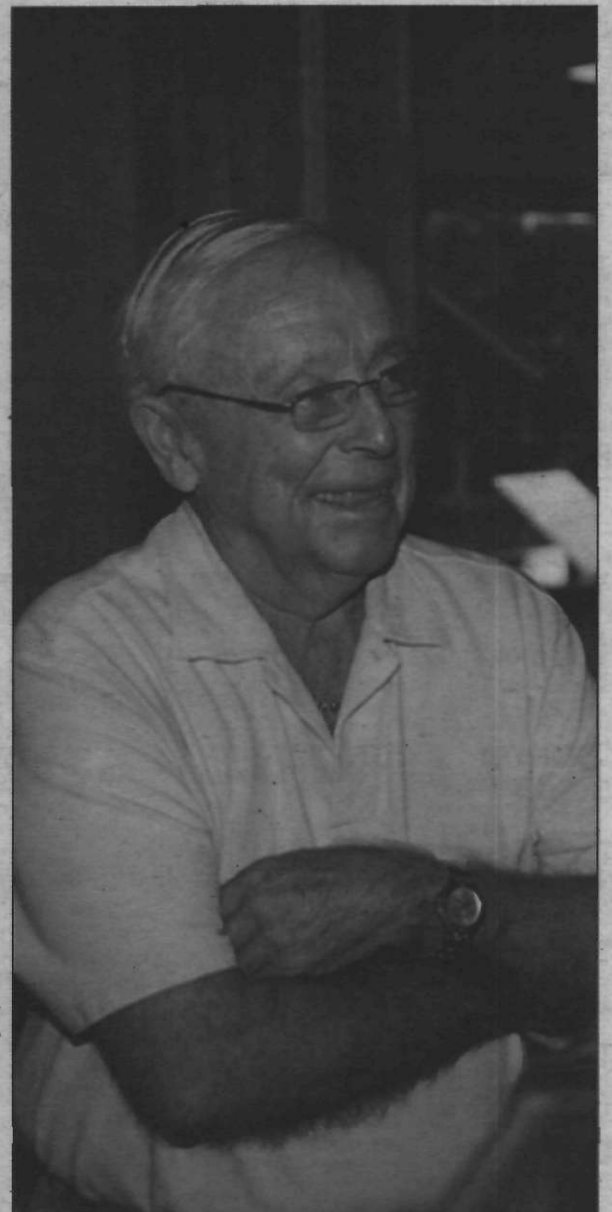

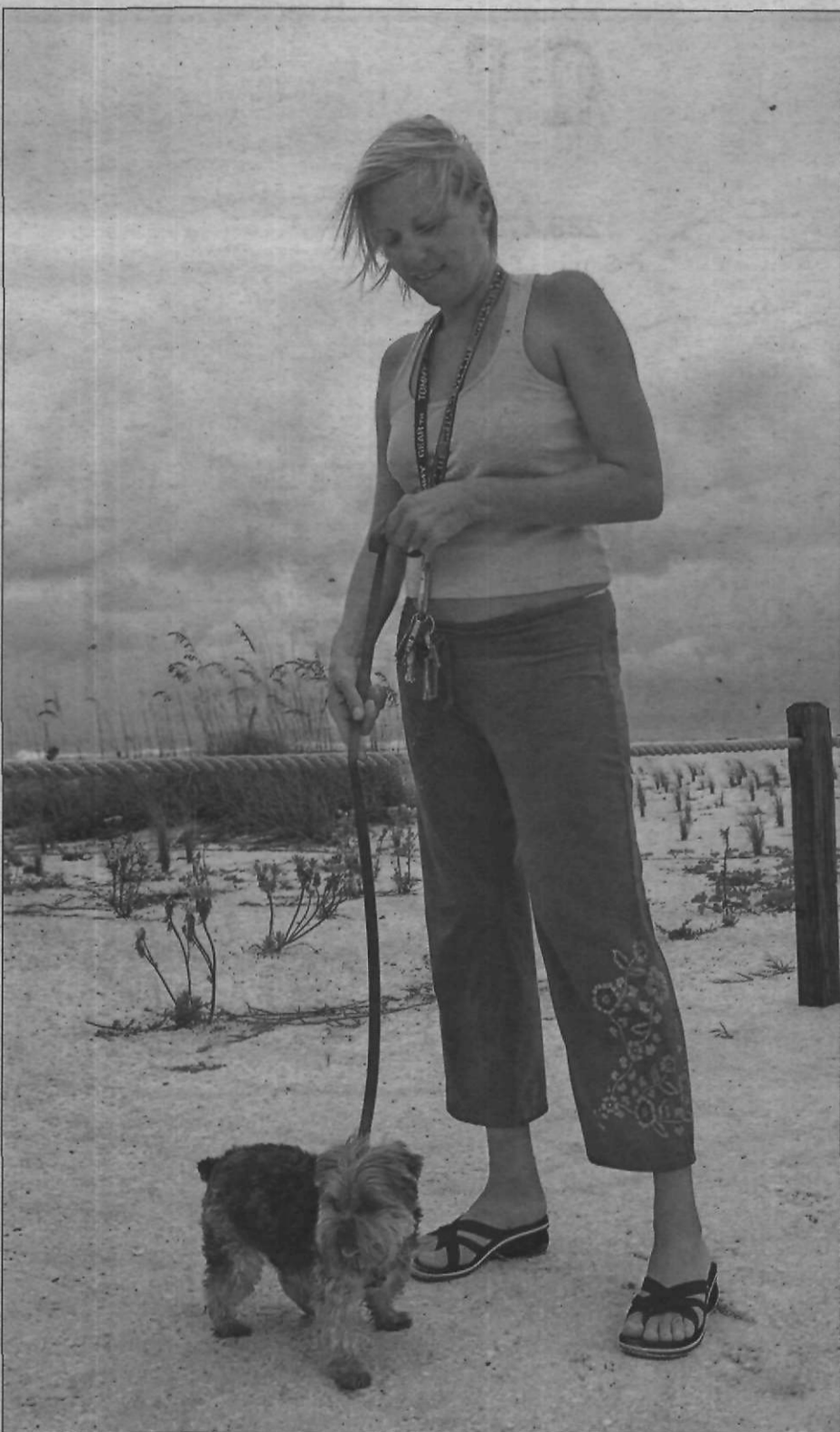

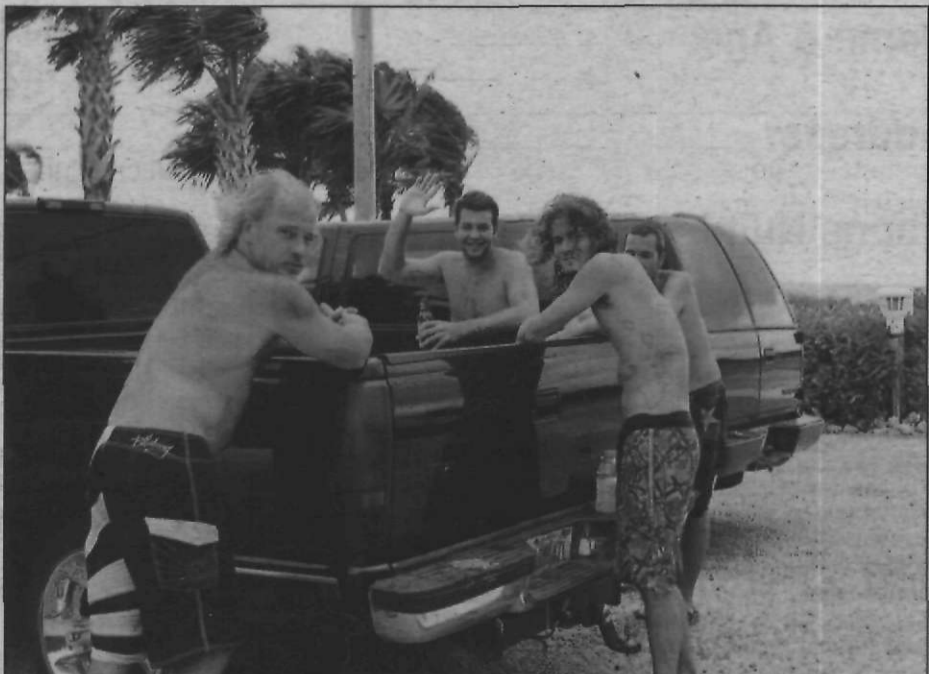

I am officially an "empty-nester." My last daughter just packed her bags and left for college. This is a sad transition for me. Being a mom has been one of life's greatest joys and I will miss her dreadfully. It gave me no small amount of joy when she texted me within 48 hours, crying a little, and saying how much she missed me and wanted to be a little kid at home again.

But for lots of moms, this is no empty nest time. They are trying to figure out how to get good food into their little ones, especially at this time of year. September is always a time for new resolutions: "I will not feed my kids junk food this year." "I will give him a hot home-cooked breakfast each morning." "I will only pack nutritious foods into her lunch box."

And then by October, all resolutions are gone. Forget breakfast when mom is in a wild-eyed frenzy trying to assemble

school papers, books, homework, teeth brushed, shoes on, and some sort of lunch stuffed into a brown paper bag. Or some change pushed into their pockets so they can indulge in the school lunch program.

I frankly do not have easy answers. Kids are not easily fed. So let's provide some options for mom and dad.

Give your kids some protein for breakfast each morning. A deviled egg, breakfast burritos, protein powder blended into a smoothie... Whatever it takes, because protein stabilizes his blood sugar, making it easier for him to concentrate on his studies.

Do not let your children eat packaged entrees for lunch. You know the brand names. They are a nutritional nightmare. Salads, healthy sandwiches, nut mixes, fresh fruit. There are lots of options, all of them natural. Teach



your kids the difference between junk food and healthy food, and help them make good decisions.

Meanwhile, we know this will not be conquered overnight. Supplements for your kids are not optional; they provide what is missing from even healthy diets. What should it contain? What do you look for? Ideally, a kid's vitamin should be a whole food supplement, certified organic, free of refined sugars, and artificial ingredients. I like one that provides probiotically cultured whole foods, packed with synbiotics from *saccharomyces cerevisiae* and *lactobacillus*.

Oh, and it should taste good.

'My Name is Red' to be at the Sanibel library

Readers are invited to discuss "My Name is Red", by Orhan Pamuk, at 2 p.m. on Wednesday, Aug. 27 during the book discussion meeting at the Sanibel Public Library. The meeting is free and open to the public.

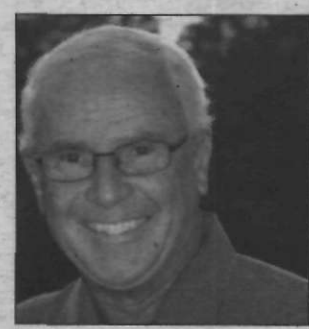

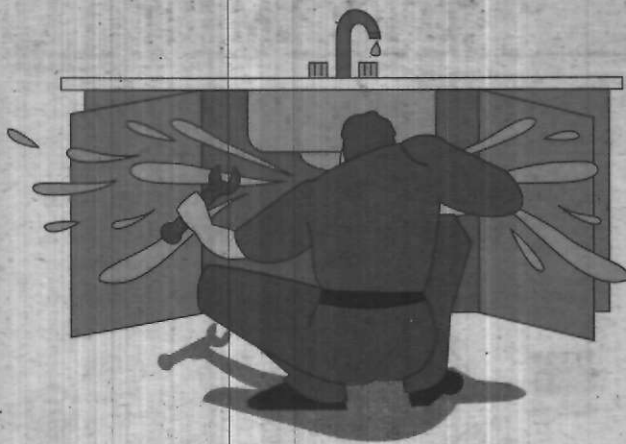

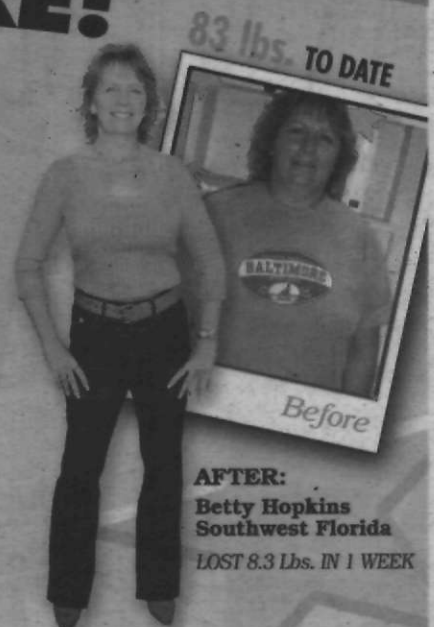
